Nellie Weddle celebrates 88th birthday with community fundraiser

On Sunday, April 14, 2024, long-time community activist Nellie Weddle, founder of Nellie's Outreach Resource Initiative (NORI), celebrated her 88th birthday at the Washington Park Senior Center, 4420 W. Vliet Street. The party was not only a way for family, friends and community partners to recognize Nellie's work and birthday, but the event was also a fundraiser for NORI, so that they can continue their neighborhood youth projects. Having previously worked with the Neighborhood Family Initiative (NFI), and inspired by the work they did, Nellie founded NORI in 1994 and considered it a spin-off of NFI. Over the years, NORI created a youth employment opportunity program model (YEOP) for the quick service food industry by partnering with McDonald's. Later they would develop a youth sports careers program with North Division Community Center, and a journalism/computer career program with the Milwaukee Times Weekly Newspaper and Publishing Co. Remembering Sade Robinson

On Monday April 1, 2024, 19-year-old Sade Robinson disappeared. By the afternoon of Friday, April 12, Milwaukee and the whole world would know what had happened to her. When Maxwell S. Anderson, 33, a man who Robinson had a date with the night she disappeared, was formally charged with first-degree intentional homicide, mutilating a corpse and arson. But while the gruesome details of what happened are still coming to light, many are overlooking who Sade Robinson was.

Born in Vicksburg, MS, Sade Carleena Robinson moved to Milwaukee with her mother, Sheena Scarbrough, before she turned 2. She then split her time between here and Florida, where her father Carlos Robinson lives. Though Scar-

brough and Robinson's father never married, they tried their best to co-parent.

After splitting her time between both parents, in 2019 Robinson decided to return to Milwaukee to live with her mother again.

Scarbrough was always impressed by her daughter's determination, like when she graduated from high school a semester early after moving from Florida. She recalled her surprise when Robinson asked to be driven to a job interview, something Scarbrough didn't know was even in the works.

Robinson worked at Pizza Shuttle on Milwaukee's East Side as a cashier, where she was a favorite among co-workers and customers alike, a manager told the newspa-



per.

Robinson was only a month away from finishing her associate degree in criminal justice at Milwaukee Area Technical College. Scarbrough said her daughter was still figuring out her next steps, but was looking at joining the U.S. Air Force. The family has other veterans, with Robinson's grand-

father a retired U.S. Navy veteran and her uncle a U.S. Army veteran, she said.

Robinson recently had gotten a passport and planned well with her money, self-funding recent trips to Jamaica and Atlanta.

The family is tight-knit, Scarbrough said, texting frequently and having groups on the family tracking app Life360. Robinson's last location on the app has been a source for searches, she said.

Scarbrough said she was a standout older sister, even getting her little sister Adriana a job at the Wisconsin Club, where Robinson worked a second job, and often picked her sister up for work.

She lived in a small "bachelorette" apartment and her

grandmother Linda would often visit her, where Robinson loved to cook seafood for her, Scarbrough said.

"Her whole life was so ahead of her, she was so, so amazing. So beautiful, such a beautiful angel. Everywhere she went, people just admired my baby," Scarbrough said.

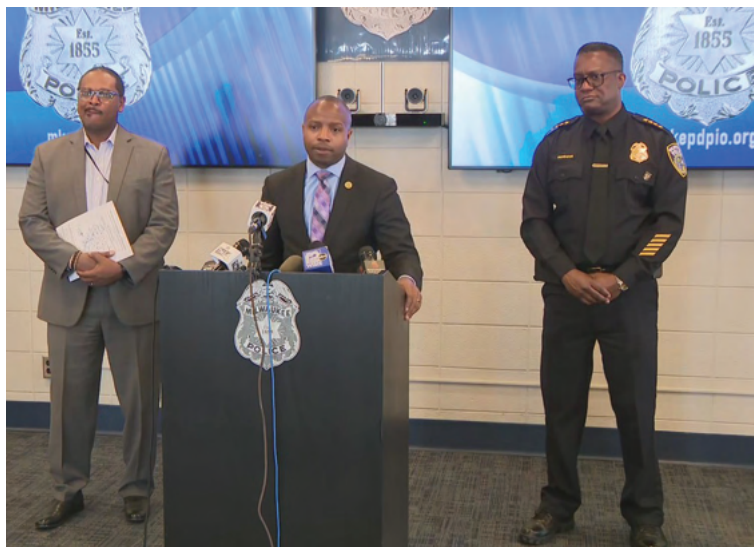
While the police and prosecution continue their investigation into her untimely death, family and friends have continued scouring Milwaukee's parks to find the rest of Robinson's remains, so that her entire family can have the farewell she so rightly deserves.

The family has established a **GoFundMe** at <https://go-fund.me/822cbe6a> to help pay for funeral services.

2024 Milwaukee crime data; homicides down 39 percent in 1st quarter of year

Milwaukee Police Chief Jeffrey Norman, Mayor Cavalier Johnson and Office of Violence Prevention Director Ashanti Hamilton, on Tuesday, April 16, 2024 presented the city's crime numbers for the first three months of 2024.

With the first quarter review, Milwaukee police say homicides have decreased 39 percent – down to 23 from 38 this time in 2023. Property crime is down 11 percent. Auto thefts are down 10 percent – down to 1,295 from



1,431 this time in 2023.

"Overall, our year is off to a positive start," said Milwaukee Police Chief Jeffrey Norman. "But as I said before, MPD cannot take full credit when crime goes down. Nor do you own all the blame when crime goes up."

In 2024 compared to 2023:

- Crashes remained the same at 3,415 in 2024 compared to 3,423 in 2023

- Hit-and-run crashes decreased 1 percent (1,258) from (1,269)
- Fatalities decreased 44 percent (9) from (16)

"We've got every reason to applaud the latest numbers across the board. Milwaukee is headed in the right direction when it comes to crime. But now is certainly no time to relax," said Mayor Johnson.

An update in a long fight for justice

On April 2, 2024, 109-year-olds Viola Fletcher and Lessie Benningfield Randle appeared together at a Tulsa courthouse in a hearing before Oklahoma's Supreme Court. Mother Fletcher and Mother Randle, as they are known in their communities, are the last two known survivors of the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre. In 2020, they were part of a group of survivors and descendants who filed a lawsuit seeking reparations for the white supremacist mob violence that destroyed Tulsa's Greenwood District on May 31-June 1, 1921, devastating Tulsa's black community with effects that have rippled through generations.



At the time of the massacre, Greenwood was one of the most prosperous black communities in the country, nicknamed "Black Wall Street," and home to black businesses, theaters, churches, restaurants, and thousands of black citizens. By the end of the mob violence, historians estimate as many as 300 black citizens were

killed, 35 city blocks were burned down, and 10,000 people were left unhoused. Instead of stopping attackers, police deputized white civilians. They gave them more guns and ammunition, and the Oklahoma National Guard helped round up and detain 6,000 black residents. No one was charged for any of the deaths, injuries, or property damage. The lawsuit has been an attempt to seek a measure of justice.

In 2021, Mrs. Fletcher, Mrs. Randle, and Mrs. Fletcher's brother Hughes Van Ellis, who passed away in October, were invited to provide Congressional testi-

mony on the massacre's centennial. Mrs. Fletcher, who had just turned seven when the massacre happened, said: "On May 31st in 1921, I went to bed at my family's home in the Greenwood neighborhood of Tulsa. The neighborhood I fell asleep in that night was rich—not just in terms of wealth, but in culture, community, heritage, and my family had a beautiful home. We had great neighbors and I had friends to play with. I felt safe. I had everything a child could need. I had a bright future ahead of me . . . Within a few hours, all that was gone."

She continued: "I will nev-

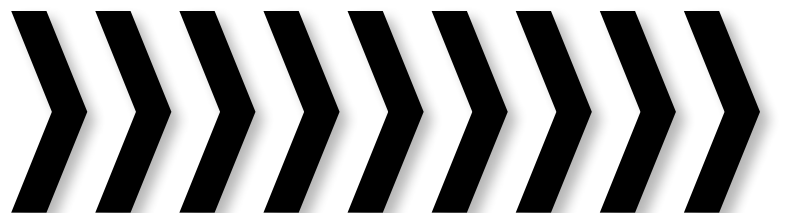
er forget the violence of the white mob when we left our home. I still see black men being shot and black bodies lying in the street. I still smell smoke and see fire. I still see black businesses being burned. I still hear airplanes flying overhead. I hear the screams. I have lived through the massacre every day. Our country may forget this history, but I cannot."

Mrs. Randle, who was six, testified about her own memories before her grandmother's home was destroyed: "I didn't have any fears as a young child, and I felt very safe. My community was beautiful. It was filled with happy and successful black people. Then, everything changed. It was like a war. White men with guns came and destroyed my community. We couldn't understand why. What did we do to them? We didn't understand. We were just living, but they came, and they destroyed everything. They burned houses and businesses . . . They murdered people. We were told they just dumped the dead bodies into the river. I remember running outside of our house. I ran past dead bodies. It wasn't a pretty sight. I still see it today in my mind—100 years later."

Mrs. Randle added: "You can help us get some justice. America is still full of examples where people in po-

sitions of power, many just like you, have told us to wait. Others have told us it is too late. It seems like justice in America is always so slow or not possible for black people. We are made to feel crazy just for asking for things to be made right. There are always so many excuses for why justice is so slow or never happens at all . . . We have waited too long, and I am tired. We are tired." She ended: "I am asking you today to give us some peace. Please give me, my family, and my community some justice."

Last summer, a judge dismissed their case. Many observers believe their appeal before the state's Supreme Court on whether they have the right to continue their lawsuit may be one of the final chances for Mrs. Fletcher and Mrs. Randle to receive some measure of justice and peace. They said in a joint statement: "We are grateful that our now-weary bodies have held on long enough to witness an America, and an Oklahoma, that provides Race Massacre survivors with the opportunity to access the legal system. Many have come before us who have knocked and banged on the courthouse doors only to be turned around or never let through the door." The fight continues.

The link between fibroids, vitamin D, and black women

Research suggests black women are two to three times more likely to develop fibroids than white women. Scary thought, right? Well get this – not only are black women more likely to develop fibroids at a younger age, but they will also need more aggressive and invasive treatment for fibroids than their white counterparts. Why? Situational, environmental, and nutritional deficiencies in the black community are behind it – more specifically, vitamin D deficiency. Lack of vitamin D in black women is thought to be linked to fibroid growth. How can we increase our vitamin D intake and reduce this shocking statistic? First, let's figure out the reasoning behind the data.

Situational

Many black people are among the poor and uninsured in the United States. Compare that to our white counterparts who not only have more monetarily, but also have adequate health insurance they can readily afford.

Many black people are trapped in precarious living situations, which leads to living with a higher baseline of stress than most Americans. Add that to being a wom-

an, whom we know usually makes substantially less money than men, and you've got a black woman in a situation where they and their family are just trying to make it to next week. Fibroids, their symptoms, and treatment may be the furthest from their minds – and their pockets.

Environmental

Our skin – the powerhouse of our “black girl magic” – also prevents us from getting vital amounts of vitamin D. Three inherent factors inhibit black skin from absorbing and processing enough vitamin D.

First, our melanin blocks most UV absorption, leading to vitamin D production.

Second, the shift from agrarianism to industrialization keeps us from getting the sunlight we would from working outdoors. Third, sunscreen blocks us from receiving harmful amounts of UV rays, inhibiting vitamin D absorption and processing.

Nutritional

It's no secret that the black diet has not been the best for centuries. Copious amounts of pork and red meat, salt and sugar, processed foods, and a



sedentary lifestyle contributed to obesity and poor health in the black community. For black women, a poor diet lacking vitamin D can encourage fibroid growth.

Combined, these factors not only contribute to fibroid development, they encourage continued growth via constant mental and physical stress, poor lifestyle choices, and unhealthy dietary choices. So what are some lifestyle changes that can help black women combat fibroids?

1. Take vitamin D supplements.

Supplemental vitamin D is available via two sources: D2 and D3, with D3 being the most effective in the human body. Supplements in pill, capsule, chewable, or gummy form are recommended

since few natural vitamin D sources are available.

2. Eat more vitamin D.

Vitamin D needs fat for optimum absorption into the bloodstream. Mackerel, tuna, and the ever-popular salmon are considered “fatty fish”, high in omega-3 fatty acids. Incorporating these and other fatty fish into mealtimes can help you absorb vitamin D supplements better.

Black women can also add mushrooms, green vegetables, eggs, poultry, and fruits into their regular diet. In addition, foods fortified with vitamin D like certain milks, cereals, breads, and orange juice can also be added to a fibroid prevention diet.

3. Get plenty of sunshine.

Standing in the sun applies to more than just Olivia Pope. Getting sunlight for at least 10 to 15 minutes a day is recommended to increase vitamin D levels. However, three things undermine ultraviolet (UV) ray absorption from sunlight for black women.

How do you combat this? Spend time in the sun sans sunscreen during midday. Research shows that optimal UV ray intensity and our ability to absorb and process it is best at noon. As black women, we will still need to spend a little more time “standing in the sun” than white women, but maximizing our time and effort by having our lunch break outside in the midday sun will help us get more vitamin D bang for our buck.

As black women, we shouldn't have fibroids to worry about on top of surviving in America. With a few lifestyle improvements, let's turn the data on fibroids and black women on its ear – and produce more positive statistics concerning the lack of fibroid growth in black women.

Five ways to de-stress daily

Keep stress low by being aware of he things that cause its presence and avoid them.

The more you can reduce your triggers, the better you will be at managing stress.

5. Eat a healthy diet

- 5 Envy Apples
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon finely grated lemon zest
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon milk
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon sugar
- ice cream, custard or cream, for serving (optional)

Preheat oven to 365 F.

Use two sheets semi-thawed pastry to line fluted tart pan approximately 10 inches, pressing and trimming neatly to fit; chill 15 minutes.

Peel, core and thinly slice apples into large bowl; sprinkle with sugar, lemon zest and cornstarch then toss well to evenly coat.

Arrange apple slices in pastry-lined tart pan, laying flat.

Beat egg with milk. Brush egg wash around pastry rim.

Cut 1/2-inch strips from remaining pastry sheet and make lattice pattern over apples, crimping edges once lattice is completed.

Brush tart with egg wash and sprinkle with cinnamon sugar.

Servings: 12

- 2 Envy Apples
- 1 tablespoon maple syrup
- 1 cup flour
- 1 cup bran flakes
- 3/4 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 cup chopped dates
- 1/2 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 cup butter, melted
- 1 egg, beaten
- 3/4 cup milk
- butter or powdered sugar, for serving (optional)

Preheat oven to 375 F and line muffin pan with cupcake papers.

Peel and core apples and dice finely; toss with maple syrup.

In large bowl, combine flour, bran flakes, brown sugar, dates, pumpkin pie spice and baking powder; mix well.

In separate bowl, whisk melted butter, egg and milk.

Add half maple-apple mixture to dry ingredients.

Pour wet ingredients into dry and fold together until mixed. Spoon evenly into muffin tin cupcake papers. Add 1 teaspoon remaining maple-apple mixture to top of each muffin.

Bake 20-25 minutes until muffin mix is set and apple topping is golden. Allow muffins to cool 5 minutes before removing from tin.

Serve with butter or dust with powdered sugar, if desired.

Yield: 1 pizza

- 1 tablespoon pizza sauce
- 1 tablespoon sweet chili sauce
- 1 storebought pizza crust
- 1/2 cup mozzarella cheese, divided
- 1/3 cup stilton cheese, divided
- 1 Envy Apple
- 4 slices prosciutto
- fresh arugula leaves, for garnish
- fresh basil, for garnish
- toasted walnuts (optional)

Preheat oven to 450 F.
