There's another phishing scam going around, Wisconsin DMV warns


There's another phishing scam going around that consumers should be aware of, according to the Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV).

In this latest scam, scammers who are pretending to be from the DMV are sending texts that attempt to get people to click on fraudulent links, or reveal their personal information.

Consumers should be on the lookout for texts that warn of a "final notice" or a vague "unpaid traffic violation." Some scams try to duplicate the look of official Department of Transportation content, the DMV said.

A wave of complaints regarding the new scam attempts started on Monday, June 2, 2025. A previous wave passed through the state late March into early April.

"We're hearing from our DMV counterparts that Illinois, Pennsylvania, Florida, New Jersey, Georgia and New York were hit with this scam last week. Given the number of calls we're getting from DMV customers, it's likely Wisconsin is the next target," DMV Bureau of Driver Services Director Tina Braddy said. "We want to protect our residents, so we are quickly issuing this alert to ensure fewer fall victim to these scams."



Make sure to follow these tips, provided by the DMV:

- Be suspicious of demands for money and urgency.
- Do not share personal information with unsolicited emails or messages.
- Sign up for account activity alerts and renewal

reminders by subscribing to Wisconsin DMV's eNotify. Like most bank accounts, you will receive confirmation of transactions on your account which alerts you to any fraudulent activities. Sign up for eNotify at wisconsindmv.gov/enotify

If you are the victim of a scam, you may:

- Consider filing a police report with the local law enforcement agency where you reside.
- Report it to the Federal Trade Commission and/ or the IC3 at www.ic3.
- Speak to AARP's Fraud Watch Helpline and find Fraud Victim Support Groups (all ages accept-

Local lawmakers push for sprinklers in apartments after weekend fires displaced 37

In less than 10 hours, two separate fires broke out at Milwaukee apartment buildings, both without sprinklers, leaving 37 people displaced and injuring a firefighter and a resident.

Milwaukee Fire Chief Aaron Lipski took to X (formally Twitter), saying, "We need to stop sacrificing SURVIV-ABILITY for AFFORD-ABILITY."

It's a conversation that started when five people were killed at the Highland Court Apartments. Two more fires broke out on Sunday, June 1, 2025, at 87th and Villard and at 45th and Hampton.

Milwaukee Fire Chief Aaron Lipski said sprinklers will reduce damage and save lives. Now, local officials are looking for ways they can help.

"If a building doesn't meet the current fire code, I think



it's important that residents who live there know that. So, when you sign a lease, you also have to sign a waiver saying, 'I might die in this property because it doesn't have sprinklers,' said Alderman Peter Burgelis. Right now, the fire department is looking at our 911 systems so they can identify these properties that don't have sprinklers."

Alderman Burgelis is on the Common Councils Zoning, Neighborhood and Development Committee; he said fire code is established in Madison.

"This policy that a lack of better legislation from Madison makes a really threatening impact to people in Milwaukee," said Alderman Burgelis.

He said under current state law, buildings built before 1974 are grandfathered into not needing sprinklers unless they have significant remodeling – a law Burgelis doesn't see changing anytime soon.



"The only thing I heard from Madison was that they're not interested," said Alderman Burgelis.

Fire Chief Aaron Lipski said it's a battle he won't stop fighting for.

"I intend to keep pushing for it but never make any mistake – just be-cause I'm advocating for something doesn't mean my position will win; but that knowledge doesn't mean that we just sit down and shut up, and I won't," said Chief Lipski.

The Department of Neighborhood Services says 30,000-40,000 residents in Milwaukee are living in buildings without sprinklers.

Nearly 1,500 MPS students apply to college before they start senior year Juniors had until June 1; M-Cubed Milwaukee Direct Admit has exceeded 35 percent participation target

More than 1,500High school juniors at Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) have met the June 1, 2025 deadline for applying early to college by using the free, simple M-Cubed Milwaukee Direct Admit form.

In less than five minutes, students could apply to Milwaukee Area Technical College, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, or both. Students can go to mpsmke. com/directadmit to get start-

Milwaukee Direct Admit effort is part of M-Cubed, a partnership connecting MPS, MATC and UWM to build bridges from K-12 to higher education and transform Milwaukee through education. As one initiative in the partnership, M-Cubed Milwaukee Direct Admit is specifically designed to simplify the college application process. There are no essays, no letters of recommendation, and no test scores, at-



tachments, or transcripts for the students to send. MPS provides UWM and MATC with transcripts and other needed information directly. And by starting the process early — during junior year instead of senior year - students can focus their senior year on finishing strong, completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and getting registered for college classes.

Students and families are

already responding in increasing numbers.

The 1,467 MPS juniors who have already applied represent 39 percent of the class --exceeding M-Cubed's goal of 35 percent and nearly doubling the 21 percent who applied last year.

Last year's applicants are now high school seniors and nearly 900 began their senior year with a college acceptance in hand. Through another

M-Cubed initiative — Smart Start — they spent their senior year getting to know one another, registering for classes and getting oriented to college. They can participate in a summer program, and the support continues into their first year at UWM or MATC. Together, these efforts are aimed at increasing the number of Milwaukee high school students who go on to and succeed in higher education, lifting up the individuals, their families, our community — and building a skilled, diverse workforce.

Experiencing at least 4 of these symptoms? You may have this autoimmune disease

Autoimmune diseases are some of the most misdiagnosed and misunderstood diseases out there. An autoimmune disease occurs when the body's immune system mistakenly attacks healthy cells and tissues as if they were foreign invaders. This attack can lead to inflammation and damage to various organs and tissues.

Autoimmune disease symptoms vary greatly depending on which part of the body is affected; but some common symptoms include fatigue, joint pain and swelling, skin problems, and recurring fevers. Other possible symptoms include weight changes, digestive issues, swollen glands, and a general feeling of being unwell.

How autoimmune diseases attack your body

The immune system's primary role is to protect the body from harmful substances like bacteria, viruses, and other foreign invaders. It does this by identifying and eliminating these invaders.

The Autoimmune response:

In autoimmune diseases, the immune system malfunctions and begins attacking the body's own cells and tis-

Autoantibodies:

The immune system produces antibodies (proteins that target and destroy invaders) that are specifically directed at the body's own cells. These are called autoantibodies.

Consequences of autoantibodies:

These autoantibodies and the resulting immune re-



sponse can lead to inflammation, tissue damage, and various symptoms depending on the affected organs or tissues.

Examples:

Many autoimmune diseases exist, including rheumatoid arthritis, type 1 diabetes, multiple sclerosis, lupus, and Crohn's disease.

What's causing it:

The exact causes of autoimmune diseases are not fully understood, but genetic factors, environmental triggers, and other unknown factors are thought to play a role.

Symptoms:

Symptoms can vary widely depending on the specific disease and the affected areas of the body. Common symptoms include fatigue, pain, swelling, and rashes.

Diagnosis and treatment:

Diagnosing autoimmune diseases can be challenging as symptoms can be nonspecific and may come and go. Treatment typically focuses on managing the symptoms and reducing the immune system's activity to minimize damage.

Are you experiencing any 4 of these symptoms?

While spotting any abnormal symptoms you are experiencing can help you get a diagnosis, sometimes getting to the root of the problem may take more. For instance, if you have the autoimmune disease, lupus, you may have to meet a certain criteria to be officially diagnosed, according to the Lupus Research Alliance.

Lupus, particularly systemic lupus erythematosus disproportionately affects African Americans, being 3-4 times more likely than white Americans to suffer from the illness. African Americans with lupus also experience more rapid progression of the disease and worse outcomes, including higher rates of lupus nephritis and cardiovascular disease, and a greater risk of progressing to kidney failure.

No single lab test can tell if you have lupus. Many symptoms of lupus are like those of other diseases and can come and go. Instead, your primary care provider or rheumatologist will use your medical history, a physical exam and

several laboratory tests to determine if you have lupus.

You will need to have at least four of the following symptoms before lupus can be diagnosed:

- Malar rash butterfly-shaped rash across cheeks and nose
- Discoid (skin) rash raised red patches
- Photosensitivity unusually strong reaction to sunlight. Sun exposure can cause a skin rash or trigger a flare.
- Mouth or nose ulcers usually painless
- Nonerosive arthritis inflammation in 2 or more joints with tenderness, swelling or effusion (discharge). Nonerosive means that bones around joints do not get destroyed.
- Cardio-pulmonary involvement - inflammation of the lining around the heart (pericarditis) and/or lungs (pleuritis)
- Neurologic disorder seizures and/or psychosis
- Renal (kidney) disorder increased protein in the urine, or clumps of red blood or kidney cells in the urine called cellular casts
- Hematologic (blood) disorder – anemia caused by damage to red blood cells, low white blood cell count, or low platelet count
- Immunologic disorder antibodies to double-stranded DNA, antibodies to Sm (a chemical element in the body), or antibodies to cardiolipin (a kind of fat in the blood)
- Antinuclear antibodies

(ANA) – positive blood test in the absence of drugs known to induce it

Does a positive ANA test mean you have it?


Not always, which is why the previous criteria are key step in diagnosing lupus. A "positive" ANA blood test means that the immune system is making an antibody (a protein) that reacts with the body's own cells. This condition, called autoimmunity, may or may not be harmful. A negative ANA test suggests that antinuclear antibodies are not present in the blood, which is less likely to indicate lupus, but doesn't completely rule it out.

Your doctor should consider the ANA test results along with the patient's symptoms, medical history, physical exam, and other blood tests to make a complete diagno-

You've been diagnosed; now

Once a diagnosis is made, it's very important to see a healthcare provider often. He/she can look for changes in symptoms, predict and prevent flares, spot side effects of medications and change your treatment plan if needed. Regular visits also help monitor major organs (the central nervous system, kidneys, heart, lungs) early for any problems that may arise. Because no two cases are the same, your lupus treatment may differ from the next person with lupus.




