CC Sabathia visits Milwaukee to commemorate 15th anniversary of 2008 playoff run

On Friday, August 25, 2023, former star pitcher CC Sabathia returned to Milwaukee, appearing during the Brewers game against the San Diego Padres that night and commemorating the 15th anniversary of his legendary 2008 run. It's the first time Sabathia has been back to Milwaukee since 2014, when he pitched for the New York Yankees.

Sabathia's Herculean performance in 2008 helped the Brewers reach the playoffs for the first time in 26 years. He went 11-2 with a 1.65 ERA, working frequently on three days rest, and gave the Brewers a complete-game effort in the finale for a 3-1 win over the Cubs that clinched the franchise's first postseason berth in a generation.

The first 20,000 fans received a commemorative poster of the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel sports front page that commemorated the occasion. Sabathia also threw out the ceremonial first pitch (left photo). Sabathia threw seven complete games, including three shutouts, in his brief tenure as a Brewer, beginning with a blockbuster trade from Cleveland in early July of 2008. On Saturday August 26, 2023, the African American Breastfeeding Network (AABN) hosted the "9th Annual Lift Up Every Baby!," Heritage Green at Westlawn Gardens, 6201 W. Custer Ave. This year's theme "Oh, What A Joy!" highlights the joys of the journey of parenthood, the beauty and blessings of birth, babies and breastfeeding. The AABN's annual Lift Up Every Baby! event was started in 2015 to acknowledge community and family resiliencies, and cultural norms irrespective of inequities and health disparities.

The event kicks off with an opening cultural ceremony of 'lifting babies up' as a way to demonstrate what we wish and hope for our children and our community. Pregnant and new parents can attend seven health/wellness stations to learn better self-help techniques and tips to achieve improved overall health. In keeping with the theme, fathers/partners expressions of joy gathering reminds Dads of the glees of becoming a parent and the amusement of fatherhood. Other event highlights were children play and craft area, free boy hair cuts, community connectors/resources, book bags and school supply give away, a community dinner, and community baby shower. There were also many community leaders present like Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson and State Senator Lena Taylor who offered blessing and well wishes to the families (second row, left photo).

Over 200 families have registered for this event. This event is hosted by the City of Milwaukee Housing Authority, and the Best Babies Zone, and other sponsoring organizations. The African American Breastfeeding Network was founded in 2008 by Angelia Wilks-Tate and Dalvery Blackwell (second row, left photo, center) set their eyes on addressing breastfeeding disparities and came together on a sunny June afternoon with a host of community leaders to discuss forming an organization.



MPS Foundation launches Classroom Support Fund for teachers and students

The Milwaukee Public Schools Foundation is raising money through donations, a telethon, and a free concert fundraiser for its new Classroom Support Fund. The fund will be used for supplies year-round for teachers and students at 25 MPS schools.

In its announcement, the foundation said the initiative comes in response to reports that more than 90 percent of teachers pay for school supplies themselves.

Already, the foundation has received a significant gift toward the fund: \$40,000 from Educators Credit Union.

The foundation said it is taking a transformative approach to classroom-supplies fundraising. The fund, modeled on the Madison Public Schools Foundation's Teacher Support Network, aims to provide sustained, year-round assistance.

In its first year, the fund will provide 25 schools with funds for traditional and nontraditional materials, personal supplies, teacher grants, and other items nec-

essary for teaching and learning.

Funding will be available for items such as books, headphones, calculators, and recess equipment. It also extends to students' personal needs, such as soap, deodorant, hair products, feminine hygiene products, food, and clothing. The teacher grants are meant to enhance student learning and invest in teachers' professional growth.

Donors can learn more about the new fund and contribute at mpsfdn.org/classroomsupportfund.

People also can help support the fund through two events in August. Jammin' 98.3 will host a two-day telethon August 24-25; tune in to hear positive stories from MPS alumni and contribute. On August 25, a free concert by MPS alum Emmitt James and his 13-piece band will take place at Third Space Brewing, 1505 W. St.



Paul Ave. The event, a fundraiser for the initiative, will run from 7:00-11:00 p.m. It kicks off with free barbecue by Daddy's Soul Food and Grille, vendors and games, and will be capped by the concert.

As educators in Milwaukee face shortages and burnout, we hope our effort can make a modest contribution to those in most need. We extend our gratitude to Educators Credit Union for their belief in this endeavor, and we hope their generosity ignites a spirit of giving in others."

The foundation's initiative is in partnership with Milwaukee Public Schools and EZ Office Products, the Madison-based office-supply company with a focus on sustainability. Through the partnership, teachers and schools will be able to shop online and have supplies delivered directly to their school throughout the year.

The Classroom Support Fund replaces the annual back-to-school No Empty Backpacks campaign, which was held by the MPS Foundation, the school district, and 88Nine Radio Milwaukee for seven years.

Back to school guide on staying healthy

For many of us, the school year has just begun, and for others, it is just around the corner. As a result, we are seeing an increase in colds, viruses, and COVID-19 cases. Teachers, parents, and school officials are all looking for ways to keep germs from spreading in their classrooms daily during the upcoming school year.

While it is true that schools can be an incubator for the spread of different illnesses, it does not have to be this way. During the upcoming school year, we have set up a guide that will help keep illnesses at bay in the classroom and at home this year!

1. Sanitize, sanitize and sanitize again

As a child, you are taught that sharing is caring throughout the entire time that you are in grade school. There are a lot of things that can be shared, such as toys, and pencils, among other things.

In the process of sharing these items, it is also possible that you are sharing germs as well. Keeping frequently touched items in the classroom as clean and sanitized as possible is a super important part of keeping germs at bay (especially if you have younger kids in your classroom!).

It is also important to wipe down desks and chairs. A great gift for a teacher would be a pack of sanitizing wipes or sprays.

2. Wash your hands

It can be said that if there is one thing that is shared a lot in school, it would be snacks! We do not realize how many germs are left on our hands after touching playground equipment, door handles, and stairwells.

Therefore, we do not realize how quickly we could be passing around germs. The most important thing you can do for your health is to wash your hands as frequently as possible.

You should use soap and water if you have access to



them. Hand sanitizer is the second best option that can be used.

3. If you are feeling sick, stay at home

If you are feeling unwell, the best thing that you can do to prevent the spread of viruses and colds is to stay at home. (And let's be honest –

no one wants to sit next to someone who is constantly sneezing and coughing.)

Therefore, if you start to feel under the weather, your best bet is to go to the doctor and follow their advice and protocols regarding how long you should stay at home.

It is very important to stay at home when you have a fever until it has gone down and you are feeling better. Talk to your child's teacher to see what they can work on at home if you are concerned that your child might fall behind in school while they are recovering.

4. Cover your mouth when you cough

To stay healthy, it is important that you cover your mouth whenever you cough or sneeze. It is recommended by the CDC that you should always cough or sneeze into the elbow if you can.

If you find yourself coughing or sneezing in your hands (because it can be an awful habit to break) just make sure to wash your hands with warm water and soap as soon

as you can.

5. Wash reusable water bottles

Did you know that reusable water bottles could be a breeding ground for germs? These bottles typically travel everywhere and collect and harvest bacteria.

A 2022 study revealed that a reusable water bottle can contain 40,000 times more bacteria than a toilet seat. (So gross.) Regularly washing reusable water bottles with warm soapy water after each use is essential to prevent the buildup of germs and bacteria.

Try using a bottle brush to make it an easy process! Also, make sure to let the bottle dry completely to prevent the growth of new mold.
