

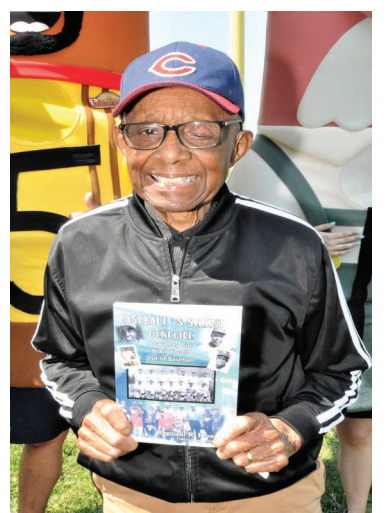
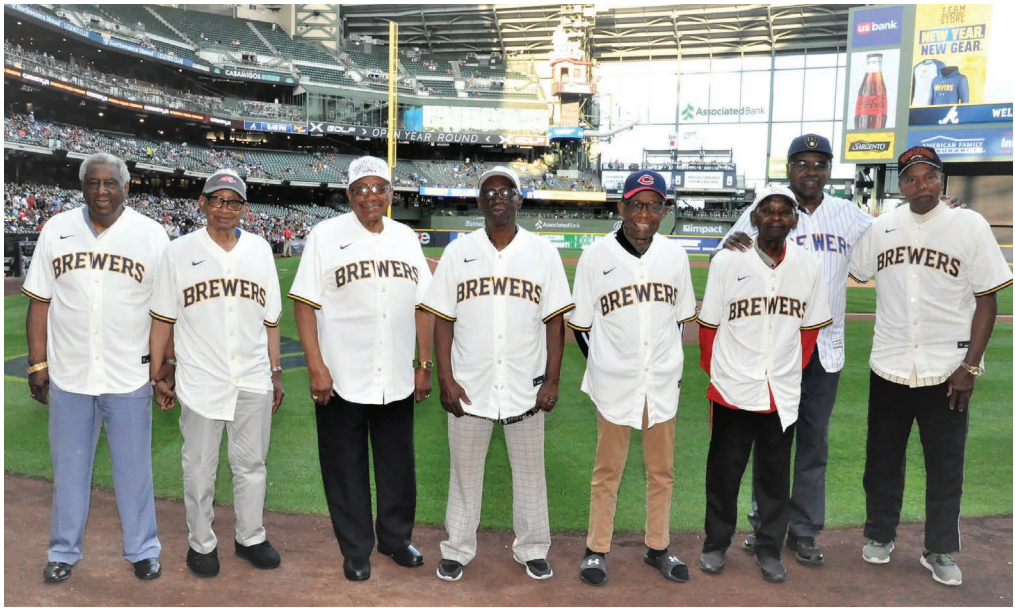

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Dr. The event honored the naming of Athletic Park (later renamed Borchert Field), the city's first professional ballpark as a historic landmark. For 64 years, Borchert Field was Milwaukee's major sports venue that for generations provided Wisconsin residents a close-up view of sports history in the making. Biden-Harris administration opens nearly \$100M in grant opportunities for HBCUs, TCCUs, MSIs and underserved students

The U.S. Department of Education (DOE) announced Tuesday, August 1, 2023 the launch of two grant programs to expand research infrastructure in our nation's historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs), tribally controlled colleges and universities (TCCUs), and minority-serving Institutions (MSIs), and to increase completion and retention rates among underserved students.



The grants, which will provide nearly \$100-million for transformational infrastructure investments and evidence-based strategies for improved student outcomes for underserved students, follow more than \$25-billion in funding to HBCUs, MSIs, and TCCUs through the Department since President Biden took office. Specifically, this consists of \$7.3-billion in cumulative investments for 98 HBCUs, \$474.5-million to 35 TCCUs, and \$18.1-billion to support MSIs.

“At a time when diversity in higher education is under attack, it’s never been more important to invest in our nation’s historically black colleges and universities, tribal colleges and universities, minority-serving insti-

tutions, community colleges, and other inclusive institutions,” said U.S. Secretary of Education Miguel Cardona. “These grant programs represent opportunities for our nation’s most inclusive and diverse colleges and universities to expand their capacity to drive research and innovation and strengthen evidence-based supports that help underserved students successfully complete their degrees and build brighter futures. The Biden-Harris Administration will continue working to raise the bar for excellence and equity in higher education and invest in institutions committed to helping students of all backgrounds and income levels reach their potential and pursue their dreams.”

HBCU, TCCU, and MSI Research and Development Infrastructure Grant Program

The Historically Black Colleges or Universities, Tribally Controlled Colleges or Universities, and Minority-Serving Institutions Research and Development Infrastructure Grant Program (RDI) will provide \$50-million to HBCUs, TCCUs, and MSIs to implement transformational investments in research infrastructure, including research productivity, faculty expertise, graduate programs, physical infrastructure, human capital development, and partnerships leading to increases in external funding.

For HBCUs and MSIs, the grant will support insti-

tutions in increasing their level of research activity in alignment with the Carnegie Classification designations to move from the Doctoral and Professional Universities (D/PU) classification toward the Doctoral Universities with High Research Activity (R2) classification; or from the Doctoral Universities with High Research Activity (R2) classification towards the Doctoral Universities with Very High Research Activity (R1) classification.

For TCCUs, which have their own Carnegie Classification designation and cannot be classified as R1, R2, or D/PU, the funds will support an increase in research activities, undergraduate research opportunities, faculty development, research development, and infrastructure, including physical infrastructure and human capital development.

Postsecondary Student Success Grant

Aligned with the goals in the DOE’s Raise the Bar Initiative, the Postsecondary Student Success Grant (PSSG) application is now open to institutions to support underserved students. The PSSG grant aims to equitably improve postsecondary student outcomes, including retention, trans-

fer, credit accumulation, and completion, by leveraging data and implementing, scaling, and rigorously evaluating evidence-based activities to support data-driven decisions and actions by institutional leaders committed to inclusive student success.

Many students of color and with low incomes still face barriers to successfully enrolling in and completing college, and as the number of non-traditional students in postsecondary education increases, additional and different supports are required to enable students to successfully complete their credentials. This grant program will provide \$45-million to fund evidence-based strategies that result in improved student outcomes for underserved students. The competition will consider applications in two tiers—early phase and mid-phase/expansion—based upon the amount of existing research validating their effectiveness.

Bringing truth to light

On July 25, the day that would have been Emmett Till's 82nd birthday, President Joe Biden hosted a White House signing ceremony for a proclamation establishing the Emmett Till and Mamie Till-Mobley National Monument in Mississippi and Illinois. Three sites are now part of this monument honoring Emmett Till, who had just turned 14 when he was abducted, tortured, and lynched in Mississippi in August 1955, and his devoted mother Mamie. Her decision to defy authorities who wanted Emmett's body buried quickly in Mississippi, and instead to hold his funeral in Chicago with an open casket to let the world see what his hateful racist murderers had done to her child, became an inflection point in the Civil Rights Movement. This new monument underscores our nation's need to keep exposing and acknowledging the truth today.

President Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris

were joined at the ceremony by members of Emmett Till's family, including his cousin, Reverend Wheeler Parker, Jr. The cousins lived next door to each other in Chicago and were best friends, and during that summer break Wheeler and Emmett traveled together to spend a two-week visit with relatives near Money, Mississippi. Wheeler was with Emmett at Bryant's Grocery and Meat Market the day Carolyn Bryant falsely said Emmett grabbed and propositioned her after buying two cents' worth of bubble gum, and he was in the room four nights later when Roy Bryant and J.W. Milam came to their family's house, dragged Emmett out of bed at gunpoint, and drove off with him. As he spoke at the ceremony honoring his cousin, Rev. Wheeler Parker, Jr. said: "When I sat with my family on the night of terror, when Emmett Till, our beloved 'Bobo,' was taken from us, taken to be tortured and brutally murdered—back then, when I was overwhelmed

with terror and fear of certain death in the darkness of a thousand midnights, in a pitch-black house on what some have called Dark Fear Road, back then in the darkness, I could never imagine a moment like this: standing in the light of wisdom, grace, and deliverance."

Rev. Parker is imagining a powerful moment for all of us. The first site in the National Monument, the Graball Landing river site, is in the area along the Tallahatchie River near Glendora, Mississippi where Emmett's mutilated body was recovered. A memorial sign installed nearby in 2008 was destroyed and two replacements were repeatedly riddled with bullets and vandalized over the next decade, and these contemporary acts of white supremacy and hatred are also exposed here. The second site is the Roberts Temple Church of God in Christ in Chicago, where as many as 125,000 people attended Emmett Till's vis-

itation and funeral services, documented in the searing photographs and news coverage. The third is the Tallahatchie County Second District Courthouse in Sumner, Mississippi, where Roy Bryant and J.W. Milam were tried in a segregated courtroom and acquitted by an all-white jury after just over an hour of deliberation. Months later they both admitted their guilt in a paid magazine interview. No one was held accountable for Emmett Till's murder, but together these three sites are a public, permanent reminder that the truth could not be buried.

During a week when the Florida State Board of Education approved new public school curriculum standards to teach children that enslaved people received a "personal benefit" from slavery, this message about the truth was not lost on anyone at the ceremony. President Biden said: "At a time when there are those who seek to ban books, bury history, we're making it clear—crystal, crystal clear—while darkness and denialism can hide much, they erase nothing. They can hide, but they erase nothing. We can't just choose to learn what we want to know. We have to

learn what we should know. We should know about our country. We should know everything: the good, the bad, the truth of who we are as a nation. That's what great nations do . . . Only with truth comes healing, justice, repair, and another step forward toward forming a more perfect union." And as Vice President Harris put it: "Today, there are those in our nation who would prefer to erase or even rewrite the ugly parts of our past; those who attempt to teach that enslaved people benefitted from slavery; those who insult us in an attempt to gaslight us, who try to divide our nation with unnecessary debates. Let us not be seduced into believing that somehow we will be better if we forget. We will be better if we remember. We will be stronger if we remember. Because we all here know: It is only by understanding and learning from our past that we can continue to work together to build a better future." The truth must be brought to light.







Living with fibroids: “My uterus was the size of a six-month pregnancy”

During their cycles, many women experience heavy bleeding, bloating, cramps, migraines, etc. Many of these symptoms are a normal part of going through your menstrual period. However, what many women don't know is that, in some cases, they can also be a sign of something far more serious.



Grace, a fibroids patient, knows that feeling all too well. Although she was officially diagnosed with fibroid tumors in 2012, she's been living in pain since high school.

“Every time I had my cycle in high school I would end up in the nurse's office because I was in so much pain. No one told me I had fibroids. I was just told that it was normal, this is what every girl goes through and so I thought that pain was normal. Every month I would go through that excruciating pain and I thought it was normal,” Grace shared.

The thought that painful periods that consist of heavy bleeding are normal is something that many women fall victim to, including the women in Grace's family.

“I have two other sisters and they both were diagnosed with fibroids later on in life; but when we were in high school we didn't know what it was. We just thought it was normal. Even when I spoke to my mom, she had bad cramps as well. So she grew up with it and she wasn't officially diagnosed,” Grace added. “Back in those days, they didn't really go to the hospital for that so my mother didn't really officially get diagnosed. But after my diagnosis, I concluded that my mother did have fibroids as well.”

By the time Grace finally got a diagnosis, she was in college. She had spent years being poorly examined by several doctors with no answers or options for treatment besides ibuprofen.

“I was getting sick every month. I would have to miss class. I would be in so much pain and I thought this is not normal, 'I need to see a doctor,’” Grace recalled.

After undergoing an ultrasound and other testing, Grace finally had the answers she had been searching for. However, she wasn't exactly sure what fibroids were.

“I didn't know what fibroids were. None of my friends were talking about it. I didn't know anybody talking about fibroids. It's like it wasn't something you talked about. It wasn't in the news so I didn't really know what it was. I was initially shocked because I wonder what is this disease? Is it contagious? Is it

gonna kill me?,” the spokesperson for the White Dress Project, a non-profit organization aimed at promoting education around uterine fibroids, shared.

Like many of the 80 percent of black women living with fibroids, the only treatment option Grace received was a hysterectomy. Grace, who'd never had surgery, wasn't ready for that option so she decided to wait it out to see if the fibroids grew.

“I thought OK what can I do in the meantime,” Grace said.

She opted to take birth control pills to manage her symptoms. “Once I got on the pill, my pain was still there but it was slightly reduced. And then every time my period came, I would start taking medication a few days prior – like my ibuprofen. It also regulated my cycle so every time I knew when to expect it, so it lightened up,” Grace noted.

The pain was reduced just enough to allow Grace to go to school normally.

Eventually, Grace sought the advice of another doctor. She was given two options: a hysterectomy (a surgical operation to remove all or part of the uterus) or a myomectomy (an operation to remove fibroids while preserving the uterus).

Although a hysterectomy would have eliminated Grace's problem altogether, she wanted to have children so she opted to continue with natural alternatives, such as diet and exercise throughout her schooling.

Exercising helped her combat the lack of energy she had due to low iron, however, she noticed that her abdomen was growing larger.

“My doctor told me my uterus had stretched to the size of a six-month pregnancy and the size was nearly 21 centimeters,” Grace shared. “My clothes didn't fit right. I was constantly shopping for new clothes because I just felt like clothes did not look good on me.”

She ultimately decided to go through with a myomectomy, which allowed her to preserve her uterus and still be able to conceive. After the surgery, her uterus went back to the normal size of six centimeters.

Living with fibroids

She did experience some relief, but it was short-lived. Last year, Grace's fibroids returned. She hasn't decided on her next method of treatment, but as she weighs her options, she is looking at non-invasive options instead of going under the knife again. One option she is considering is uterine fibroid embolization (UFE), which wasn't an option for her before due to the size of her fibroids. UFE is a minimally invasive procedure used to block blood flow to fibroid tumors, causing them to shrink.

Grace's advice to women living with fibroids

Find the right doctor. "Find a good doctor that you feel listens to you, understands you and you connect with and try to get those symptoms treated as soon as you can."

Find a therapist. "Finding a therapist to help you through what you go through—that's really important—because having fibroids really affects you mentally...and it adds a lot of stress to your life."

Find a community. "Finding a community also is very important. I would tell women to find other communities out there that can provide resources."

Grace recommends *The Uterine Health Guide*, a digital repository created by Sumitomo Pharma America and Pfizer that contains information about menstrual health, including conditions such as uterine fibroids. *The Uterine Health Guide* also offers advice for talking to your

doctor and finding support in your community.

When to talk to a doctor about fibroids

Grace noted that "your body usually tells you when something is off."

If you are experiencing any of the following, it's a good idea to schedule an appointment with your doctor to get tested for fibroids:

- Heavy bleeding (which can be heavy enough to cause anemia) or painful periods
- Feeling of fullness in the pelvic area (lower abdominal area)
- Enlargement of the lower abdomen
- Frequent urination
- Pain during sex
- Lower back pain
- Complications during pregnancy and labor, including a six-time greater risk of Cesarean section
- Reproductive problems, such as infertility, which is very rare

The good news is that there are several treatment options available for fibroids, including:

- Medications – Used to help treat some of the symptoms associated with uterine fibroids
- Gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) antagonists – Decrease heavy periods associated with fibroids
- Minimally invasive procedures – Destroy the fibroids
- Surgery – Hysterectomy (surgical removal of the uterus) or myomectomy (removal of fibroids from the uterus)

Your doctor can help you address your fibroids and find the best method of treatment for you as each case is different.
