Coggs, who brought the concept many years ago to neighborhoods across the city. This partnership has not only included residents old and young from the neighborhood, but featured partners have been the City of Milwaukee, Groundworks, and Jan Carroll.

The Hop to launch lakefront streetcar route this October

The lakefront line service will begin on Oct. 29 but will initially only run on Sundays due to construction

Milwaukee's streetcar, The Hop, will begin its new lakefront service this fall, but with a limitation in place.

According to the Milwaukee Business Journal, the service will kick off on October 29, 2023. But, because of the construction of the Couture apartment tower, initially, it will only operate on Sundays.

The soft opening, featuring the Sunday-only schedule, will last until April, 2024, when daily service will begin and the station located under the Couture will open.

"We don't have sidewalks that would be accessible," Milwaukee Department of Public Works commission-



er Jerrel Kruschke said. "If I decided to drop off a passenger at the Couture site, they couldn't access Clybourn or Michigan (streets). That's why we are not going to be utilizing those stops until they turn over that entire concourse to us. It's for safety of passengers."

However, the city could add a Saturday service between October 2023 and April 2024. It all just depends on the construction timing of the Couture.

The lakefront line will run along Michigan and Clybourn streets, with most of the track built in 2017 and 2018. The opening of the lakefront track had been delayed due to delays in the groundbreaking and construction of the Couture Tower.

Due to the delays, the city had to work with federal officials to extend deadlines for the start of service. The federal grant that financed most of the lakefront route had set a deadline of 2020 for start of service. But, the city worked with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to get the deadline pushed to October

"Everyone wants the streetcar to run seven days a week, just like us," Kruschke said.

"We think it is going to be fantastic for ridership. It's going to be an access point for the lakefront. So far, we've satisfied everything the FTA wants."

Once it's operational, the lakefront line, or L-line, will run separately from the existing downtown M-line so riders will need to transfer onto it from stations at North Broadway and North Milwaukee streets.

There will be L-line service at stations near Jackson Street at both Michigan and Clybourn, plus the central Couture station which will be operational come April.

"Tree had everyone's backs; he saw the potential in everyone and sought to nurture it.

So said Tomiko Brown-Nagin, dean of the Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study at Harvard and professor of constitutional law at Harvard Law School, and one of Harvard Law School Professor Charles Ogletree's many colleagues, admirers, and friends. Charles Ogletree, who died August 4, was one of our nation's preeminent legal scholars and a lifelong champion for racial and social justice. Many of his friends have noted "Tree" was an appropriate nickname for a man who felt like a giant, standing tall and steadfast and protecting and nurturing others around him. This always included his students, especially the black students who attended the beloved "Saturday School" enrichment sessions he led at Harvard Law School. President Barack Obama and First Lady Michelle Obama were both among his brilliant mentees.

As President Obama remembered: "Eventually, Saturday School became so popular that students of every background began showing up to hear Charles explain things in a way they could understand. It was an example of the kind of person Charles has always been: unfailingly helpful, and driven by a genuine concern for others." This concern extended far beyond his own circles. I am especially grateful for his legacy as a steadfast champion of nurturing all children's potential and embracing proven child development strategies before children, especially poor children of color, ended up in the criminal justice system.


He grew up poor himself as the child and grandchild of farm workers in Merced, California, the oldest of seven siblings, and the first in his family to graduate from high school. His parents separated when he was young and he moved between family mem-



bers' households often. But he loved to read, finding freedom and escape in piles of library books read by flashlight, and as a self-identified "Brown baby" who benefited from the doors opened by Brown v. Board of Education he understood the impact access to education made in his own life: "To me, it is the key that turns things in the right direction. Educating every child makes an enormous amount of difference."

When a high school guidance counselor first suggested he apply to Stanford University, two hours from home, he had not yet heard of it. But he took the counselor's advice and was accepted with a scholarship. He would later remember that on his way to start his freshman year he thought he had a flat tire and actually turned around and went home, but was surprised by what happened next: "When I got back to my house, my brothers and my sister had moved my bed out completely. I said, 'What's going on here?!' and they said, 'You're the first to go from high school to college and we want you to succeed.' I had no choice." He turned back around and he did indeed succeed, first at Stanford, where he earned his bachelor's and master's degrees, and then at Harvard Law School before beginning his long and storied career. Just as he'd been a role model for his younger siblings, he became one for countless

Throughout it all he used his talents to help make sure other young people could also receive fair access to education and opportunity. He testified before Congress, wrote, and spoke often on the need for juvenile justice reform and positive interventions for at-risk children, and



moderated a Children's Defense Fund conference panel around the shared mission of ending the Cradle to Prison Pipeline® crisis. As he said in one interview: "It's one thing to talk about trying to change the way we look at children. It's another thing to give it some teeth so that it makes a big difference . . . If we do this, if we really embrace this ... we will save a generation of children from what others have experienced in the past, and we will create a generation of smart, healthy, excited, energetic, competent, and resourceful young leaders for tomorrow."

Charles Ogletree had a clear vision for how our nation could be better and more just for everyone, and he spent his life fighting for that vision and teaching others the tools they needed to join him. He often quoted one of his favorite gospel songs:

I don't feel no ways tired, I've come too far from where I started from. Nobody told me that the road would be easy, I don't believe He brought me this far to leave me.

Four tips to help relive your child's back-to-school anxiety

Back-to-School season is upon us – if you couldn't tell by the uniforms and school supplies strewn all over every department store. And, as the yearly routine goes, there are a few tykes somewhere in the world begging their parents not to leave them at school.

There may be an actual reason behind your child's unwillingness to go to school besides what some parents perceive as cute stubbornness. Ever heard of school refusal? According to the Anxiety and Depression Association of America, your child's refusal to go to school or stay in school may be the first sign of a mental disorder.

This anxiety-based illness usually affects two to five percent of all school-age children. Experts say the refusal occurs during those transitional -sometimes-scary school years, such as entering kindergarten, middle and high school.

The main symptom is complaining of physical illness shortly before it's time to head to school:

Your child was feeling fine last night. But all of a sudden, around six a.m., as you all prepare for the school day, your little one is complaining of a headache or stomachache. Then, if you let your child stay home, the symptoms disappear without any treatment only to return the next morning.

Here are four ways to help your child:

1. Talk to your child about their feelings and fears.

Sometimes, especially at early ages, children may have developed a fear that something will happen to their parents while they are at school. It's best to have an open discussion with your little one to find out what's bothering them and how that may be triggering their fear of going to school.

It's important to create an environment where your child feels comfortable expressing their concerns and worries. You can start by initiating open conversations about school, addressing their fears and acknowledging their feelings. Let them know that their emotions are valid and that you're there to support them.

2. Help your child establish a support system.

It's great if your child comes to you for advice on any and every topic. But some children may feel like they can't have deep discussions with their parents. Help your child create a list of family members and teachers that can step in and give trust-



worthy advice when needed.

You can also reach out to friends from their previous school year or arrange playdates with classmates they'll see again. Reconnecting with familiar faces can help ease the fear of the unknown.

3. Expose your child to school in small doses.

Dropping off your little one at kindergarten can be frightening if they haven't had any exposure to school before. If your child didn't attend preschool, find some extracurricular activities that could get your child acclimated to the social elements of a classroom setting.

It may also help to arrange a visit to the school before the academic year starts. Walking through the hallways, locating classrooms, and meeting teachers can help alleviate some of the unknowns and reduce anxiety associated with the new environment.

A consistent daily routine provides a sense of predictability that can ease anxiety, but remember to start small so you don't overwhelm your child. For example, you can gradually adjust their sleep schedule and meal times to align with the school routine. Having a structured plan can help reduce uncertainty.

If your child's stress is particularly intense, consider

creating a transition plan. Start with shorter visits to school, gradually increasing the duration until they feel more comfortable.

Involve your child in backto-school preparations. Let them choose their school supplies, backpack, and even their first-day outfit. This sense of ownership and control can boost their confidence and excitement.

4. Speak with a therapist.

If your child's school refusal continues for more than a couple of weeks, it may be best to speak with a therapist. There could be some other event that triggered your child's anxiety about school that only a professional can detect and help treat.






