County Board unanimously adopts resolution encouraging investment at Wisconsin's only black-owned bank

On Thursday, March 21, 2024, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted a resolution supporting investment in Columbia Savings & Loan by the County Treasurer. This new initiative aims to drive economic empowerment and foster racial equity within the community through investment in the state's first and only black-owned bank.

Milwaukee County Board Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson propelled this reso-



lution along with co-sponsors Supervisors Priscilla E. Coggs-Jones, Sequanna Taylor Taylor (Dist. 5), Juan Miguel Martinez, Shawn Roland, Steve F. Taylor (Dist. 17), and Ryan Clancy. The resolution, crafted in collab-

oration with the Milwaukee County Treasurer David Cullen, encourages the Treasurer's Office and other relevant Milwaukee County departments to explore depositing funds in Columbia Savings & Loan, helping support

initiatives that increase capital availability for low- and moderate-income families in Milwaukee County. Chairwoman Nicholson issued the following statement:

"The decision to invest in Columbia Savings & Loan is a decision to invest in the prosperity of our community. This resolution highlights our commitment to supporting black-owned businesses in Milwaukee and addressing the wealth gap. By investing available public funds with the state's first, and now only, black-owned bank, we are contributing to the revitalization of black communities in Milwaukee. This is just

the beginning."

Columbia Savings & Loan, set to celebrate its 100th anniversary this year, is currently conducting its "100 by the 100th" campaign. This initiative seeks to secure \$10-million in new funding to facilitate homeownership for 100 families by the end of 2024. The campaign and this resolution acknowledge the significance of increased homeownership as a critical indicator of the overall health of a community.

The adopted resolution will now be sent to the desk of the County Executive for approval.

WI Supreme Court: Amazon drivers are employees, not independent contractors

The Wisconsin Supreme Court on Tuesday, March 26, 2024 let stand a lower court ruling that declared some delivery drivers for Amazon are employees as the state argued, not independent contractors as the online retail giant contended.

The court, in a unanimous decision, said the appeal was "improvidently granted," meaning the Supreme Court should not have reviewed the case. That decision dismissing the case, issued after the court heard verbal arguments, leaves a 2023 Wisconsin appeals court ruling against Amazon in place.

That ruling found that drivers in the Amazon Flex program are a part of the state's unemployment insurance system and entitled to jobless pay if they are laid off. The decision means an Amazon subsidiary, Amazon Logistics, will likely be hit with a tax bill of more than \$200,000.

Justice Ann Walsh Bradley, in a concurring decision, said the reason the court dismissed the case was that further review "would not serve any meaningful purpose" or any "further development of the law." Justice Rebecca Bradley, in a separate writing, faulted Bradley for trying to explain the court's decision, saying it "will only sow additional confusion."

The case was closely watched for what effect a ruling would have on workers in the "gig economy."

Labor unions, along with the state Department of Workforce Development, pushed for the Wisconsin Supreme Court to recognize the Amazon Flex workers as employees.

Courts across the country have been grappling with similar questions as states

struggle with how to treat workers who are hired for a particular job, often at the push of a button through a smartphone app, to deliver food, groceries, packages or perform a variety of tasks.

"The gig economy is clogging up the court with all of this stuff, all the time," said Samantha Prince, assistant professor of law at Penn State Dickinson College of Law and an expert on worker misclassification and the gig economy. "It's just nuts. We really need this stuff to be resolved and stay resolved and stop with all the uncertainty for everybody."

Prince said even though the court declined to issue a ruling in this case, allowing the appeals court ruling to stand that found the Amazon Flex drivers were employees is "one of the many dominoes that are starting to fall."

"And even though this case only applies to Amazon Flex drivers, it will likely resonate through the other gig company court cases," she said. "The more cases that find that gig company drivers are employees, the more companies are going to have to pay their rightful share."

Every state has its own laws determining whether workers are employees or independent contractors, Prince said. Those laws set the rules for what wages and overtime the workers must be paid and, in this case, whether they are subject to unemployment benefits that the employer must contribute toward.

Employees who got approved for the Amazon Flex program could download an app for their personal phones showing blocks when they could deliver packages for the company. Workers would scan packages at the Amazon warehouse in Milwaukee and use their personal vehicles to



deliver them, using a route suggested by Amazon.

After one Amazon Flex worker was fired, he filed for unemployment insurance. The Department of Workforce Development conducted an audit of more than 1,000 Amazon Logistics drivers between 2016 and 2018 and concluded the vast majority of drivers were employees, not independent contractors, and therefore eligible for unemployment insurance payments. The state told Amazon in 2018 that it owed more than \$205,000 in unemployment insurance premiums.

The Wisconsin Labor and Industry Review Commission upheld the state DWD determination that the drivers were employees. Amazon Logistics sued and a Waukesha County circuit court judge ruled the drivers were independent contractors. Last year, the Wisconsin Court of Appeals overturned that ruling, agreeing with the state that the drivers were employees. That set up the appeal to the Wisconsin Supreme Court.

Many other states have looked at the issue.

A Virginia appeals court ruled in 2023 that Amazon Flex drivers were employees, not independent contractors, and ordered Amazon to pay unemployment insurance

taxes and penalties.

A California state appeals court last year said app-based ride hailing and delivery companies like Uber and

Lyft can continue to treat their California drivers as independent contractors, allowing them to bypass other state laws requiring worker protections and benefits.

The U.S. Department of Labor enacted a new rule March 11 that aims to prevent the misclassification of workers as "independent contractors," a step that could bolster both legal protections and compensation for millions in the U.S. workforce. That rule applies to wages and overtime, but not unemployment compensation.

Being Frank

There is March Madness in the USA. The NCAA D1 Men's Tournament started in March and ends in early April. For college basketball fans this is the best time of the year. Big money changes hands during the tournament. The majority of the teams that compete in the NCAA Tournament are predominantly white schools that feature African American players. You have to wonder how the NCAA Tournament would look if African Americans plied their skills at historically black colleges and universities (HBCUs).

The dominant college basketball teams are all in Power Five conferences. For example, you have the ACC, SEC, Big Ten, Big East, to name a few. These conferences consist of predominantly white schools. Yet, if you look at their basketball teams, in many cases the team features many African Americans. Many of these players are using the college to possibly go to the NBA. On the other hand the school is definitely using the players. Just making the NCAA Tournament brings in a couple million



dollars. Imagine if African American players decided to go to HBCUs and ply their trade. How would the power dynamic shift in college basketball and education with millions pouring into HBCUs?

The money that basketball generates for colleges during the NCAA Tournament, is one aspect. The branding that comes from winning and being called a "blue blood" program is incalculable. Take a school like Kansas or, heaven forbid, Duke. These schools are known for having powerhouse basketball programs.

The apparel that is sold from having a winning basketball program helps establish the school in the nation's psyche. What if the money and prestige that comes to these two schools could be transferred to HBCUs like Hampton or Norfolk State? The premier programs would not be the UCLAs or UConns. The premier programs would be Lemoyne-Owen or Wilberforce, two HBCUs that have educated African Americans for years without a lot of glory.

Ironically, many of the best college teams come from former slave states. Alabama, Tennessee, Kentucky, and both Carolinas were slave states that exploited African Americans. Now, more than a century later these slave states are still exploiting African Americans for profit. Does it make sense for African Americans to uplift former slave states? Does it make sense for African Americans to ignore their own colleges and universities to be exploited by schools that may have excluded African Americans during the 50's and 60's?

dul Jabbar, played at UCLA and brought three titles to the school. Imagine if Kareem would have gone to Rust College and led them to three straight NCAA titles. Would there be a concept of a "blue blood" programs in college basketball? Probably not. The press would probably change the moniker to "black blood".

The millions and prestige that the NCAA Tournament generates would be a great asset to any HBCU. Think of the way Micheal Jordan looks out for University of North Carolina. In a different world Jordan would still be considered the greatest basketball player, but his time and donations would go to North Carolina Central University. It is a beautiful concept. In all truth though, African American athletes go to the white schools for the exposure that these schools offer. At this time there is no way an HBCU could give an athlete the exposure a player at Kentucky gets during practice. Yet, you have to wonder. What if in the early 60's African Americans like Jabbar and others would have gone to HBCUs? Would HBCUs be the small schools downplayed or the major schools being catered to?

According to the NCAA's website, HBCUs have won 15 tournament games over the years. There are nine different HBCUs that achieved a victory in the NCAA D1 Tournament. That is a paltry number when you think of the fact that UCLA has won 11 NCAA championships. There were African Americans that played key roles on UCLA's championship teams. One of the greatest college basketball players ever, Kareem Ab-

and Sample Ballots

**OFFICE OF THE MILWAUKEE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION
TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE:**

Notice is hereby given of a spring election and presidential preference vote to be held in the City of Milwaukee on April 2, 2024, at which the officers named below shall be chosen. The names of the candidates for each office, whose nominations have been certified to or filed in this office, are given under the title of the office, each in its proper column, together with the questions submitted to a vote, for a referendum, in the sample ballot below.

Information to Voters

Upon entering the polling place and before being permitted to vote, a voter shall:

- state their name and address
- show an acceptable form of photo identification*
- sign the poll book**

***If a voter does not have acceptable photo identification, the voter may obtain a free photo ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.**

****If the voter is unable to sign the poll book due to disability, a poll worker may write the word "exempt."**

If a voter is not registered to vote, they may register to vote at the polling place serving their residence if the voter provides proof of residence.

Where ballots are distributed to voters, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot.

Upon being permitted to vote, the voter shall enter a voting booth or go to a machine and cast their ballot. The vote should not be cast in any manner other than specified here. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the voter in marking their ballot may be taken into the booth and copied. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked.

A voter who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the voter's minor child or minor ward.

An election official may inform the voter of the proper manner for casting a vote but the official may not advise or indicate a particular voting choice.

Assistance for Voting

A voter may select an individual to assist in casting their vote if the voter declares to the presiding official that they are unable to read, have difficulty reading, writing, or understanding English, or that due to disability are unable to cast their ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the voter's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the voter.

AT THE PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE VOTE

**A voter may cast only one vote in the
presidential preference primary.**

Where Optical Scan Voting is Used

Within the party of his or her choice, the voter shall fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate of their choice or shall, in the alternative, fill in the oval next to the words "Uninstructed Delegation," or write in the name of the person of their choice for a candidate in the space provided for a write-in vote and fill in the oval next to the write-in line.

When using an *electronic ballot marking device* ("ExpressVote") to mark an **optical scan ballot**, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the party of their choice. Within the party of their choice, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the name of the candidate of their choice or shall, in the alternative, touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the words "Uninstructed Delegation," or type in the name of a person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote.

Where Touch Screen Voting is Used

The voter shall touch the screen at the party of his or her choice. Within the party of their choice, the voter shall touch the screen at the name of the candidate of their choice or shall, in the alternative, touch the screen at the words "Uninstructed Delegation," or type in the name of a person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote.

AT THE SPRING ELECTION

Where Optical Scan Voting is Used

The voter shall fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided and fill in the oval next to the write-in line. On referendum questions, the voter shall fill in the oval next to "yes" if in favor of the question or fill in the oval next to "no" if opposed to the question.

When using an *electronic ballot marking device* ("ExpressVote") to mark an **optical scan ballot**, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. On referendum questions, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select "yes" if in

favor of the question, or the voter shall touch the screen or use they tactile pad to select "no" if opposed to the question.

Where Touch Screen Voting is Used

The voter shall touch the screen at the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. On referendum questions, the voter shall touch the screen at "yes" if in favor of the question, or the voter shall touch the screen at "no" if opposed to the question.

Spoiled Ballots

If a voter spoils an **optical scan ballot**, they shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one voter. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the voter shall return it to the election official, who shall issue a proper ballot in its place.

The voter may spoil a **touch screen ballot** at the voting station before the ballot is cast.

After Voting the Ballot

After an official **optical scan ballot** is marked, it may be inserted in the security sleeve, so the marks do not show. The voter shall insert the ballot in the voting device and discard the sleeve or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit. The voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

After an official **touch screen ballot** is cast, the voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

A sample of the official ballot is included with this notice.

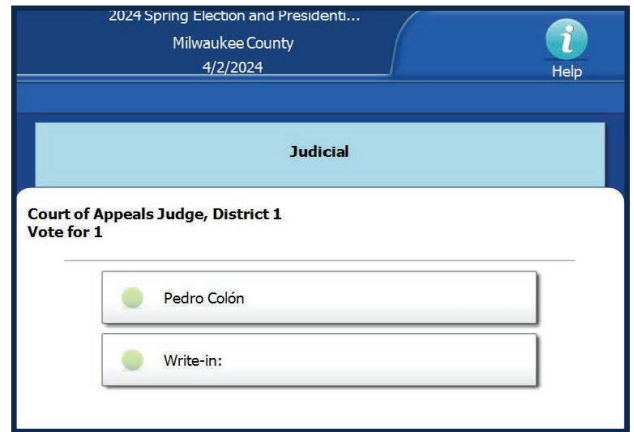

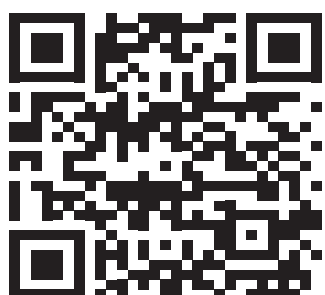
