Superintendent Keith Posley resigns following MPS special board meeting

Milwaukee Board of School Directors voted unanimously early Tuesday, June 4, 2024

to accept resignation of Dr. Keith Posley

Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) Superintendent Keith Posley has resigned following a special board meeting that was held the evening of Monday, June 3, 2024.

The Milwaukee Board of School Directors (MBSD) accepted his resignation unanimously in an after hours closed session, early Tuesday morning, according to a statement from MBSD.

It came hours after the Milwaukee School Board convened for the meeting on Monday to discuss the status of Superintendent Posley, after learning about the state potentially withholding funds because of long-over-



due financial reports.

The directors heard from parents, taxpayers, former employees, and even city leaders.

Many called for Posley's resignation, along with oth-

ers on the board too, saying a lack of transparency and discrepancy in funds is a longstanding issue within MPS.

"Accountability. I think that's probably my biggest concern. As an elected offi-

cial I want my constituents to hold me accountable, just like the parents and the families and the residents here are holding the school board accountable," said District 10 Alderwoman Sharlen Moore. "We need accountability and when things aren't working right, we need decisions that are going to be made to change those outcomes."

Moore was just elected this past spring. She said she has kids in MPS and that she's been concerned about these issues for years.

She told TMJ4 that she attended the meeting Monday night to support students, families, and Milwaukee tax-

payers who deserve to know what's going on with the district's finances.

Other aldermen attended, including 5th District Alderman Lamont Westmoreland. He has been vocal for the last week, calling out MPS saying he's disgusted and embarrassed by the ongoing failures.

"I'm not one to put something out like that and sit behind the scenes. I'm here with the people. They're pissed off, I'm pissed off. I'm a taxpayer," said Alderman Westmoreland. "I don't have kids in MPS; however, I represent

Midwest Bible College holds special graduation

Midwest Bible College (MBC) celebrated a unique graduation ceremony last week at its 21st annual meeting on Friday, May 24, 2024. Thirty-two students received their associate's, bachelor's, and doctoral degrees in Biblical Studies. Three of these students completed their studies online including one African graduate who, although unable to attend, was able to share in the celebration via live streaming of the event. With the addition of this year's graduates, a total of 788 students have earned a degree or certificate from Midwest Bible College since 2003.

This graduation was bittersweet, however, as it was the first graduation without the founder and president, Dr. Roy Bowen. Dr. Roy went home to be with the Lord last December. He left giant shoes to fill, as he was a teacher and mentor to hundreds of pastors, leaders and friends both locally and around the world, especially in East Africa. His daughter, Dr. Nicole Bowen Purpura is continuing his legacy and his work as the new president of Midwest Bible College. Apostle Steven Mayanja, a dear friend of Dr. Roy's, was the keynote speaker via video from Uganda, East Africa.

Waukegan City Council votes to censure alderman over Facebook post of arm

DNA testing is underway to determine if arm belongs to Sade Robinson, a Milwaukee woman murdered and dismembered last month

As investigators in multiple jurisdictions continue their search for remains of a woman believed to have been murdered and dismembered, a member of a government body in Illinois formally condemned one of its members over a social media post which depicted a picture of a human arm.

The Waukegan City Council voted 6-3 to censure Ward 6 Alderman Keith Turner because of the graphic Facebook post.

Someone found the arm May 11 along Lake Michigan in Waukegan. A spokesperson for the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, which is leading the investigation into Robinson's death, said experts are conducting DNA testing to see if the arm belongs to Robinson.

"Shocking discovery at Waukegan Beach!" Turner's mid-May post read, "A severed arm found, but no report or mention from the administration. What's the story behind this mysterious



incident? #WaukeganBeach #MysteryUnsolved." post initially included the photo of the arm. The photo has since been removed.

Some have asked for Turner to apologize for the controversial post. Ahead of Monday night's vote, at least one member of the City Council echoed the request.

In his first public comments about the controversy, Turner said the planned censure vote was politically motivated because he's running

"It is important to note that this post was not made in my capacity of alderman, nor did it involve the use of city resources. I am profoundly

disturbed that these public officials would misuse their authority in such a manner, attacking my character and fostering a hostile work environment within the city council," Turner said.

The resolution called Turner's actions unauthorized, insensitive and disgraceful and questions his ability to handle sensitive information.

thousands of families that do have kids in MPS, so we deserve better."

The board went into a closed session to discuss the fourth agenda item, which was "possible action concerning the administrative assignment status of the superintendent."

They remained in closed session for more than five

Posley's resignation will go into effect on June 30, 2024 according to the statement from MBSD.

In the meantime, the MPS Regional Superintendent for the Southwest Region, Eduardo Galvan, will support and facilitate day-to-day operations for students and families while MPS searches for an interim superintendent. Galvan has served MPS for over thirty years, operating in many roles throughout the district.

The board will begin the search for an interim Superintendent right away.



The board also released Superintendent Posley's employment contract and resignation agreement.

That resignation agreement lays out a \$160,000 severance payment. It will be paid out in a lump sum with taxes withheld.

The agreement also says Posley will be paid out any wages he'd earned on the job but hadn't received a paycheck for. He'll also be paid any accrued, unused vacation and personal day pay. Both of those "terminal benefits" were agreed to in Posley's original employment con-

As part of that agreement, Posley cannot file any action claim or grievance against the board. He can't disparage the board, MPS or any of its respective agents. Posley also agrees to be cooperative in any litigation following the signing of the agreement.

The agreement also said that Posley can't be employed by the board in the future.

'Same Game Different Smokers' exhibition explores troubled history between the tobacco industry and black America, shines light on menthol

a strong push by health advocates, civil rights groups, elected officials, and residents, including thousands from Wisconsin, urging federal officials to finalize the proposed rule by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to remove menthol cigarettes from the market.

The recent announcement that President Joe Biden's Administration is postponing the long-awaited menthol ban, while a disappointment, will not impede the work of those working to reverse the damage caused by the decades-long and ongoing targeting of the black community with menthol tobacco.

"Today's news from the Biden Administration is a blow to the black community, who continue to be unfairly targeted and unjustly killed by Big Tobacco," wrote Derrick Johnson, NAACP President and CEO in a statement.

"The NAACP is outraged and disgusted, but we refuse to be deterred. We will continue to do whatever it takes to protect and advance black life. This is what standing for community looks like."

In truth, the tobacco industry's troubled relationship with black America is much deeper than menthol. It began hundreds of years ago. It's the same game, just dif-

> Curated by California artist and activist Tracy Brown, Same Game, Different Smokers is a national exhibition that explores the troubled 400+ year relationship between black America and tobacco. The free exhibit is being featured at Milwaukee's Washington Park Branch Library, 2121 N. Sherman Blvd., through June 29, 2024.

> "We hope that the community comes out to experience this free exhibit and learn about how the tobacco industry has devastated African American communities, and how the industry is using those same time-tested tactics to generate a new generation of tobacco users," said Lorraine Lathen, director of the Wisconsin African American Tobacco Prevention Network (WAATPN) and Wisconsin Tobacco Prevention & Poverty Network (WTTPN).

> The WAATPN and WTP-PN brought the exhibit to Milwaukee with the support of Milwaukee Public Libraries, the African American Tobacco Control Leadership Council and Wisconsin Tobacco Prevention and Control Program.

> Exhibit curator Tracy Brown, said the exhibit takes visitors on a trip through the history of tobacco and black America, exploring

timate link to slavery. The slave trade brought tobacco to North American colonies, mainly Virginia, to supply the English market. Slaves in North America cultivated tobacco, the product that enslaved them.

Tragically, the multi-billion tobacco industry of today has been built on the backs of slaves and their lineage. This success has been achieved to the detriment of black health and through the egregious behaviors that are so deeply entrenched in the tobacco industry's DNA.

"Throughout history, black America has been victimized by tobacco," said Carol McGruder, co-founder of the African American Tobacco Control Leadership Council (AATCLC), which sponsored the Same Game Different Smokers exhibition. "Although tactics have changed, we're still targets of the tobacco industry."

McGruder's group, the AATCLC, recently filed a second lawsuit against the

FDA for its failure to take action on menthol.

Wisconsin State Representative LaKeshia Myers, recently discussed issues related to tobacco industry menthol targeting in an op-ed.

"The tobacco industry has strategically targeted African American communities with menthol cigarettes through advertising techniques and product customization. This includes placing more advertisements in predominantly black neighborhoods and

sponsoring events popular among black audiences (who remembers the Kool Jazz Festival?)," Myers wrote.

Visitors can learn more about the history between black America and tobacco and its evolution to current day by visiting the Washington Park Branch Library during any of its regular hours of operation to experience Same Game Different Smokers. To learn more visit SameGameWi.com.


