Milwaukee Alderman Khalif Rainey is not seeking re-election

Rainey has served Milwaukee's Seventh Aldermanic District since 2016

Alderman Khalif Rainey announced Thursday, December 21, 2023 he will not seek re-election. He has served Milwaukee's Seventh Aldermanic District since 2016.

In a statement, Rainey included some of the items the Common Council accomplished that he is most proud of.

"When my colleagues and I started talking about food deserts and how to end them, few even seemed to understand the problem. Now it's a priority. We lifted barriers for

felons that prevented them from purchasing city-owned property. We pushed for simple, street-level changes to improve the cleanliness of our city and reduce reckless driving. We created an Equity Impact Statement to make legislation more transparent and evaluate it through a different lens.

"We created 'Hip Hop Week MKE,' a celebration of an art form I care very deeply about, and raised Milwaukee's place in



it to national notice," Rainey said. "We also created an Office of African American

Affairs to acknowledge and directly address the unique problems of a community so long plagued by racism, both open and systemic."

Rainey was born and raised in Milwaukee's 53206 ZIP code.

When he received a scholarship from a local philanthropist to attend college, it was stipulated that he study hard, work hard, and then

bring back what he learned to his community for use in its service. "I have spent my entire professional life trying to keep that promise," Rainey said.

His term will end on April 16, 2024.

There are five other candidates running for Rainey's seat. Nomination papers are due by close of business Jan.

The spring primary is Feb. 20, and the spring general election is April 2, 2024.

President Biden talks investments in Milwaukee's community with black, local business owners

President Joe Biden visited Milwaukee on Wednesday December 20, 2023, his third visit to the Badger State this year.

Milwaukee is one of many stops for the president as he talks about his efforts and investments in local economies.

"Today we're making sure Milwaukee is coming back and all of Milwaukee is coming back," Biden said.

"Milwaukee business applications are up 70 percent compared to before the pandemic. The share of black people employed in 2022



was the highest in more than a decade," Biden added.

The President said his \$15-billion bipartisan infrastructure law offers opportunity and hope to communities, like Milwaukee, to fully

participate in today's economy...something local business owners like, Rashaun Spivey, understands firsthand.

"After years of hard work I achieved my goal of becom-

ing a master plumber and opened my own business, Hero Plumbing," Spivey said

His entrepreneurship was sparked by Spivey's own mother, and continued, he said, by Biden's investment in black-owned businesses and city-wide infrastructure.

"President Biden's support of black-owned businesses has helped us live up to the hero name. Thanks to his investments, we've been able to replace 600 lead lateral pipes across the city, mostly at child care centers," Spivey explained. Across Milwaukee, thousands of miles of lead lateral pipes need to be replaced, a decades-long process. However, Biden's infrastructure plan promises to accelerate that timeline.

"Last month we proposed a new rule that's gonna require the water systems to be fully replaced in Milwaukee within 10 years, instead of 60," Biden added.

This was just one of two stops President Biden had in the Milwaukee area. Likely, we could see him again as Wisconsin plays a crucial role in the 2024 election.



A Christmas lesson

Thursday, December 28, 2023

On December 24, 1967, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., delivered the message at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, on what would be his last Christmas Eve. The message was titled, "A Christmas Sermon on Peace". More than 50 years later, I reiterate some of that powerful lesson.

In a season when many people sing carols praying for peace on earth, Dr. King shared a sharp warning for our nation and world: "Now let me suggest first that if we are to have peace on earth, our loyalties must become ecumenical rather than sectional. Our loyalties must transcend our race, our tribe, our class, and our nation; and this means we must develop a world perspective. No individual can live alone; no nation can live alone, and as long as we try, the more we are going to have war in




this world . . . We must either learn to live together as brothers or we are all going to perish together as fools."

His words remain prescient. Are we any closer to heeding them? At the end of the sermon, Dr. King spoke about the day four years earlier when he had told the nation at the March on Washington that he had a dream for America's future. He said,

in the turbulent years that had followed, it already felt like he was watching that dream turning into a night-mare. But Dr. King said he was not willing to give up:

"Yes, I am personally the victim of deferred dreams, of blasted hopes, but in spite of that, I close today by saying that I still have a dream . . . I have a dream that one day men will rise up and come to see that they are made to live together as brothers. I still have a dream this morning that one day every Negro in this country, every colored person in the world, will be judged on the basis of the content of his character rather than the color of his skin, and every man will respect the dignity and worth of human personality. I still have a dream that one day the idle industries of Appalachia will be revitalized, and the empty stomachs of Mississippi will be filled, and brotherhood will be more than a few words at the end of a prayer, but rather the first order of business on every legislative agenda."

He went on: "I still have a dream today that one day justice will roll down like water, and righteousness like a mighty stream. I still have a dream today that in all of our state houses and city halls



will toward men. It will be a glorious day, the morning stars will sing together, and the sons of God will shout for joy."

Decades later, Dr. King's dream remains deferred, but every generation has a new chance to bend the arc of the moral universe closer toward justice, equality, good will toward all, and peace. It is still up to us to make real that dream and that day when the children of God shout for joy or all young people and their families in America and around the world.

Kwanzaa: What it really is and how and why it's celebrated

Every year, around Christmas time, you may hear some black folks talking about celebrating Kwanzaa. many of them jokingly because they don't know the history or roots behind the holiday. Here's how it all came about and why celebrating it could be more important than ever.

Maulana Karenga created Kwanzaa in 1966, as the first specifically African-American holiday. According to Karenga, the name Kwanzaa derives from the Swahili phrase matunda ya kwanza, meaning "first fruits of the harvest". The choice of Swahili, an East African language, reflects its status as a symbol of Pan-Africanism, especially in the 1960s, although most of the Atlantic slave trade that brought African people to America originated in West Africa.

Kwanzaa is a celebration that has its roots in the black nationalist movement of the 1960s and was established a means to

help African Americans reconnect with their African cultural and historical heritage by uniting in meditation and study of African traditions and Nguzo Saba, the "seven principles of African Heritage" which Karenga said "is a communitarian African philosophy". Karenga believed and stated that "you



must have a cultural revolution before the violent revolution. The cultural revolution gives identity, purpose and direction.

Kwanzaa was not created to give people an alternative to their own religion or religious holiday. Many African Americans who celebrate Kwanzaa do so in addition to observing Christmas.

Kwanzaa over seven days with each day focusing on a specific principle in the black community. A Kwanzaa ceremony may include drumming and musical selections, libations, a reading of the African Pledge and a discussion of the African principle of the day or a chap-

ter in African history and a feast known as the "karamu."

Each day also consists of a candle-lighting ritual. You have what is called a kinara (candle holder) and seven candles (one black candle, three green candles and three red candles). The black candle is lit first then used to light each of the other candles on the day that is celebrated, going back and forth with lighting the red and green.

The seven principles of Kwanzaa are as follows:

- 1. Umoja (Unity): To strive for and to maintain unity in the family, community, nation, and race.
- 2. Kujichagulia (Self-Determination): To define and name ourselves, as well as to create and speak for ourselves.
- 3. Ujima (Collective Work and Responsibility): To build and maintain our community together and make our brothers' and sisters' problems our problems and to solve them to-
- 4. Ujamaa (Cooperative **Economics**): To build and maintain our own stores,

- shops, and other businesses and to profit from them together.
- 5. Nia (Purpose): To make our collective vocation the building and developing of our community in order to restore our people to their traditional greatness.
- 6. Kuumba (Creativity): To do always as much as we can, in the way we can, in order to leave our community more beautiful and beneficial than we inherited it.
- 7. Imani (Faith): To believe with all our hearts in our people, our parents, our teachers, our leaders, and the righteousness and victory of our struggle.

Besides the candles and the candle holder, other Kwanzaa celebratory symbols include a mat (Mkeka) on which other symbols are placed: a Kinara (candle holder), Mishumaa Saba (seven candles) mazao (crops), Muhindi (corn), a Kikombe cha Umoja (unity cup) for commemorating and giving shukrani (thanks) to African Ancestors, and Zawadi (gifts). Supplemental representations include a Nguzo Saba poster, the black, red, and green bendera (flag), and African books and artworks – all to represent values and concepts reflective of African culture and contribution to community building and reinforcement. With corn being the primary symbol for both decoration and celebratory dinning.

The greeting for each day of Kwanzaa is Habari Gani? which is Swahili for "What's the news?" or "How are you?"

Time for action: White House needs to end delay, move forward with Ban on Menthol

The tobacco industry decades ago launched a devastating campaign to target the black community with its products, its primary tool being menthol cigarettes. This sustained attack on black health has resulted in profits in the billions and the deaths of millions.

Understandably, health and social and racial justice advocates, among many others, saw great promise in the proposal by the Food and Drug Administration to remove menthol cigarettes from the market. Many saw the ban as a way to change that trajectory and put action behind the statement, "Black Lives Matter."

That promise is now tempered by disillusionment and utter disappointment as the White House announced recently that any action on menthol won't happen until at least March. It's no secret why the Biden Administration changed its tune, or at least muted it for now. The tobacco industry and its



powerful lobby have funded a campaign using false statements, some being carried by prominent black activists, to stoke fears that a ban on menthol will cause more harm than good.

Think about that for a second. Tobacco kills 45,000 African Americans a year and is a prime contributor to the three main causes of death among African Americans: heart disease, cancer and stroke. Menthol, a product used by 85 percent of black smokers nationally and 89

percent of black smokers in Wisconsin, is the primary cause of this carnage, the direct result of a successful targeting campaign by the tobacco industry.

Banning menthol will save up to 650,000 lives in 40 years, including more than 200,000 black lives, research estimates have found. How is this a bad thing?

I'm not here to say that the tobacco lobby arguments against the ban are baseless. They play upon legitimate

fears of the black community in regards to over-policing and police brutality. But, instead of addressing those legitimate concerns by standing behind social justice and taking actions such as ending their relentless targeting campaign of the black community, they're using the argument to keep our communities in harm's way; to keep profits rolling their way.

Here's the facts. The menthol ban will be enforced against manufacturers and retailers, not against individual consumers or smokers of menthol. It would not make it illegal to possess menthol cigarettes. The menthol ban is also not a campaign issue

and will not hurt Biden at the polls. The NAACP of Milwaukee, faith and community groups, residents and many others stand strongly in favor of the ban. We know it will save lives and the tobacco industry and the Biden Administration know it too. It's time to stop talking about it and take action before more black lives are lost to menthol tobacco.
