Ruth McNeely-Wells, 105 votes in Wisconsin's most watched Supreme Court election





Ruth Bradley McNeely-Wells has witnessed more than a century of American history, including the passage of the Voting Rights Act in 1965. On Tuesday, April 1, 2025, the 105-year-old cast her ballot in Wisconsin's spring election.

Ruth delivered her absentee ballot accompanied by her daughter Tracey Louise Mc-Neely (left Photo) to the Milwaukee Election Commission at City Hall. The election featured several key races, including a pivotal Wisconsin Supreme Court contest that saw liberal candidate Susan Crawford defeat conservative Brad Schimel.

Ruth has been a consistent voter. She views voting as a hard-won civil right and a sacred responsibility, never missing an opportunity to cast her ballot in elections.

She was born in 1920 when only white women gained suffrage. Despite the 19th Amendment, black women continued to face discrimination barriers. The 1965 Voting Rights Act finally eliminated these obstacles, allowing her to exercise her constitutional right to vote.


Ruth has remained politically active. In 2024, she attended a campaign rally for

then-Vice President Kamala Harris at Milwaukee's Fiserv Forum. She also participated in a "Souls to the Polls" event during early voting in October 2024, where she was recognized as Milwaukee's oldest voter.

The centenarian has a rich history of accomplishments, including publishing an autobiographical cookbook titled "Recipes From The Heart, Food For The Soul."

"My mom is fantastic," her daughter said during the celebration. "She has stuck with me and my brothers through thick and thin. She's always there, no matter what."

Thousands in Milwaukee join nationwide 'Hands Off!' protests against Trump, Musk

Organizers said the protests are meant to highlight reproductive rights, voting access and other topics.

Thousands of protesters gathered in front of the Federal Building in downtown Milwaukee took part in nationwide "Hands Off!" demonstrations on Saturday, April 5, 2025.

According to organizers, the protests were meant to oppose "legislative actions threatening fundamental rights and freedoms." They also spotlighted certain issues like reproductive rights, voting access and democracy protection.

More than 1,200 "Hands Off!" demonstrations were organized across the nation by more than 150 groups, including civil rights organizations, labor unions, LB-GTQ+ advocates, veterans



and fair elections activists. Madison, Appleton, Chicago, Washington, DC, Atlanta and Boston were just some of the other cities also holding demonstrations on Saturday, April 5.

This also comes on the heels of the Trump Administration's cuts to various government agencies, along with billionaire Elon Musk's involvement in the White House.

The nation's most expensive Supreme Court race of all time just wrapped up on Tuesday, April 1, 2025 as well. Musk and his groups spent more than \$20-million

to back Brad Schimel, who ended up losing to Susan Crawford. Schimel also received an endorsement from President Donald Trump. Musk also sparked controversy during the race when he handed out multiple \$1-million checks to people who signed a backed petition of his opposing "activist judges."

"This is a consequential"

moment for our country,' said Ben Dombrowski, lead organizer of Milwaukee's "Hands Off!" event. "Now is the time for Milwaukee communities to come together in a big way to stand for fundamental rights, not just for the privileged, but for everyone...This protest ensures lawmakers, oligarchs, and those in authority hear the

people clearly: Hands off our bodies, our expression, our votes, our future. Milwaukee is taking a stand."

Congress-Democratic woman Gwen Moore and newly elected Milwaukee alderperson Alex Brower also spoke at Saturday's protest in Milwaukee.

"When they told us that they were closing down departments...when they told us to just lay down and take it. What did we do? We fought back," Moore said on Saturday.

At last check, the Trump administration has not given any statement on Saturday's nationwide demonstrations.

Community Advocates will continue to provide energy assistance despite federal layoffs at the low-income home energy assistance program

2024-2025 energy assistance benefit season ends May 15

On Wednesday, April 2, 2025, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) laid off all federal employees working in the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LI-HEAP) as part of the Trump administration's plan to reduce the DHHS workforce by 20,000 positions.

LIHEAP—common-ly known as Energy Assistance—provides both benefit dollars and administrative funding to states to help households maintain sential utility services. The current funding allocation continues to support Community Advocates' Energy Assistance Team and their work providing vital utility assistance to Milwaukee County residents through the Milwaukee County Energy Assistance Program.

households maintain their utility services by offering financial support and assistance with payment plans. The Milwaukee County Energy Assistance Program is administered by Community Advocates and UMOS.

"LIHEAP enables households with low incomes to stay warm in the winter and access weatherization services that reduce energy usage and costs," said Maudwella Kirkendoll, Chief Operating Officer of Community Advocates. "While the impact of these federal layoffs is still unclear, we remain fully committed to delivering this essential program to Milwaukee County residents. We

Cory Booker breaks Senate speech record in 25-hour rebuke of Trump administration

Democrats have been from constituents, and referstruggling to energize their frustrated base since losing all three branches of government in the November 2024 election.

Senator Cory Booker (D-NJ) may have found a way.

For more than 25 hours, the New Jersey Democrat stood at the Senate lectern speaking against President Donald Trump's policies in what may be the most dramatic and sustained public challenge to Trump's agenda since his return to the White

By Tuesday, evening April 8, 2025, Booker, his voice but unwavering, hoarse broke the record for the longest speech in Senate history, which was previously held by Senator Strom Thurmond, a South Carolina segregationist who spoke for 24 hours and 18 minutes in opposition to the Civil Rights Act of 1957. Booker began speaking at 7 p.m. on Monday, determined to disrupt Senate proceedings and draw attention to what he described as the reckless dismantling of government programs and institutions under Trump. His speech—equal parts policy critique and moral call to action—was punctuated by impassioned readings from

ences to civil rights icons.

"This is not a partisan moment—it is a moral moment," Booker said around the 20-hour mark, gripping a pocket-sized copy of the Constitution. "Where do you stand?"

Though not a filibuster in the technical sense—his remarks were not tied to a specific vote—Booker's address ground the Senate to a halt. More significantly, his speech became an unexpected rallying cry for Democrats seeking to reinvigorate opposition to the President's policies ahead of the next election cycle.

Hundreds of thousands of viewers tuned in online to watch Booker's historic stand. It was a remarkable display of stamina as he pushed through exhaustion to keep his protest alive. "I'm rip-roaring and ready," he said at the beginning. "I'm wide awake. I'm going to stand here for as many hours as I can." Booker remained standing throughout, refraining from bathroom breaks to maintain control of the floor. Occasionally, fellow Democratic Senators interjected with lengthy questions—allowing Booker to briefly rest his voice without yielding the floor. Senator Chris Murphy the Constitution, testimonies of Connecticut, a longtime



ally who led a nearly 15hour filibuster to advocate for gun control in 2016, was with Booker throughout his speech as he pressed forward.

Booker fueled his speech with occasional sips of water but otherwise spoke uninterrupted. He invoked the words of Rep. John Lewis (D-GA), the late civil rights leader, who urged Americans to get into "good trouble" in the pursuit of justice. "How am I living up to his words?" Booker asked.

one-time presidential candidate, Booker denounced the Trump Administration's attacks on Medicaid and Social Security, and assailed its handling of immigration, education, and national security. He argued that its policies had inflicted "harm after harm" on ordinary Americans and undermined the nation's democratic institutions.

As he neared the record Tuesday evening April 8, Booker noted that he had long been troubled by Thurmond's place in Senate history and saw his own speech as an opportunity to reclaim the record. "To hate him is wrong, and maybe my ego got too caught up that if I stood here, maybe, maybe, just maybe, I could break this record of the man who tried to stop the rights upon which I stand," Booker said. "I'm not here though because of his speech. I'm here despite his speech. I'm here because as powerful as he was, the people were more powerful."

Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) then took a moment to mark the accomplishment. "Do you know how proud this caucus is of you?" he asked Booker, as Senators applauded. "Do you know how proud America is of you?"

Booker said he would keep speaking, but only for a little longer. "Then I'm gonna deal with some of the biological urgencies I'm feeling."

His marathon speech came at a time when many progressive Democrats feel let down by recent compromises with Republicans, including a Trump-backed budget deal that ten Senate Democrats supported last month to avoid a government shutdown. A February CNN/ SSRS poll found that nearly three-quarters of Democrats and Democratic-leaning adults felt congressional Democrats weren't doing enough to oppose Trump. Booker's speech, while not directly blocking any Republican attempts to advance Trump's agenda, could serve as a direct response to those frustrations, signaling his willingness to challenge the status quo and take a stand against the compromises that many feel have weakened the party's resistance to Trump's agenda.

'I've been hearing from people all over my state and indeed all over the nation calling upon folks in Congress to do more, to do things that recognize the urgency, the crisis of the moment," Booker said in a video posted to social media beforehand. "And so we all have a responsibility, I believe, to do something different, to cause — as John Lewis said — 'good trouble,' and that includes

Speaking to reporters afterwards, Booker said that he hadn't eaten food since Friday and that he stopped drinking liquids on Sunday night in order to maintain stamina for the 25-hour speech. By the end, he said his muscles were cramping up from a lack of water. He declined to answer when asked if he used a catheter or wore a diaper.

When asked if he saw himself as the future of the Democratic resistance against Trump, the 55-year-old Booker demurred. "İ'm just trying to step up, because we all should be thinking about doing this," he said. "I'm really hoping that, as I said, a new generation of leaders in America can come. That generation is here."

Here's what to know about Booker's marathon protest.

Was this speech a filibuster? While Booker's speech kept the Senate floor occupied for more than 24 hours, it does not qualify as a traditional filibuster. A filibuster is typically aimed at delaying or obstructing the passage of specific legislation or the confirmation of nominees. In contrast, Booker's speech is a broader critique of President Trump's policies rather than an attempt to block a specific vote.

That said, the impact is similar. By taking the floor for such an extended period, Booker is disrupting the normal functioning of the Senate, drawing attention to what he and many of his Democratic colleagues view as a dangerous political climate under Trump's leader-

Prior to Booker's record, the longest individual speech belonged to the late Senator Strom Thurmond, who spoke for 24 hours and 18 minutes in a failed attempt to block the Civil Rights Act of 1957. More recently, Republican Senator Ted Cruz (R-TX) spoke for 21 hours and 19 minutes in 2013 to protest the Affordable Care Act, which had been law for three years.

Under Senate rules, a Sen-

ator recognized by the presiding officer can speak for as long as they wish, provided they remain standing and continue speaking. Booker, who appeared to have nothing more than two glasses of water and notes on his lectern, skillfully used the rules to his advantage, permitting colleagues to ask questions to give himself brief moments of rest while still maintaining control of the floor. Senator Murphy, the Connecticut Democrat, noted one of Booker's tactics: "Cory had a Senate page take his chair away to eliminate any temptation to sit down," Murphy posted on X late Monday night.

A symbol of Democratic frustration

Since Trump's election, Democrats have struggled to present a unified strategy against a White House that has frequently outmaneuvered them. The party's progressive wing was particularly incensed last month when ten Senate Democrats joined Republicans in voting for a Trump-backed budget deal to keep the government open, a move that many on the left saw as a capitulation.

Booker's speech appears designed to reassure the party's base that Democratic leaders are willing to fight. "The threats to the American people and American democracy are grave and urgent," Booker said. "And we all must do more to stand against them."

The White House dismissed Booker's speech as political theater. A spokesperson mocked the senator's effort in a statement to Fox News, calling it "another 'I am Spartacus' moment," referencing Booker's remarks during the confirmation hearings for Supreme Court Justice Brett Kavanaugh. "When will he realize he's not Spartacus—he's a spoof?" the statement said.

The effectiveness of the strategy depends on how it resonates with the public and whether it ultimately shifts the political conversation. Booker's marathon speech, while powerful, is unlikely to directly impact the broader legislative landscape—but it could serve to embolden Democrats who feel increasingly sidelined in a Senate controlled by Republicans.

Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer praised Booker's efforts, calling them a vital stand against the "huge dangers that face [Americans] with this Trump-DOGE-Musk Administration."

"Your strength, your fortitude, your clarity has just been nothing short of amazing and all of America is paying attention to what you're saying," Schumer said on the Senate floor. "All of America needs to know there's so many problems, the disastrous actions of this administration."
