Highlights from Milwaukee's 2023 Juneteenth Celebration

On Monday, June 19, 2023, the city of Milwaukee observed its 52nd Juneteenth celebration. Milwaukee is home to one of the longest held Juneteenth Day celebrations in the United States. The theme of this year's parade was "I Am Juneteenth." When it first began in 1971, Milwaukee was one of the first northern cities to host such celebrations. The local parade and festivities have been organized by Northcott Neighborhood House for the past half century. In pre-pandemic years the event would attract up to 170,000 visitors. For 2023, the third year of Juneteenth being a federal holiday, the crowd capacity appeared to break all previous records. Nearly 400 vendors in booths lined King Drive from Burleigh to Center Streets, offering African-style crafts and a variety of traditional food unique to the street festival. The holiday began with the Juneteenth Parade followed by opening ceremonies. The street festival concluded with a concert at Bernice and Clinton Rose Park.

Juneteenth is one of the first cultural celebrations of Milwaukee's summer-long festival season. The Juneteenth board has already met to discuss how to make things safer and bigger for next year.

Gov. Tony Evers signs Wisconsin shared revenue bill into law; Milwaukee lawmakers respond

Wisconsin's Democratic Gov. Tony Evers called it a "historic day" before he signed a bipartisan bill on Tuesday, June 20, 2023, that sends more money to Milwaukee and gives both the city and county the ability to raise the local sales tax in an effort to avoid bankruptcy.

The measure also sends 36 percent more money overall to every other smaller city, town, village and county in Wisconsin, part of a deal Evers struck with Republican legislative leaders to also increase funding for K-12 public schools and send more money to private schools that accept voucher students.

Evers signed the bill surrounded by a bipartisan group of state lawmakers, Milwaukee leaders and local officials in Wausau. Local governments have been clamoring for more state aid following years of cuts or stagnant funding that have forced cuts to essential services like police and fire protection.

"For far too long, our local communities have been forced to do more with less," Evers said. "And we've seen the consequence of that play out in communities across

Wisconsin." He said communities have been "forced to make impossible decisions about what essential services to fund."

Milwaukee's leaders had warned of catastrophic cuts if the bill was not enacted. Milwaukee is struggling with an underfunded pension system and not enough money to maintain essential police, fire and emergency services.

State Sen. LaTonya Johnson, of Milwaukee, said at the bill signing ceremony that the city was "on the verge of insolvency" that would have required laying off hundreds of police and firefighters, among others. The additional funding provides a lifeline, she said.

"It is our city's opportunity to start over," Johnson said.

The roughly \$1-billion in aid to local governments — known as shared revenue — would be paid for by tapping 20 percent of the state's 5-cent sales tax. Aid would then grow along with sales tax revenue. The measure increases current aid by about \$250-million statewide.



The new law also allows the Milwaukee Common Council and Milwaukee County Board to vote on raising local sales taxes, a power they previously did not have.

Some Republicans in the Legislature had wanted to require a vote of the people before those local sales taxes could be raised. But Milwaukee leaders, Democrats and some Republicans argued the need for more funding was too critical to leave to a referendum vote that could fail.

With Evers' signing the bill, the focus now shifts to those Milwaukee governing boards to see if they will vote to approve the increase.

The shared revenue program to fund local governments, created in 1911, has remained nearly unchanged for almost 30 years, despite

overall growth in tax revenues. Shared revenue for counties and municipalities was cut in 2004, 2010 and 2012 and since then has been relatively flat.

The Legislature passed the bill on a bipartisan vote last week.

While the focus of the new law is sending more money to Wisconsin's local governments, it also includes a wide array of other provisions.

Those include cutting aid to communities that reduce the number of police officers and firefighters and banning public health officials from ordering businesses closed for more than 30 days without approval from a local governing board, which could extend closures for only an additional 30 days.

The law also forbids local communities from putting advisory referenda questions on the ballot, except those related to certain projects that would be funded with property tax money. The bill would not allow questions on hot-button issues like whether voters support abortion rights, accept Medicaid expansion or legalize marijuana, which many communities across the state have put forward in recent years.

The law also targets diversity, equity and inclusion efforts.

It prevents Milwaukee from using tax money for "funding any position for which the principal duties consist of promoting individuals or groups on the basis of their race, color, ancestry, national origin or sexual orientation."

The law also says that no local government "may discriminate against, or grant preferential treatment on the basis of, race, color, ancestry, national origin, or sexual orientation in making employment decisions."

It further requires Milwaukee Public Schools to return at least 25 police officers, known as school resource officers, to its schools by January 1, 2024.

Nobody's free until everybody's free

Our nation has just celebrate its third commemoration of Juneteenth as a federal holiday, marking the jubilant day in June 1865 when many enslaved people in Texas finally learned they were free from federal troops arriving in Galveston after the end of the Civil War. The news came more than two and a half years after President Lincoln issued the Emancipation Proclamation on January 1, 1863, freeing all slaves in the Confederate states.



While Juneteenth is still a very new federal holiday, many black families have celebrated this day for generations, a tradition that began almost immediately in Texas following the first "Jubilee Day." We honor this date because, in my beloved friend and role model Fannie Lou Hamer's eternal words, nobody's free until everybody's free.

activists who worked tirelessly to push for Juneteenth's recognition as a national holiday, remembers her own early childhood in Marshall, TX, where Juneteenth was celebrated at the local fairgrounds with games, music, and food, and always felt like a second Christmas. But she also remembers Juneteenth in 1939, soon after her family had moved into a new white neighborhood in Fort Worth, TX. That night a white mob set fire to their new home, destroying the furniture and possessions her parents had just so proudly unpacked. Family friends took them in as they were forced to spend

the next several years rebuilding their lives. Both memories are key pieces of the full story of American history.

Ms. Lee, who eventually earned a master's degree in education and spent more than twenty years as an educator and counselor in Fort Worth public schools, remains committed to making sure students learn the full truth about our nation's history of injustice and violence so "we can heal from it and not let it happen again." As she said, "I'm adamant about schools actually having the truth told." Her own children's book, *Juneteenth*:

A Children's Story, is just the kind of history and truth that some schools and libraries in her home state and elsewhere are desperately trying to ban and hide right now. Some current Members of Congress voted against making Juneteenth a federal holiday. But truth hidden will always be brought to light.

For more than two years after the Emancipation Proclamation slavery continued as usual in Texas, but on June 19, 1865, U.S. Major General Gordon Granger issued General Order No. 3 finally informing all people in Texas that all enslaved people were free. For decades after that, many Americans did not know what Juneteenth symbolized. Now it is a federally recognized annual holiday that teaches all Americans about that inescapable moment in our history and officially reminds us of the ongoing struggle to make the promise of liberty and justice for all real. As Ms. Lee also said, "We don't want people to think that Juneteenth is a stopping point, because it isn't. It's a beginning."

On June 13, 2023, Ms. Lee was one of the honored guests at the White House's Juneteenth Concert, and as Vice President Kamala Harris opened the event, she invited her to come to the stage. Ms. Lee greeted all the "young people"—telling the whole audience they were included if they were not yet 96—and said: "Please, could I just say this to you, young folk: Make yourself a committee of one to change somebody's mind. If people can be taught to hate, they can be taught to love. And it's up to you to do it. We are the most powerful country . . . and we must get together and get rid of the disparities, the joblessness and homelessness, and health care that some people couldn't get and others can, and climate change that we are responsible for. If we don't do something about it, we're all going to hell in a handbasket." We honor this spirit on Juneteenth as we remember again that nobody's free until everybody's free.







I recently worked with a widow who wanted to transfer ownership of the family house to her daughter. In order to ensure that her wishes were carried out correctly when she was no longer around to speak for herself, we first needed to “clean up” the title to the property. First, we needed to remove her late husband from the deed registered with the City of Milwaukee. It is important to eliminate as many potential obstacles to clear title as possible before they can become problems. Possible issues include any judgments, liens (unpaid debt registered through the court), back taxes, old code violations, personal indebtedness such as credit card or student loan debts, etc. Fortunately cleaning up the title was relatively easy for my client.

I am like a real estate firefighter in that I can help prevent financial and legal peril for families at title transfer time with a wonderful tool I call an “owner’s title policy.”

An owner’s title policy is an insurance policy that protects homeowners against potential losses due to title defects or ownership disputes related to their property. Here are some benefits of having an

owner’s title policy:

- Protection against title issues
- An owner’s title policy provides coverage for losses arising from title defects that existed before the policy’s effective date.
- It protects you if someone else claims ownership rights to your property,
- If there are undisclosed liens, encumbrances, or judgments against the property.

If a covered issue arises, the policy will typically provide legal defense and financial compensation, if necessary.

Peace of mind: By having an owner’s title policy, you can have peace of mind knowing that your investment in the property is protected. Milwaukee Public Schools Class of 2023 scholarships and grants set record

The scholarships and grants offered to Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) graduates in 2023 totaled a record-setting \$121-million.

The jump by \$14-million in 2023 represents the largest year-over-year increase in scholarships and grants since MPS began tracking the total in 2012.

The reveal was held on the front lawn of MPS Central Services, 5225 W. Vliet Street, with several of the more than 900 scholarship and grant awardees in attendance.

One of them was Chianang Xiong, salutatorian and senior class president at James Madison Academic Campus. Xiong said she initially applied for scholarships on her own and was rejected. She worried she wouldn't be able to afford college, but she began working with her school counselor and the staff of the MPS College and Career Center at James Madison to apply for scholarships.



Ultimately, she received more than \$200,000 in scholarship offers. She intends to attend UWM on a \$15,000 scholarship, to major in diagnostic medical sonography.

Another graduate, Savion Jarvis of Golda Meir School, spoke of the strong support he received from MPS' Department of Black and Latino Male Achievement on his journey through school. He was offered multiple scholarships and plans to study political science at North Carolina Central University, to "give back to grassroots organizations to create equity

in Milwaukee" after he graduates, Jarvis said.

Kearra Hartz, who graduated from Bradley Technology and Trade High School in the school's top 5 percent, wants to address gun violence and mental illness by studying psychology at Marquette University, where a scholarship will cover four years of tuition and two of room and board. "When I graduate, I will be able to give back to my community in a positive way," she said.

Except for one year, the MPS scholarship and grant total for graduates has

climbed steadily since 2012, when it was \$18-million:

In addition to school counselors and College and Career Centers — which assist all Milwaukee students in Grades 6 through 12 and even after graduation — the district has a scholarship coordinator.

MPS now has 21 College and Career Centers in schools, and it also serves schools without centers. The staff help students with scholarship applications, college tours, résumé writing, job searching, and more.

Three of the centers — Bradley Tech High School, 700 S. 4th Street; Milwaukee School of Languages, 8400 W. Burleigh Street; and Wisconsin Conservatory of Life-

long Learning, 1017 N. 12th Street — are open over the summer. Hours are 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Fourteen MPS high schools tallied more than \$1-million in scholarship and grant offers to its graduates.

MPS graduates plan to continue their education at more than 30 institutions in Wisconsin, including the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, Milwaukee Area Technical College, and Marquette University.

Members of the Class of 2023 have been accepted at more than 30 historically Black colleges and universities, such as Howard University, Morehouse College, and Tuskegee University.

Others have been accepted at another 50-plus colleges and universities across the country, including Cornell University, the University of Chicago, and Georgia State University. Some plan to attend international schools, while others plan careers in the military, in service organizations, and in the trades.
