This is Austin's first venture into mass production. Austin was inducted into the Wisconsin Black History Society on March 21, 2023, and she is now listed in their historical archives. The event was intended to honor the legacy of Austin as well as the expansion of her company into the retail sector.

Austin makes every one of her cakes with a heavenly touch of love. Founded in 2013, Martha set out on a journey to bake her way into the heart of Milwaukee. From her baking to catering ventures, each of Memah's cakes, pies, and meals is full of homemade goodness with a dash of her spectacular personality. The mix was designed and created by Austin for mass production and retail beginning in 2023.

Milwaukee's Bishop Sedgwick Daniels passes; church, community mourn

Members of Milwaukee's Holy Redeemer Institutional Church of God in Christ are in mourning in the wake of Bishop Sedgwick Daniels' death.

"He will truly, truly be missed," said Michelle Pitts, a longtime friend of Bishop Daniels.

"It is a call you never want to receive about a friend."

Pitts owns a funeral home in Milwaukee. Now the person who helps others grieve is experiencing grief of her own.

"I felt as if I was falling apart," Pitts said. "I will never see him again. I'll never hear his voice again. But his spirit will live on and I will feel him day after day. I will remember the words he would say, that 'nothing is too hard for God'."

Pitts said she has been

friends with Bishop Daniels for more than 50 years. The 64-year-old died on Sunday, Nov. 12, 2023.

"He loved children, he loved the elderly, he loved his church, he loved his family. If he didn't care for you, you never knew it because he shared so much love," Pitts said.

Daniels was not only known for being the bishop

at Holy Redeemer; he also helped found a school, a senior living center and even opened a health clinic.

"I remember one time Bishop Daniels was talking about opening up an orphanage. He just wanted a piece of everybody, he wanted to help everybody," Pitts said.

Even in death, Pitts said Daniels' church, family and friends will keep the bishop's

legacy alive.

"If you could just take a piece of who Bishop Daniels was, it would make this world a much better place," Pitts said.

At the time of this publication, funeral arrangements have not been announced.

State Senate voting on Brewers funding bill, lawmakers express optimism after 11th hour negotiations



State Sen. Dan Feyen, (R-Fond du Lac) said Republicans will introduce an amendment to the Brewers funding bill that Feyen said will secure the bipartisan votes needed to pass.

Just before the session began at 8 a.m., Feyen said the amendment will restore Milwaukee and Milwaukee County's appointees to what would be the new stadium district board and gradual-

ly increase a new ticket tax on non-game events to help bring down the state's contribution to the overall deal.

Sunday, Nov. 12, 2023 on WISN-TV 12's 'UPFRONT,' both Feyen and Senate Minority Leader Melissa Agard said the votes weren't yet there to pass the

bill as negotiations intensified throughout the weekend and into Monday.

Before the new amendment, the Senate plan included a state contribution of roughly \$382-million through taxes collected on player salaries; \$135-million would come from Milwaukee and Milwaukee County,

and the Brewers would contribute an additional \$110-million.

As of Tuesday, Nov. 14, 2023, both bills dealing with the Brewers stadium, AB 438 and AB 439, passed the State Senate by a vote of 14-9. The bills will now be sent back to the Assembly for consideration.

Missy Elliott says 'words cannot describe' being first female rapper inducted into Rock & Roll Hall of Fame

Missy Elliott still can't quite believe that she is the first female rap artist to be inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame (RRHOF) on Friday, Nov. 3, 2023. Speaking to *Good Morning America's* (GMA) Robin Roberts on Thursday Nov. 2, 2023, Elliott said she always dreamed of being a "superstar... I never wavered. I never changed. I said it every time," but after three decades in the music business the 52-year-old Grammy-winning rapper said her latest accolade is unfathomable.

Elliott said "words cannot describe" how honored she is to take the stage alongside fellow 2023 inductees Kate Bush, Sheryl Crow, George Michael, Willie Nelson, Rage Against the Machine and The Spinners. She told Roberts that as an artist from the hip-hop world, Rock Hall enshrinement seemed "so far out of reach." Plus, with this being the 50th anniversary of the birth of hip-hop, Elliott said the Hall of Fame kudos is further proof that "no matter what people say the hip-hop world is something special and unique."



Joking that as a kid her family once convinced her that she was related to another one of this year's inductees, musical excellence honoree R&B legend Chaka Khan, Elliott said being ushered in alongside the likes of Nelson and Crow is indescribable. "To be even at a table with them is a blessing, past a blessing, there's got to be a bigger word than that," she said.

Elliott will be among just a handful of rappers whose plaques are on display at the RRHOF museum in Cleveland, joining such icons as Jay-Z, LL Cool J, The Notorious B.I.G., Tupac Shakur,

N.W.A, Public Enemy, The Beastie Boys, Run-DMC and Grandmaster Flash and the Furious Five. And though some critics might quibble at the elastic definition of rock and roll that has found artists who don't play what is traditionally considered amplified, guitar-based rock music, Elliott said in her mind rock, like hip-hop, is a "gumbo of different styles of music."

Elliott was inducted by her friend of 20 years, Queen Latifah, who she praised as someone who, "come before me, opened that door, left it open... And I owe so many flowers, bouquets. It's not enough bouquets for those

women that came before me. And she's one of those women." In addition, Elliott's mother will be in the house at the 38th annual induction ceremony at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn.

Believe it or not, Elliott's mom had never seen her perform live before. "She's never been to a show because, you know, I had some little words I didn't ever want her to hear," Elliott told *GMA*. "And so she's comin' for the first time."

The event featured presenters and performers Olivia Rodrigo, Stevie Nicks, Adam Levine, Carrie Underwood, Elton John, Brandie Carlile, Chris Stapleton, Dave Matthews, H.E.R., New Edition, St. Vincent, Common, Ice-T, LL Cool J, Miguel, Latifah

and Sia. Other inductees this year include DJ Kool Herc and Link Wrap for musical influence, Khan, Al Kooper and Elton John lyricist Bernie Taupin for musical excellence and Soul Train host Don Cornelius for the Ahmet Ertegun Award.

The induction ceremony was broadcast live coast-to-coast on Disney+ on Friday, November 3, 2023, at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and will be available to stream following the ceremony. ABC will air a three-hour prime-time special, *2023 Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony*, featuring performance highlights and standout moments on Jan. 1, 2024 (8-11 p.m. ET), available the next day on Hulu and Disney+.

Tracy Chapman becomes first black female recipient of CMA's Song of the Year award

In a groundbreaking moment at the Country Music Association Awards (CMA) in Nashville on Wednesday, Nov. 8, 2023 Tracy Chapman was awarded 'Song of the Year' for her 1988 single, "Fast Car." This historic win marks a significant milestone: Chapman is the first black songwriter to clinch this accolade since the CMAs began in 1967.

"Fast Car," Chapman's poignant ballad that touched hearts across the globe, peaked at No. 6 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart over three decades ago, according to NPR. The song's initial release garnered three Grammy Award nominations, securing a win in the category of Best Female Pop Vocal Performance for the singer-songwriter.

However, "Fast Car" experienced a revival in recent months when the talented singer Luke Combs paid homage to the timeless classic with his cover in April. Combs' rendition ascended even higher, to the position of No. 2 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart, earning him the Single of the Year award at this year's CMAs.

Regrettably, Chapman was unable to grace the ceremony with her presence, but she expressed her gratitude through a heartfelt written statement.

"I'm sorry I couldn't join you all tonight," she conveyed. "It's truly an honor for my song to be newly recognized after 35 years of its debut. Thank you to the CMAs, and a special thanks



to Luke and all the fans of 'Fast Car.'"

During his acceptance speech for Single of the Year, Combs showered praise on "Fast Car" and its writer. He spoke passionately about the song's profound impact on his life, describing it as his "first favorite song."

First and foremost, I want to thank Tracy Chapman for writing one of the best songs of all time," he shared with genuine appreciation. "Never intended for that - I just recorded it because I love this song so much. It's meant so much to me throughout my entire life. It's the first favorite song I ever had from the time I was four years old."

Chapman has crafted a remarkable musical career marked by hits like "Give Me One Reason," "Baby Can I Hold You" and "Crossroads." She has earned 13 Grammy nominations and won four.







Youth leaders from 12 MPS schools in the Milwaukee Community Schools Partnership add to their skill

“The main purpose today is to empower yourself,” Dom Portis told about 150 Milwaukee Public School (MPS) students of all ages. They were youth council members, representing 12 of the 16 schools in the Milwaukee Community Schools Partnership, who gathered at the annual Fall Youth Coalition Summit.



Portis, the community high schools manager for the partnership, added, “Take what you need to be a better leader.”

Students made connections and selected which leadership workshops to take part in. The workshops were led by community partners at the summit, which took place at Marquette University’s Alumni Memorial Union on Thursday, October 26, 2023.

Milwaukee Public Schools, the Milwaukee Teachers’ Education Association, and United Way of Great Mil-

waukee and Waukesha County together lead the Community Schools Partnership, but the partnership is based on sharing leadership. It gives students, families, and the larger community voice in their schools.

The aim of the councils is to build a youth coalition and establish collaboration among youth councils across the partnership. At the fall summit, the focus was on having students be better equipped to take on school

change.

At the summit, youth leaders could choose which two of the nine workshop sessions to attend. One workshop was “Hip Hop Chess: Think Ahead,” presented by the nonprofit Your Move MKE. The group aims to build community through chess programs that promote higher-level thinking. It also encourages self-expression by incorporating hip hop.

At the Youth Coalition Summit, Your Move MKE

speakers told students that chess can help them develop skills that they would use as leaders, such as:

- Concentration
- Intuition
- Visualization
- Patience
- Resilience
- Planning
- Problem solving
- Decision making, both short term and long term

Embracing challenges and persevering, qualities that chess players would develop, also are essential for leadership in any field, the students heard. Other lessons that transfer from chess to day-to-day life: Players must look at a chessboard from both sides, not just from their side, and they must come to the best decision they can to move forward.

Chess boards on the tables at the session let students play the game and think about the skills they were using. Some

of the students observed that, in chess, they moved forward like they do in life, and they had to consider short-term goals to move toward long-term success.

A sophomore from Bradley Technology and Trade School named Daevion, who is in his first year on his school’s youth council, was helping a younger student in the session figure out his next, best moves on the chess board. “The more you play, the more you learn,” he told him.

Daevion has been playing chess since 6th grade. “I like the strategy of it,” he said. And he does find that chess represents life, in a way: The game presents challenges, and it’s up to the player “to find a way to get above it,” he said.

And he sees the youth council as a chance for students to work with many other people. “In the future, you’ll have better opportunities,” he said.
