Milwaukee social services agency abruptly shuts down

Closure of Social Development Commission prompted by 'misallocation of funding'

A social services agency that's been a lifeline in Milwaukee for more than 60 years has abruptly shut down. The Social Development Commission (SDC) had three locations in Milwaukee and one in West Allis.

The sudden closure has left both employees and clients in the lurch.

For decades, the nonprofit Social Development Commission has assisted and advocated for Milwaukee County residents living in poverty. Their funding comes from a mix of public and private dollars. Their programs range from energy assistance to food programs to even the foster grandparents' program Charles Dansby works for helping special needs kids at school.

"I'm there to help mentor them, help them with their work, anything I can do for them," Dansby said Monday, April 29, 2024.

But as he just learned, the agency abruptly shut down Friday, April 26, 2024, laid off the last of their staff, and said they were unsure they'd reopen.

"It's always been here for the community. What's going on now is bothersome. I really hope they get back in functioning," he said.

In an open letter last month, the SDC revealed "instances of misallocation of funding have been uncovered."

"It's really a sad, sad, situation," said Jean Shallow out-



side of the SDC's main office at 17th Street and North Avenue in Milwaukee.

She used the Social Development Commission's free tax preparation program and now doesn't know if they were even filed.

"And I don't want to be penalized for late taxes and they said that they would put an extension in. I don't even know if that was done," Shallow said.

Another client showed up and appeared frustrated when the door was locked.

"Now we got all these consumers out here waiting for taxes, and the doors is closed," said Ike Hernes, who also left his taxes there, and hasn't heard a status.

"I want to know where's my taxes at that I sent in in January. I had a reply saying to come down to sign for them, they're ready. I come down and they're locked up," Hernes said.

Late Monday, the SDC's tax program director did return a call to WISN-TV 12. Diane Robinson said she is working with the Internal Revenue Service to ensure

the approximately 800 returns still to be filed will be handled correctly. She said extensions were all filed by the deadline, and the remaining returns are simply waiting for signatures. Robinson said they're searching for an alternative site to facilitate that.

"We are not going to let them fall by the wayside," she said Monday night. "We just have to figure out how we're going to do it," Robinson said.

SDC's attorney Monday told WISN-TV 12 News the

board is meeting is Thursday, May 2, 2024 to chart a path forward for the agency.

"We believe we're going to be able to right this ship," William Sulton said.

Sulton said the former director of finance had been terminated, and he "absolutely misrepresented the financial situation."

Sulton said CEO George Hinton also resigned at the request of the board.

"I have no evidence of theft," Sulton said.

Milwaukee police said Monday they do not know about a criminal investigation. Sulton said he too was unaware of a criminal probe.

The Wisconsin Department of Administration confirmed it has suspended payments to SDC pending the results of a fiscal audit.

In a statement released on Monday, April 29, DOA Communications Director Tatyana Warrick said

"During an annual financial review in November 2023, DOA Division of Energy Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR) staff discovered late payments from SDC to contractors, which prompted further inquiries and review related to administration of weatherization funds.

"DEHCR has not given additional funds to SDC since that point. DEHCR suspended SDC's weatherization contract in March 2024 to conduct an audit. To minimize disruption and to ensure continuity of services for weatherization and program customers, two other Milwaukee area agencies (La Casa de Esperanza and Partners for Community Development) have been asked to step in to cover ongoing work and new referrals."

Breaking Earth's stillness

Earth Day and the month of April are commemorated across the world as a time to celebrate our planet and focus on action to protect it. During this month I often remember the poem "Keeping Quiet" by Nobel laureate Pablo Neruda, which urged the world "to count to twelve and all keep still, for once on the face of the earth.":

*Life is what it is about.
 I want no truck with
 death . . .*

*Perhaps a huge silence
 might interrupt this
 sadness
 of never understanding
 ourselves
 and of threatening our-
 selves with death.
 Perhaps the earth could
 teach us . . ."*



*"It would be an exotic mo-
 ment
 without rush, without en-
 gines . . .
 Fishermen in the cold sea
 would not harm whales
 and the man gathering salt
 would look at his hurt
 hands.*

*Those who prepare green
 wars,
 wars with gas, wars with
 fire,
 victories with no survivors,
 would put on clean clothes
 and walk about with their
 brothers
 in the shade, doing noth-
 ing.
 What I want should not be
 confused
 with total inactivity.*

This month is a re-
 minder that Earth's silence is
 being broken by the felling
 of thousand-year-old trees
 and other sounds of industry
 and environmental destruc-
 tion leading to the tinker of
 coins in corporate coffers.
 Earth's quiet is also broken
 by the sounds of children
 gasping for breath as asthma
 and other respiratory diseases
 from the pollution of the air
 and land around them rav-
 age their bodies and staunch
 their learning.

There are many other kinds
 of dangers making the Earth
 a treacherous playground rath-
 er than a safe one. Children
 are now threatened by toxic

pollution from the airwaves
 and internet along with the
 air and water. We hear the
 bickering and horse-trad-
 ing between politicians and
 special interest groups who
 are often debating how big a
 tax break to give to the non-
 needy instead of investing in
 a cleaner, safer environment
 for the future. And Earth's
 stillness is shattered by the
 sounds of guns and war
 across our nation and world,
 killing more civilians than
 soldiers, including children.

As we conclude this month,
 I hope it can spur us to build
 an even more powerful moral
 movement to protect all
 children and young people

against interrelated
 poverty and violence
 and environmental
 degradation and to
 preserve the Earth
 we hold in trust for
 them. As they have
 done so many times
 before, young peo-
 ple are already lead-
 ing the way forward.
 When *TIME* mag-
 azine named then-
 16-year-old climate
 change activist Gre-
 ta Thunberg their 2019 Per-
 son of the Year, the youngest
 person so far to receive that
 honor, it noted her represen-
 tation of an entire new wave
 of young people who refuse
 to accept the world adults
 have created for them: "She
 is a reminder that the people
 in charge now will not be in
 charge forever, and that the
 young people who are in-
 heriting dysfunctional gov-
 ernments, broken economies
 and an increasingly unlivable
 planet know just how much
 the adults have failed them."

Children's Defense Fund
 Freedom School® Scholars
 are part of that wave. They've
 engaged in civil action pro-
 claiming that climate justice

is racial justice, and they've
 partnered with Youth vs.
 Apocalypse, a diverse group
 of young climate justice ac-
 tivists working together to
 lift the voices of young peo-
 ple, especially youth of color
 and youth from low-income
 and working-class families,
 to fight for a livable climate
 and an equitable, sustainable,
 and just world. They join mil-
 lions of other young leaders
 emerging around the world
 as the global youth climate
 movement boldly advocates
 for climate justice amidst this
 crisis and reframes the need
 for urgent action. All of them
 are breaking the stillness too,
 but by using their voices to
 speak out for change.



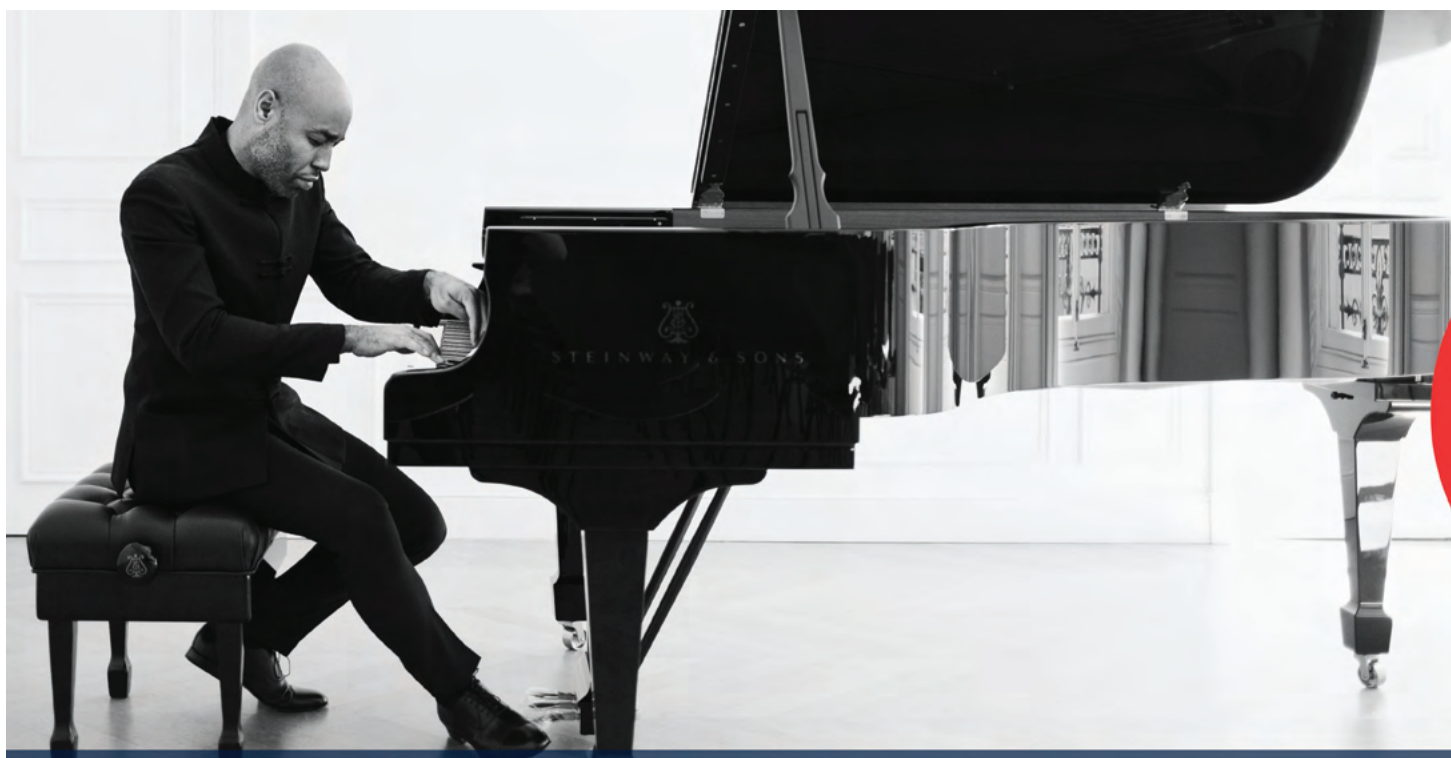

Milwaukee Direct Admit simplifies college applications for MPS students

Does applying to college seem complicated? High school juniors attending any Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) school can apply to Milwaukee's two largest colleges in less than five minutes at no cost. By applying now, students will begin their journey to start college in Fall 2025.

Milwaukee Direct Admit is the latest initiative to come out of the M3 (pronounced M-Cubed) partnership, a collaboration among MPS, Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC), and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee (UWM). This partnership works to transform the future of Milwau-

Through a streamlined online application, Milwaukee Direct Admit will connect a student's MPS transcript di-

rectly to the schools of their choice. The application is free and does not require attachments, an essay, or letters of recommendation. This method will help students—

especially first-generation college applicants—have better access to opportunities after graduation.

A student or family member will fill out a simple online form that needs only the student's name and MPS student ID number. The applicant can choose to apply to MATC or UWM or both. Milwaukee Direct Admit is free and takes the stress out of applying for college. Students who apply are guaranteed acceptance to at least one of the schools they select.

Students who apply through Direct Admit will hear back from their selected schools in about one month, and will be notified of accep-

tance by September, 2024. Students are not locked in to attend either school. Accepted candidates must officially accept their offer and complete forms required by the school they choose to attend. Enrollment at MATC or UWM depends upon the student successfully graduating from high school in spring or summer of their senior year.

The application is open now—deadline is June 14, 2024.

Getting blacks into heart-related clinical trials isn't a 'spectator sport'

Despite progress in cardiovascular disease prevention and treatment, black adults in the USA still face higher rates of premature CVD death compared to white adults. According to Dr. LaPrincess C. Brewer and Joshua J. Joseph of the Cobb Institute, this disparity is rooted in systemic inequities and a lack of access to clinical trials for black communities.

Their commentary published in *Nature* highlights several reasons for this lack of inclusion. Many clinical trials fail to prioritize black participant enrollment, and there's a general absence of accountability for achieving diversity in research.

This negligence stems from a history of unethical research practices that has fostered a deep mistrust of clinical research among black communities. Examples like the Tuskegee Study and the forced sterilization of women from minority groups are cited as reasons for this skepticism.

The consequences of the lack of blacks in clinical trials

The lack of black representation in cardiovascular clinical trials has significant downstream effects. Firstly, researchers miss crucial opportunities to understand and address the specific health concerns identified by black communities themselves.

Secondly, the underrepresentation

of black patients creates a gap in data on how they respond to various medical therapies. This lack of data hinders the development of tailored solutions to improve cardiovascular care for black communities, who are most in need. Ultimately, the absence of black voices in research allows existing health disparities to persist and prevents the development of effective treatment strategies specifically designed for black patients.

Furthermore, the lack of black researchers and healthcare professionals in leadership roles discourages participation from black communities. This lack of diversity hinders researchers' understanding of the challenges faced by black patients, further limiting efforts to increase enrollment.

A legacy of unethical research on black Americans

Deep mistrust permeates black communities due to a history of unethical research practices. The Tuskegee Study of Untreated Syphilis and forced sterilizations of minority women are frequently cited examples. These historical wrongs have fostered a justifiable skepticism toward clinical research among black people.

Neglectful practices by researchers

The current research landscape often fails to prioritize black participant enrollment. Many clinical trials lack clear plans for recruiting black patients, and there's a general absence of accountability for achieving diversity. This negligence reflects a lack of



understanding of the specific challenges faced by black communities.

Lack of black healthcare professionals

The underrepresentation of black researchers and healthcare professionals in leadership roles further discourages participation. This lack of diversity creates a gap in understanding between researchers and black communities.

Researchers may not be fully aware of the logistical challenges and opportunity costs that prevent black individuals from participating in research. Additionally, black patients may feel less comfortable or heard when they don't see themselves reflected in the research team.

What can be done to improve black clinical trial participation

The cornerstone of this approach lies in rebuilding trust with black communities. Firstly, researchers and funding agencies must acknowledge past injustices and current inequities in health care.

Partnerships with trusted community organizations can facilitate open dialogue

and collaboration. These partnerships can also ensure that research agendas reflect the specific health concerns identified by black communities themselves.

Funding reforms and community engagement

Funding agencies need to invest in long-term, community-engaged research projects led by diverse investigators. Current practices often favor well-resourced institutions, putting under-resourced researchers at a disadvantage.

Shifting to longer-term funding would allow for more rigorous research that better addresses the needs of minority groups.

Beyond simply increasing diversity metrics, the authors advocate for a "community in-reach" model. This approach empowers black communities to co-design research questions and address their specific health concerns. Initiatives like the ComPASS program and lay stakeholder engagement in grant review committees are examples of such practices.

Centering the patient above

all else

At the patient level, solutions need to address the logistical and practical challenges that prevent black individuals from participating in research. Offering flexible scheduling options outside of regular business hours and locating research sites within black communities can significantly increase accessibility.

Additionally, providing financial compensation for time and travel can help offset the "opportunity cost" of participation.

Another key solution is the inclusion of black research ambassadors. These individuals can serve as trusted liaisons between the research team and black communities, addressing concerns and promoting awareness about the benefits of participation.

The authors argue for a paradigm shift in cardiovascular clinical trials. Moving beyond traditional research models, they propose a "community-driven" approach that tackles social and structural barriers to participation.

This will ensure equitable representation in clinical trials, leading to better research and improved cardiovascular health outcomes for black communities. Only through intentional and actionable changes can we address these disparities and achieve true health equity.
