Milwaukee Bucks hire Adrian Griffin as head coach

The Milwaukee Bucks have hired Adrian Griffin as head coach, making the official announcement on Monday, June 5, 2023.

Griffin, who becomes the 17th head coach in franchise history, brings 15 seasons of NBA coaching experience to the Bucks, most recently spending the last five seasons as an assistant coach with the Toronto Raptors.

“Adrian is a widely respected coach and former player, who brings great leadership and experience to our team,” said Bucks general manager Jon Horst. “His championship-level coaching pedigree, character, basketball acumen and ability to connect with and develop players make him the ideal choice to lead our team. He has earned this opportunity.”

In Griffin’s time as an assistant coach, the Raptors finished in the league’s top 10 of both defensive rating and

fewest points allowed per game in four of his five seasons, including in 2019-20 when they allowed a league-low 106.5 points per game. He was part of the development of a young core of players that included the league’s Most Improved Player, the NBA Rookie of the Year and four players who made six All-Star appearances.

“I’m incredibly honored and grateful to Wes, Jamie, Dee, Jimmy and Jon to be named the head coach of the Milwaukee Bucks,” said Griffin. “The Bucks are a championship organization and I’m thrilled to work with an established roster of high character and talented players. I’m excited to be back in Milwaukee and I can’t wait to get started.”

Prior to joining the Raptors, Griffin spent two seasons as an assistant coach with the Oklahoma City Thunder from 2016-18. His NBA coaching experience



also includes stops as an assistant coach with the Orlando Magic (2015-16), Chicago Bulls (2010-15) and the Bucks (2008-10). In Griffin’s 15 seasons as an assistant coach, he was part of teams that made the playoffs 11 times, with two Conference Finals appearances in addition to winning an NBA title with the Raptors in 2019.

“Adrian is well-regarded throughout the NBA, and we believe that his vast experience working under and playing for successful head coaches makes him the right

person to guide our team in competing for championships,” said Bucks co-owners Wes Edens, Jamie Dinan and Dee and Jimmy Haslam. “Following a widespread coaching search, we are extremely impressed by Adrian’s leadership and communication skills and welcome him to the Bucks family.”

A native of Wichita, KS, Griffin began his coaching career after a nine-year NBA playing career with Boston, Dallas, Houston, Chicago and Seattle from 1999-2008. He appeared in 477

regular-season games in his NBA career and averaged 4.0 points in 16.8 minutes per game. Griffin also saw action in 48 playoff games, including in 2006 when he reached the NBA Finals with the Dallas Mavericks.

Griffin played collegiately at Seton Hall for four seasons where he earned All-Big East Second Team honors as a senior and was inducted into the school’s Athletics Hall of Fame in 2010. After his collegiate career, Griffin played professionally in the United States Basketball League, the Continental Basketball Association and internationally in Italy. His coaching experience also includes working with the USA men’s national team that won gold at the FIBA Basketball World Cup in Spain in 2014.

A formal press conference introducing Griffin as the Bucks’ head coach was held on June 6, 2023 in GATHER at Deer District.

Drucilla was born in South Carolina and blessed at birth with exceptional intelligence and the resilience. As a young girl, she said she invented a type of hair curler in 1939 that was very popular and sold well; but she never patented the design and eventually someone else did, preventing her from profiting further off her own invention. Later in her life, she

played an active part during World War II, relocating to Milwaukee in 1945 to work for NESCO a manicure of kitchen appliances who produced ammunition during the war.

Despite the fact that Drucilla only had one daughter, Joan Hood, she has been blessed with a multitude of descendants, five grandchildren, seven great grandchildren and eleven great-great children. Many of them were at the party on Saturday to celebrate with her, along with nieces, nephews, friends and other family. She retired in 1972, but said she continues on occasion to “mess around with hair,” as she modestly refers to her hair styling efforts.

“Treat everyone the way you want to be treated,” she said when asked for the secret to her long life.







What Is Juneteenth?

Juneteenth commemorates the effective end of slavery in the United States

Juneteenth (short for “June Nineteenth”) marks the day when federal troops arrived in Galveston, TX in 1865 to take control of the state and ensure that all enslaved people be freed. The troops’ arrival came a full two and a half years after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation. Juneteenth honors the end to slavery in the United States and is considered the longest-running African American holiday.

Confederate General Robert E. Lee had surrendered at Appomattox Court House in Virginia two months earlier, but slavery had remained relatively unaffected in Texas—until U.S. General Gordon Granger stood on Texas soil and read General Orders No. 3: “The people of Texas are informed that, in accordance with a proclamation from the Executive of the United States, all slaves are free.”

The Emancipation Proclamation

The Emancipation Proclamation issued by President Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, had established that all enslaved people in Confederate states in rebellion against the Union “shall be then, thenceforward, and forever free.”

But in reality, the Emancipation Proclamation didn’t instantly free any enslaved people. The proclamation only applied to places under Confederate control and not to slave-holding border states or rebel areas already under Union control. However, as Northern troops advanced into the Confederate South, many enslaved people fled behind Union lines.

Juneteenth and slavery in Texas

In Texas, slavery had continued as the state experienced no large-scale fighting or significant presence of Union troops. Many enslavers from outside the Lone Star State had moved there, as they viewed it as a safe haven for slavery.

After the war came to a close in the spring of 1865, General Granger’s arrival in Galveston that June signaled freedom for Texas’s 250,000 enslaved people. Although emancipation didn’t happen overnight for everyone—in some cases, enslavers withheld the information until after harvest season—celebrations broke out among newly freed black people, and Juneteenth was born. That December, slavery in America was formally abol-



ished with the adoption of the 13th Amendment to the US Constitution.

The year following 1865, freedmen in Texas organized the first of what became the annual celebration of “Jubilee Day” on June 19. In the ensuing decades, Juneteenth commemorations featured music, barbecues, prayer services and other activities, and as black people migrated from Texas to other parts of the country, the Juneteenth tradition spread.

In 1979, Texas became the first state to make Juneteenth an official holiday. Today, all 50 states recognize Juneteenth as a holiday. President Joe Biden signed the legislation in June 2021 that made Juneteenth a Federal observance.

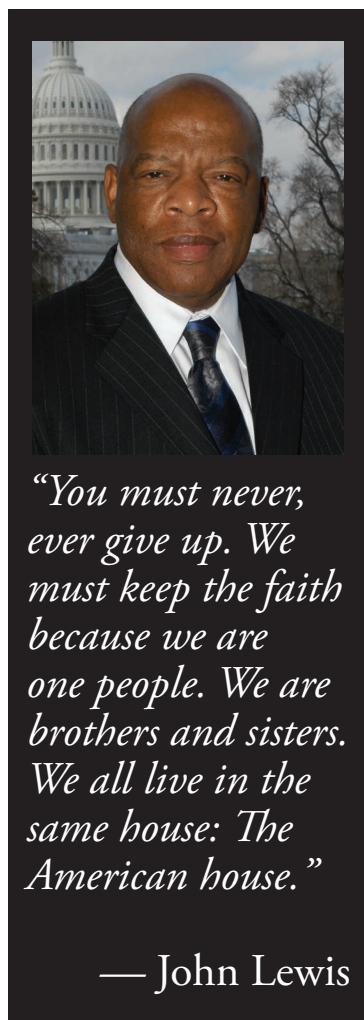



Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month: A Salute to a Milwaukee Caregiver, Johnna McGee

During Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month, the Alzheimer's Association salutes more than 191,000 caregivers taking care of a loved one with dementia. Johnna McGee of Milwaukee, is a caregiver for two special people on this difficult journey. Her 95-year old mother, Vera Roana and 40-year old daughter, Rhonda, are living with dementia. "When their lives began to change, my life began to change," Johnna said.

Her daughter, Rhonda, has Down syndrome, but previously was able to live alone and had a job. But when her daughter started hearing voices, she moved back in

with Johnna for support. Individuals affected by Down syndrome have a greatly increased risk of developing a type of dementia and after meeting with a doctor, they believe the voices are an early sign of dementia for Rhonda.

Johnna's mother has lived with her for more than 20 years, but was diagnosed with dementia in recent years. "My mom's mind is sharp, but she forgets we have conversations and to take her medications," Johnna said. "My life is surrounded by them now. I want to make sure they are taken care of, so my time is their time at this point in our lives."

Johnna is still working, but plans to retire early to focus on her family. She is able to work from home three weeks out of the month and her family helps when she works off-site.

Joy of caregiving

"Taking care of them is a joy for me," Johnna said. "It's a journey and every day is different. But I'm lucky to have a 95-year-old mother and a daughter with Down syndrome who will soon be

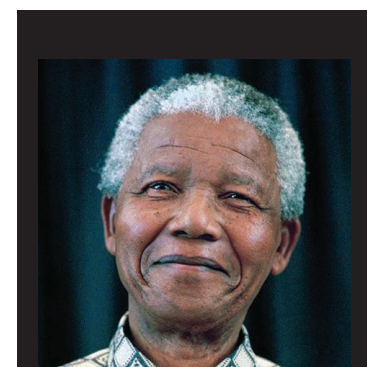

40. At this point they have more needs than I do and I'm happy to take care of them."

"I would encourage other caregivers to take time for themselves," Johnna said. "It's hard to do, but you shouldn't feel guilty that you aren't doing enough. Have a little confidence in yourself and know that you're doing all you can."

Johnna attended the Alzheimer's Association caregiver event in 2022 that was focused on self-care strategies and available resources for families.

Public Notification of Completion of a National Out-of-Hospital Cardiac Arrest Research Study in Milwaukee County

A research study on the effect of an initial airway management strategy using laryngeal tube insertion (LTI), compared with endotracheal intubation (ETI), on survival among adults with out-of-hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA) has been completed in Milwaukee County.

About the research

This study was performed by the Resuscitation Outcomes Consortium (ROC) – a collaboration of 10 U.S. and Canadian sites that perform emergency research. A total of 3004 patients were enrolled in the study. Milwaukee County was one of the ROC sites where Milwaukee County Emergency Medical Services and the Medical College of Wisconsin performed this research.

Of the 3004 patients enrolled nationwide, 875 patients were enrolled in Milwaukee County between October 2016 and November 2017. 542 patients (61.9%) were male and 333 (38.1%) were female. 452 patients (51.7%) were White, 276 (31.5%) were Black or African American, 11 (1.3%) were Asian, and 136 (15.5%) were other or unreported race. 52 patients (5.9%) were Hispanic.

Study Results

The study found that among patients with OHCA, a strategy of initial LTI was associated with significantly greater 72-hour survival compared with a strategy of initial ETI. These findings suggest that LTI may be considered as an initial airway management strategy in patients with out-of-hospital cardiac arrest, but limitations of the pragmatic design, practice setting, and ETI performance characteristics suggest that further research is warranted.

Public Notification of Completion of a National Traumatic Brain Injury Study Performed in Milwaukee County

A research study on the effect of Tranexamic Acid (TXA) versus Placebo on 6-Month Functional Neurologic Outcome in Patients with Moderate or Severe Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) has been completed in Milwaukee County.

About the research

This study was performed by the Resuscitation Outcomes Consortium (ROC) – a collaboration of 10 U.S. and Canadian sites that perform emergency research. A total of 1063 patients were enrolled in the TBI study. Milwaukee County was one of the ROC sites where Milwaukee County Emergency Medical Services and the Medical College of Wisconsin performed this research.

Of the 1063 patients enrolled nationwide, 105 patients were enrolled in Milwaukee County between September 2015 and February 2017. 79 patients (75.2%) were male and 26 (24.8%) were female. 59 patients (56.2%) were White, 35 (33.3%) were Black or African American, 3 (2.9%) were Asian, and 8 (7.6%) were other or unreported race. 12 patients (11.4%) were Hispanic.

Study Results

The study found that among patients with moderate to severe TBI, out-of-hospital TXA administration within 2 hours of injury compared with placebo did not significantly improve 6-month neurologic outcome as measured by the Glasgow Outcome Scale – Extended (GOS-E).
