40th annual Bastille Days festival wraps up in Cathedral Square Park





Sunday, July 16, 2023 marked the final day of the four-day Frenchthemed Bastille Days festival held in Cathedral Square Park in downtown Milwaukee. "Esquires II" (pictured above) who were the last band to perform at the festival this year.

Bastille Days returned for its 40th year of celebrating French history and culture and, of course, food; and visitors to the festival seemed happy to see the event return to its pre-pandemic format. Organizers estimated more than 100,000 people attended the popular, free street festival this year.

Bastille Days commemorates the violent and forceful takeover by French citizens of the infamous Bastille Prison in Paris on July 14, 1789, marking the start of the French Revolution (hence the rallying cry "Storm the Bastille"). It also was the beginning of the end of France's days as a monarchy (both the king and queen were eventually beheaded); and the country's eventual adoption of a constitution and a republic form of representative government. Nowadays, Bastille Day in France is celebrated on July 14 as a national holiday, much like we in the United States celebrate July 4 as our nation's Independence Day.

With 2023's successful Bastille Days weekend now in the books, festival organizers are already looking forward to making it even bigger and better next year. À l'année prochaine..." (Loose translation: "See you next year!")

Cawker Park to be renamed for Milwaukee jazz legend Al Jarreau

If you're passing through the Amani neighborhood, a new, colorful mural may catch your eye.

Tucked in Cawker Park, 2929 N. 30th St., the City of Milwaukee Parks, along with several community partners, are creating a mural to honor the neighborhood.

The plans for the mural, a new playground, and painted basketball courts are part of a park revitalization effort. The city hopes to promote community engagement, improve public spaces, and honor Milwaukee's cultural heritage.

The park will soon be renamed Al Jarreau Park, in honor of the late Grammy award winning Milwaukee-born jazz musician. Who

graduated from the former Lincoln High school The project is led by a community mural artist, Tia Richardson. The park revitalization effort is also being led by Milwaukee Parks, Amani United, the Dominican Center, and Safe & Sound, Inc.

"He was very interested in helping people through music, and he used his art to Inspire others and bring light to the world," Richardson explained.

After listening sessions with neighborhood residents, Richardson created the design for a mural that honored both the singer and the Amani neighborhood where the parks sits.

"There's local musicians, the music, the basketball,



the beautiful colors, the sense of community. Everything the mural represents in the Amani community," Leesa McGhee, a lifelong Amani neighborhood resident, said.

Community painting sessions set for Friday, July 20th and Saturday, July 21st invited the neighborhood in to help paint the mural. Lifelong residents, curious kids, and even the neighborhood firefighters stopped by to pitch in.

"Community members can come through here and

see how they contributed to something that's going to be so vibrant and so great," Barbara Smith, chair for housing and economic development at Amani United, said with a smile.

Over the rest of the month, painting will continue with help from 250 youth from the Earn and Learn Camp Rise on scheduled days.

In collaboration with Activate Co., a creative agency specializing in public art projects, the basketball courts at Cawker Park will also be transformed.

The Rev. Jesse Jackson steps down as leader of civil rights group he founded in 1971

The Rev. Jesse Jackson announced Saturday, July 15, 2023, that he will step down as president of the Rainbow PUSH Coalition, the Chicago-based civil rights group he founded more than 50 years

Jackson, 81, announced his resignation during a quiet farewell speech at the organization's annual convention, where the group paid tribute to him with songs, kind words from other black activists and politicians, and a video montage of Jackson's 1984 and 1988 presidential campaigns.

Jackson, who has dealt with several health problems in recent years and uses a wheelchair, capped the proceedings with muted remarks. Flanked by his daughter, Santita Jackson, and his son, Congressmen Jonathan Jackson (D-IL), the once-fiery orator spoke so softly it was difficult to hear him.

"I am somebody," he said. Green or yellow, brown, black or white, we're all perfect in God's eyes. Everybody is somebody. Stop the violence. Save the children. Keep hope alive."

The Rev. Frederick Douglass Haynes, "a long-time student of Rev. Jackson and supporter" of the Rainbow PUSH Coalition, will take over as the group's leader, the coalition said in a statethe coalition said in a statement. Haynes is the pastor at Friendship-West Baptist Church in Dallas, TX, according to the church's web-

Jesse Jackson has been battling Parkinson's disease for the last eight years. He suffered a host of health set-



backs in 2021, beginning with gallbladder surgery, a COVID-19 infection that landed him in a physical therapy-focused facility and a fall at Howard University that caused a head injury.

Jackson has been a powerful advocate for civil rights and a strong voice in American politics for decades.

A protégé of the Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr., he broke with the Southern Christian Leadership Conference in 1971 to form Operation PUSH, initially named People United to Save Humanity, on Chicago's South Side. The organization was later renamed the Rainbow PUSH Coalition. The group's mission ranges from promoting minority hiring in the corporate world to voter registration drives in communities

Jackson has been a driving force in the modern civil rights movement, pushing for voting rights and education. Among other things, he joined George Floyd's family at a memorial for the slain black man and has participated in COVID-19 vaccination drives to counter black hesitancy about the

drugs.

Before Barack Obama was elected president in 2008, Jackson had been the most successful black presidential candidate. He won 13 primaries and caucuses in his push for the 1988 Democratic nomination, which went to Massachusetts Gov. Michael Dukakis.

Jackson said in his remarks that he plans to continue working on social justice issues, including advocating for three survivors of the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre who this week saw a judge dismiss their lawsuit seeking reparations.

"We're resigning, we're not retiring," Jackson said.

Ron Daniels, who works with the National African-American Reparations Commission, a panel working for financial payments to black people as compen-sation for slavery, told convention-goers that Jackson is a "synthesis" of King and another 1960s civil rights leader, Malcolm X.

"He is an authentic genius," Daniel said. "(Jackson) had the unparalleled capacity to frame and articulate ... political strategy in a way common, ordinary people could understand it."

Marcia Fudge, secretary of the U.S. Department Housing and Urban Development, thanked Jackson for paving the way for black politicians like herself.

"Most people talk a good game but they have no courage," she said. "But you never left us, no matter how hard (things became)."

Santita Jackson implored convention-goers to follow her father's lead and continue to fight for equality.

"Rev. Jackson has run his leg," she said. "What are you going to do?"

Study: Life expectancy for black Americans continues to lag behind that of whites, study finds

While disparities in life expectancy have narrowed over the past three decades, the COVID-19 pandemic has reversed some of that progress.

The life expectancy of black Americans has improved in recent decades, but it continues to lag behind that of white people, according to research published recently in the journal *Annals of Internal Medicine*.

The study underscores the need for further examination of how structural racism, including in housing and health care, plays a role in harming the health of black people, as well as the need for policies to address the issue, experts say.

"The interaction of race, ethnicity and geography is really profound and explains a lot of the gaps in health that we see in the United States," said lead study author Dr. Greg Roth, an associate professor of medicine at the University of Washington School of Medicine.

In the study, Roth and his team looked at death records and U.S. census data to estimate life expectancy for white, black and Hispanic Americans from 1990 through 2019.

They found that while life expectancy improved for each of the groups over the last three decades, black Americans consistently had the lowest life expectancy of any of the groups.



The disparities fluctuated among states — Missouri saw the largest increase in life expectancy disparities over the time period, while Massachusetts, Connecticut and Oregon saw the largest decreases, according to the study.

What's more, the researchers found widening disparities within the black community, with life expectancy varying by state.

Black women in Rhode Island, for example, had a longer average life expectancy (about 87 years) than black women in Washington, DC, (about 76 years), according to the study. For black men, the average life expectancy in Rhode Island was about 81 years, and about 67 years in Washington, DC.

Roth said the disparities between the states looked as if people were "living in different countries."

The findings mirror those from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's National Center for Health Statistics, said Elizabeth Arias, a health scientist for the center who analyzes national death data. She was not involved in the new study.

Arias said black Americans have historically had a lower life expectancy than non-Hispanic white Americans; in the 1900s, white people's life expectancy was, on average, 14 years longer than that of black people's.

By 2019, she said, the country saw progress, with the gap narrowing to four

years. The COVID-19 pandemic, however, has started to reverse that, with white people now living on average five years longer than black people.

Had the pandemic not happened, it's "very likely" that the gap in life expectancy between black and white people would have continued to decline, she said.

Dr. Gbenga Ogedegbe, the director of the division of health and behavior at New York University's Grossman School of Medicine, said that the U.S. can improve the life expectancy of black Americans by making investments in housing, health care and education. He was not involved in the study.

Black Americans have historically had lower life expectancy compared to white Americans, he said, due in part to the discriminatory practices of denying services to people based on their race.

Ogedegbe mentioned redlining, a discriminatory housing policy that saw lenders refuse to issue credit to borrowers in communities of color. The practice not only impacted where black people lived, he said, but where they could receive health care, find jobs and get an education.

At that point, "ZIP code could actually predict life expectancy," he said.

Ogedegbe also said more physicians and health care workers have to become advocates for policies that reduce inequities in health care.

"I don't think we've done a good job of training our physicians to be health care advocates for justice," he said.

Roth, the author of the study, also called for states to adopt interventions in diet and access to education to "disrupt the cycle of poverty that we see in some communities."

"These gaps are really large and life expectancy, when you measure it for these groups within each state, paints a really concerning picture," he said.






