This year McCollum also honored Chazzoe Sprewell-Norwood, who passed away this summer after a battle with cancer. "Chaz was my bonus son and I loved him like he was my own. Voice of the Fatherless Child brings holiday joy to families in need

On Sunday, December 17, 2023, Voice of the Fatherless Child (VOFC), a local nonprofit, helped Milwaukee families get into the holiday spirit by delivering trees, gifts and decorations to families in need. This year they stopped at 10 homes, bringing the holiday spirit to people's doorsteps. VOFC founder Monte Mabra, said as a child he always dreamed of a Christmas with a real tree, the lights and gifts underneath it. Now he's giving that experience to other families as a holiday surprise. This year was even more special, as it marked the celebration of 11 years of their "Single Parent Christmas Giveaway." The giveaway supplied families in need with a live tree, lights, tree topper, decorations, gifts and more. Among the families that VOFC helped this year was that of 4-year old son of Ebony Johnson. Ebony, along with her two friends, Bobbie Dyson and Lashonda Jackson, were killed on November 3, 2023 after driving home from a concert. The individual that hit them was fleeing the Milwaukee police on a high-speed chase hitting Ebony's

car. Ebony's son was someone that could use some 'Christmas magic.'

Mabra said he finds families through Facebook and other organizations in the community. Along with sponsors Home Depot Port Washington, America Works and Hupy & Abraham, families received the full Christmas experience, thanks to volunteers like A.J from Home Depot, who delivered and set up everything for the families. "The joy of giving is the paycheck," said Mabra.

Andre Braugher, 'Brooklyn Nine-Nine' actor dies at age 61

Actor who played deadpan Captain Raymond Holt and starred in 'Homicide: Life on the Street,' has died after a brief illness

Andre Braugher, who starred as Captain Raymond Holt in the hit comedy *Brooklyn Nine-Nine* and as Detective Frank Pembleton in *Homicide: Life on the Street*, has died at age 61.

The actor passed away on Monday, December 11, 2023 after a battling lung cancer, his publicist confirmed.

Instantly recognizable for his deep voice, Braugher came to fame on the NBC drama *Homicide: Life on the Street*, which ran from 1992 to 1998. He won an Emmy for his portrayal of the tenacious, arrogant Detective Frank Pembleton in 1998.

But it was his performance as the deadpan Captain Raymond Holt in the hit comedy *Brooklyn Nine-Nine* that made him most famous, appearing alongside Andy Samberg for eight seasons. He won two Critics Choice Awards for best supporting actor in a comedy series and received four Emmy nominations for his performance as Holt, the precinct's no-nonsense, black and gay boss.

Born in 1962 in Chicago as the youngest of four children, Braugher studied theatre on a Stanford University scholarship before attending the Juilliard School for drama.

His first film role came in 1989's *Glory* when he played a Union soldier in one of the American Civil War's earliest African American regiments. The film earned three Oscars, including best supporting actor for Braugher's co-star Denzel Washington.

In the years that followed, he played a number of roles in television films – including revivals of classic crime series

Kojak – before his breakout in the critically acclaimed police drama *Homicide: Life on the Street*.

A 2010 article in the *Guardian* called Braugher's character Detective Pembleton "the smartest, sharpest master of the art of interrogation". He was nominated twice for an Emmy and won in 1998, his last year on the series.

Braugher won his second Emmy for the 2006 miniseries *Thief*, in which he starred as the leader of a heist balancing a high-stakes operation with family struggles.

Throughout his three-decade career, he was nominated for an Emmy a total of 11 times and often starred in roles circling the military and police, including his beloved role on *Brooklyn Nine-Nine*.

Other appearances included a cop providing insider info to his disgraced partner on the series *Hack*, a Navy captain on the military drama *Last Resort*, and a general in the sci-fi miniseries *The Andromeda Strain*.

In 2020, he spoke to *Variety* about the complexities of portraying police on television.

"I look up after all these decades of playing these characters, and I say to myself, it's been so pervasive that I've been inside this storytelling, and I, too, have fallen prey to the mythology," he said.

"Cops breaking the law to quote, 'defend the law,' is a real terrible slippery slope. It has given license to the breaking of law everywhere, justified it and excused it. That's something that we're going to have to collectively address – all cop shows."

Many former co-stars and creatives who had worked with Braugher shared tributes on social media.

In a post on Instagram, Braugher's *Brooklyn Nine-*

Nine co-star Terry Crews wrote: "I'm honored to have known you, laughed with you, worked with you and shared 8 glorious years watching your irreplaceable talent. This hurts.

"You left us too soon. You taught me so much. I will be forever grateful for the experience of knowing you. Thank you for your wisdom, your advice, your kindness and your friendship. Deepest condolences to your wife and family in this difficult time. You showed me what a life well lived looks like."

Fellow *Brooklyn Nine-Nine* star Chelsea Peretti also posted on Instagram with memories from the set: "Will miss your dulcet tones. Forever lucky to have gone on such a journey with you. Ringside seat."

Braugher also recently starred in *She Said*, the drama about the Harvey Weinstein scandal, playing Dean Baquet, the *New York Times* executive editor. He also played the charismatic lawyer Ri'Chard Lane in the final season of *The Good Fight*, alongside Christine Baranski and Audra McDonald.

Braugher is survived by his wife, the actor Ami Brabson who also appeared in *Homicide*; their three sons Michael, Isaiah and John Wesley; as well as his brother, Charles and mother, Sally.



At the MPS Battle of the Drumlines, the Rufus King varsity drumline holds on to its title

The 21st annual Milwaukee Public School (MPS) Battle of the Drumlines had it all: high-energy performances; an enthusiastic crowd of all ages; finalists that included a first-year drumline; a nail-biter of a margin at the finish; and a drumline with tricks up its sleeves—or, actually, sticks up its sleeves.

In the end, the Rufus King International High School's varsity drumline retained its title as city champions, winning its 16th Battle of the Drumlines on Saturday, December 9, 2023. Because King won last year, it played host to this year's Battle of the Drumlines, held in the school's gymnasium.

King's varsity line claimed victory over Riverside University High School in the championship round by less than one point — 58 points to Riverside's 57.25. Another fraction of a point separated Riverside and Reagan College Preparatory High School. Reagan came in third, with 56.5 points.

And in an unexpected fin-

ish by a first-time drumline, Washington High School of Information Technology tied for third place with Reagan in the first round to advance to the championship round.

Participation, both by drumlines and audience members, was robust this year, the best since the start of the pandemic in 2020.

This year, seven drumlines competed, up from four in 2022. Also vying at this year's battle were Bradley Technology and Trade School, Milwaukee Marshall High School, and Rufus King's junior varsity drumline.

Drumlines from Mac-

Dowell Montessori School, Milwaukee Parkside School for the Arts, and Humboldt Park School put on exhibition performances to kick off the event. The Milwaukee Hittaz Drum Corps, a community drumline, performed while judges compiled scores for the championship round. More than 600 attended the event.

"It was amazing. I was so excited by how many people were there to watch," said Share Garcia, district music curriculum specialist for Milwaukee Public Schools. The growth in participating drumlines was exponential,

she noted; the drumlines "not only showed up but showed out."

The drumlines had their own distinctive approaches. "They're completely different styles of music making. I'm glad the judges recognized everything that went into it," Garcia said.

Garcia added, "I loved Marshall's track suits. You can do it nontraditional and still look sharp."

Two judges focused on the musical aspect of the performance and how the music and visuals go together; one judge focused on what's called 'the repertoire effect' and the 'showmanship effect' — what the performance looks like and feels like, Garcia said.

That takes into account the synchronization and precision with which the drumlines perform, and the showmanship in elements, like the Riverside drumline dropping drumsticks from their sleeves, letting them dangle on lines as they held up their arms while leaving the floor.

Garcia noted that the district is grateful to Milwaukee voters for approving the \$87-million referendum in 2020 to support MPS. The referendum's aim was, in part, to attract and retain highly qualified teachers and expand music and other arts, language, and physical education instruction. The difference the referendum is making could be seen in the drumlines.

For instance, some of the drumlines' equipment was new, but all of the drumlines that competed this year will have new equipment in time for the 2024 competition. In some cases, equipment that is more than two decades old will be replaced.

And the district now has two traveling music instructors with expertise in percussion and drumlines, each of whom visits six schools.

That could mean more drumlines at next year's competition. "We hope this will just continue to grow," Garcia said.

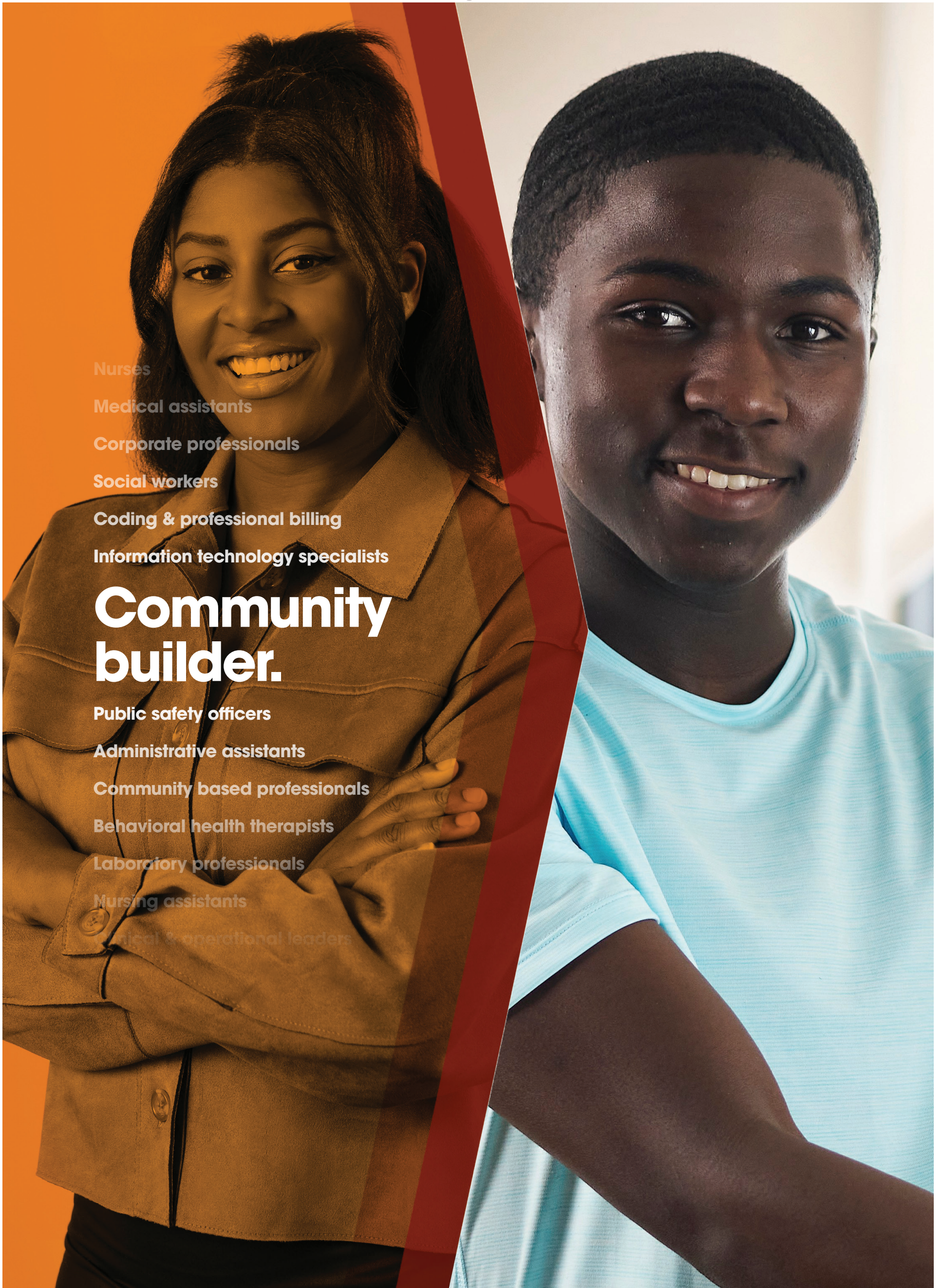

Heart attack deaths spike during the winter holidays

The American Heart Association urges people to be aware of and reduce risks for deadly 'holiday heart attacks'

The winter holidays can turn deadly, as research shows that more people die from heart attacks during the last week of December than at any other time of the year. While being aware of the signs of a heart attack and taking steps to reduce your risk are important all year long, the American Heart Association, the world's leading voluntary organization focused on heart and brain health for all, says that's especially critical during the next few weeks.

A number of scientific studies confirm this deadly phenomenon.

A study published in *Circulation*, the flagship journal of the American Heart Association, reported that more cardiac deaths occur in the U.S. on December 25 than on any other day of the year, followed by December 26 and January 1.

In a *British Medical Journal* study reviewing more than 16 years of data on heart attacks among people in Sweden, there was a 15 percent overall increase in heart attacks during the winter holidays. Of particular note, heart attacks increased 37 percent on Dec. 24 (Christmas Eve), peaking at 10 p.m. and more often in people over 75 and those with diabetes or previous cardiovascular disease.

A study presented at the British Cardiovascular Society meeting in June 2023 supported previous research finding more serious heart attacks occur on Mondays than any other day of the week. This year, Dec. 25 (Christmas Day) falls on a Monday.

"No one wants to think of tragedy during this joyous time of year as we gather with family and friends. However, these startling facts are very sobering. We don't know exactly what triggers this increase in heart attacks during the holidays, it's likely a combination of factors," said Johanna Contreras, M.D., M.Sc., FAHA, clinical volunteer for the American Heart Association and a cardiologist at Mt. Sinai Hospital System in New York City. "Winter weather has been noted to increase heart attack risk due to restricted blood flow when arteries may be constricted in cold temperatures. We also know the holidays bring a lot of added stress to many people. There are lots of parties and family gatherings where many tend to overindulge in rich foods and drink."

According to Contreras, one of the most critical factors might be that people ignore important warning signs

of a heart attack or stroke.

"While you may not want to spend the holidays in a doctor's office or hospital, getting checked out and receiving prompt treatment if there is a problem is one of the best gifts you can give yourself and your loved ones for all the celebrations to come," she said.

Giving the gift of life may also come into play if you see someone experiencing heart attack or stroke symptoms. You could be out shopping at the mall, enjoying the sights and sounds of the holiday season or spending time at a family gathering and witness someone having a heart attack and going into cardiac arrest. Starting CPR immediately and calling 9-1-1 could be the difference in life or death in those situations.

"Hands-Only CPR is something nearly everyone

can learn and do. We encourage at least one person in every family to learn CPR because statistics show that most cardiac arrests occur outside the hospital and often in the home," Contreras said. "The American Heart Association has a short instructional video at Heart.org/HandsOnlyCPR. Watching the video and learning Hands-Only CPR could be a lifesaving and lifechanging activity for the family to do together as you're gathered for the holidays."

Contreras notes that family gatherings are also a good time to talk about family health history.

"Many of the health factors that impact heart disease and stroke are heredity," she said. "If any of your parents, siblings or grandparents have had a heart attack or stroke, you are likely at higher risk, too. But the good news is,

you can lower your risk with preventive measures. Knowing that history is an important first step."

Following are several heart-healthy tips for the upcoming holidays:

1. Know symptoms and take action: Heart attack signs and stroke symptoms vary in men and women and it's important to recognize them early and call 9-1-1 for help. The sooner medical treatment begins, the better the chances of survival and preventing heart damage.

2. Celebrate in moderation: Eating healthfully during the holidays doesn't have to mean depriving yourself; there are still ways to eat smart. Look for small, healthy changes and swaps you can make so you continue to feel your best while eating and drinking in moderation; and don't forget to watch your salt intake.

3. Plan for peace on earth and goodwill toward yourself: Make time to take care of yourself during the busy

holiday. Reduce stress from family interactions, strained finances, hectic schedules and other stressors prevalent this time of year, including traveling.

4. Keep moving: The American Heart Association recommends at least 150 minutes of physical activity per week; and this number usually drops during the hustle and bustle of the holidays. Get creative with ways to stay active, even if it's going for a family walk or another fun activity you can do with your loved ones.

5. Stick to your meds: Busy holidays can cause you to skip medications, forgetting them when away from home or not getting refills in a timely manner. The American Heart Association has a medication chart to help stay on top of it, and be sure to keep tabs on your blood pressure numbers.

"We do know there are ways to mitigate your risk for a deadly heart attack. So, we encourage everyone to pause during the holiday hustle and bustle and make note of these important steps that could be lifesaving," Contreras said.
