It would have been a proud day for Keith Carrington, the late principal of North Division High School, to see his graduating seniors being honored at their banquet for their academic, athletic, and leadership achievements.

All 36 graduating seniors at North Division High School received gift cards to celebrate the students' achievements, given by MMABSE in memory of Carrington. At one of the banquet chairs was his blue North Division blazer and a photo of him, along with his assistant principal, Jason McCord, now the Assistant Principal in Charge at the high school. Assistant Principal Robin Bradford, along with other staff at North Division, arranged the banquet for the students and their families.

MMABSE gave each senior \$40 in gift cards as a reminder of how proud their late principal would have been of their accomplishments and to encourage them to continue pursuing their academic and life goals.

The gift cards the seniors received at their senior banquet on May 11, 2023 can be used at a variety of local



businesses. North Division's graduation was May 25, 2023.

Carrington, 48, died unexpectedly in August 2022 after having surgery. He had been principal of North Division since 2016. Previously, he worked for MPS in roles including assistant principal, special education teacher, and paraprofessional.

Born in Dallas, Carrington moved to Milwaukee in childhood with his family. He earned a bachelor's degree at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and a master's at Alverno College. He was pursuing his doctorate at the time of his death.

"He always performed his duties and responsibilities with passion and compassion," said Dr. Patricia A. Ellis, director of the MPS Department of Equity, Access, and Inclusion, and president of MMABSE. For him, being a principal was more than a career, Ellis said. It was a calling.

"He wanted all of them to aspire to greatness and achieve that greatness," Ellis said.

Carrington, an avowed "sneakerhead," could be seen walking the halls of North Division, rotating through his collection of sneakers. "The children enjoyed that personal connection," Ellis said.



Late principal Keith Carrington


He was active in MMABSE, serving as vice president from 2019 to 2022, as chairman and co-chairman of the annual Teacher of the Year Recognition Gala in 2021 and 2022, and in other capacities. He served alongside Dr. Christlyn Frederick-Stanley, who served as the MMABSE president during his tenure as vice president.

At what would be his last gala for teachers in 2022, Ellis recalled, Carrington spent the evening making sure everything was going well. "He wanted to be sure that it would be a memorable moment for the honorees," Ellis said.

"The footprints he left for us to follow will leave an everlasting impression, not only on the adults but also the students he so dearly loved," Ellis said. "He really cared about each and every individual."

Carrington's survivors include his wife, Dr. Tanzanique Carrington, principal of Morse Middle School for the Gifted and Talented.





## Do black people really need to wear sunscreen?

Hey, lovelies, I'm so glad you landed here! It's finally summertime, and she ain't playing no games! The heat, humidity, and air quality are about to take me out and there's no edge control that can tame my edges. After experiencing cautious joy and scary freedom during the pandemic, this is the perfect time to live and enjoy being outside-not in. While y'all are out frolicking at summer concerts, on trips, and on cruises (stay out of suspicious submarines) I hope you're also wearing sunscreen and being healthy. I know there are many misconceptions about sunscreen for those of us with more melanin. So, let's get into it!

## Did you know?

1. Melanoma is the most



common cancer in the United States.

- Melanoma is the most dangerous skin cancer and caused 7,650 deaths in 2022.
- 3. Black people are three times more likely to be diagnosed with melanoma at a later stage than white people.

## What is melanoma?

Melanoma is a cancer that begins in the melanocytes, cells that produce melanin (the pigment that gives your skin its color). Since melanoma cells still produce melanin, tumors are typically black or brown and occasionally pink, tan, or white.

It can develop anywhere on the skin, but for men, it typically starts on the chest and back, and for women on the legs. Although less common than forming on the skin, it can also form in the eyes, mouth, genitals, and the anal

The cause of melanoma is a combination of genetic factors, environmental factors, and excess exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun and tanning lamps. People with a fair complexion, blonde or red hair, blue eyes, and freckles are at increased risk of developing melanoma.

However, skin cancer does not discriminate, people of color can also develop melanoma. For people who have darker skin tones, melanoma is more likely to be on the

soles of the feet, the palms of the hands, and under the

## So, do black people really need to wear sunscreen?

Scrolling on social media is my favorite way to avoid my responsibilities. I was on TikTok one day and saw a video about Black people not needing sunscreen because our melanin is our natural protection.

Then I had a friend tell me that she uses shea butter as sunscreen at the beach (I know she was cooking like fried chicken in a cast iron skillet). It was at that point that I knew we needed to have a kitchen table talk/ read.

While our melanin does offer us protection, our natural SPF is very low. Also, when thinking of our ancestors and how they didn't have sunscreen to protect them against the sun, we have to put that statement and timeframe into context.

Baby they had a real ozone layer. We are living in peak environmental disaster and need to use all the sunscreen we can. I know "Black don't crack," but if you don't wear sunscreen daily, then you'll be aging like milk.

For all my skincare girlies, if you're working on hyperpigmentation, wearing sunscreen needs to be embedded in your routine. Dermatologists recommend using an SPF of 30 or higher that provides broad spectrum coverage with reapplication every two hours, especially if you're outdoors.

And yes, you can wear sunscreen and makeup! As much as I want us all to be outside having fun, I want us to be healthy and safe even more. Please wear your sunscreen, stay hydrated, and stay cool.

## Closing

Whether you're at the beach, on a hike, or reading under a tree, you need to wear sunscreen. Melanin, in all its beautiful shades and glory, is not a fair fight against overexposure to the sun.

There are so many different types of sunscreens, so find whichever one works best for you, pack a water bottle & fruit, and your favorite shorts, and live your best life!

## Let the people be heard: Should blacks celebrate the 4th of July?

Asked to deliver remarks about the 4th of July to residents of his hometown, Rochester, NY, Frederick Douglass didn't mince words. On July 5, 1852, during that 76th anniversary of all things red, white and blue, Douglass made plain his answer to the question, "Should blacks celebrate America's independence," saying:

"What, to the American slave, is your Fourth of July? I answer: a day that reveals to him, more than all other days in the year, the gross injustice and cruellity to which he is the constant victim. To him, your celebration is a sham; your boasted liberty, an unholy license; your national greatness, swelling vanity; your sounds of rejoicing are empty and heartless; your denunciations of tyrants, brass fronted impudence; your shouts of liberty and equality, hollow mockery."

In other words, no.

However, in the 169 years since Douglass blindsided that New York crowd with hard black facts, much has changed in America.

Or has it?

In all quality-of-life indicators, blacks remain woefully at the bottom, be they health, economic or education-related. Additionally, the national wealth enjoyed by blacks has scarcely changed since 1865, the year blacks were emancipated.

In that year, blacks controlled 0.5 percent of national wealth. In 1990, that amount had only increased by 0.5 percent, to a "whopping" 1 percent.

Moreover, of the 14 GOP U.S. House members who said: voted against making Juneteenth a federal holiday, all have either evidenced support of white power organizations and events, supported state Confederate Memorial Days or sided with other such things that many



interpret as anti-black.

Shawn D. Rochester, author of The Black Tax: The Cost of Being Black in America, laid out some harrowing numbers. First, the value of the labor stolen from enslaved blacks has been estimated to be from \$24-\$97 trillion.

Second, the value of four million enslaved blacks, America's most valuable commodity at the time, was \$15.5 trillion in terms of wealth and \$28 trillion in terms of GDP (Gross Domestic Product).

Third, the net worth (economic value) of blacks in the 21st century is roughly \$1.5 trillion, or 15 times lower than when enslaved.

Rochester's point: racism discrimination have cost blacks \$70-trillion and thus created today's massive racial wealth gap, economically leaving blacks in nearly the same economic shape experienced in 1865, just 13 years after Douglass' famous speech.

Thus, the Defender asked if Douglass' position on the 4th of July question still applies.

They understand the man-centered bias and manipulating that has gone into every holiday that is nationally observed in order to socially control society. So every Christian should ask this question over every nationally observed holiday and make sure that they are celebrating the good in it or the good that CAN be in it, if there is any good that can be celebrated in a national holiday. I can see the black community celebrating July 4th if they are celebrating the idealism of America, of freedom and equality, even though as we know that freedom and equality was only for certain kinds of people and

for worldly reasons. If a reconciliation of understanding was made with American politics and institutions then I can see a progressive view of July 4th being celebrated. But the understanding of the perspective of why what needs to be made clear and public by the reconciling black and white communities that are choosing to participate. And education and national understanding of black history untold needs to be elevated and supported in this as well. No more rewriting or hushing history and making us all just love "America" as envisioned by white society only. -Howard Lee Thomas III
