# SNAP benefits may go out in November, here's where you can go for food assistance

As October comes to an end, the threat of missing FoodShare and WIC benefits looms for people across Wisconsin and across the nation.

In an October 10, 2025 letter, Sasha Gersten-Paal, director of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program's development division, said: "SNAP has funding available for benefits and operations through the month of October. However, if the current lapse in appropriations continues, there will be insufficient funds to pay full November SNAP benefits for approximately 42 million individuals across the nation."

Nearly 700,000 Wisconsinites receive food and nutrition assistance through FoodShare.

Here are some things you can do if you live in Milwaukee and may be impacted by a lack of food resources in November.

# Food resources

# Milwaukee's last reserve ladder truck breaks down, as fire chief alerts to aging fleet

Milwaukee fire Chief Aaron Lipski announced that the city's last reserve ladder truck broke down Monday while responding to an emergency, leaving the Milwaukee Fire Department short on equipment and needing to borrow from a neighboring department.

Earlier this month, Lipski warned about the aging fleet in a recent finance and personnel committee meeting at city hall.

According to the National Fire Protection Association, front-line engines and ladder trucks should not be more than 15 years old. Currently, Milwaukee Fire Department data shows three engines are already 15 years old, and five are 17 years old. There is one ladder truck that is 21 years old, one ladder truck that is 14 years old and one that is 13 years old. Multiple "reserve" trucks and engines are past their lifetimes, too.

Mayor Cavalier Johnson's proposed 2026 budget includes \$2 million for the fire department to repair and replace old equipment, but data from the department indicates that more than \$27 million is needed to fix, replace, and ensure all equipment meets national standards within the next two



"Chief, what can you buy with \$2 million worth of equipment budget?" Alderman Peter Burgelis, the vice chair of the finance and personnel committee, asked during Friday's budget hear-

"I can probably get a single fire engine and there will be a little leftover," Lipski responded during the meeting.

The latest breakdown occurred Monday near 10th and State streets when the front passenger wheel fell off the truck, which was responding to a medical call.

"I don't know what else I need to demonstrate here," Lipski said on-scene.

The rig was 20 years old, one of more than a dozen in the department that exceeded national standards. Burgelis said he is working on an amendment to Mayor Johnson's proposed budget to get MFD more money to buy new trucks and engines.

"It's probably going to get worse and worse until we're able to repair and have a fleet that meets basic national standards," Burgelis said.

Lipski plans to borrow a truck from a nearby department as soon as possible. Until then, he said, "I don't have a single ladder truck between here and Lake Michigan."

Lipski said his captains Monday were working on moving a ladder truck from elsewhere in the city downtown temporarily. Then he plans to borrow a ladder truck from another department in Milwaukee County until he can get one of his own trucks repaired and back into frontline service.

Despite the breakdown, Lipski said paramedics did the medical call, with dispatch sending a rig from 30th and Galena to take over, which took an additional five to six minutes to arrive.

The mayor's office previ-

"We are working with the Fire Department to make sure they have the equipment needed to keep the city safe. In recent years, we were able to supplement their budgets

above historic levels. That said, we face continuing challenges to balance all the competing demands for capital funding with the very limited resources available," the mayor's spokesperson said.







# Milwaukee School Board approves \$1.6 billion final budget for 2025-26

The Milwaukee Board of School Directors on Tuesday, Oct. 28, approved Superintendent Brenda Cassellius's final budget for the 2025-26 school year.

MILWAUKEE AREA TECHNICAL COLLEGE

The \$1.6 billion budget increases the district's portion of the property tax levy by about \$8 per \$100,000 of assessed value, a 2.95% rise that remains below the 12-month inflation rate, according to a Tuesday MPS press release.

Cassellius said the plan "maximizes resources for students and schools while demonstrating fiscal prudence and responsibility." Board President Missy Zombor added that the budget

expands extracurricular opportunities for middle and high school students.

Key changes from the preliminary budget include \$20 million more in state special education funds, \$32 million in state aid aided by the 2024 referendum and \$22 million less in vacancy savings to strengthen future planning.


The district also claims to have reduced expenses by \$11 million to reflect lower enrollment, eliminating 54 vacant positions without lay-

Cassellius said work has already begun on the 2026-27 budget.

# The Wilson Center presents: acclaimed jazz saxophonist, Joshua Redman

One of the most acclaimed jazz saxophonists of his generation, Joshua Redman has spent over 30 years shaping modern jazz. After winning the prestigious Thelonious Monk Competition, he became a sought-after collaborator, performing with Chick Corea, Herbie Hancock, McCoy Tyner, and The Rolling Stones. In building a new rhythm section, Redman found himself drawn to younger players he had recently encountered. Bassist Philip Norris and drummer Nazir Ebo came aboard first, and Redman quickly knew he had made the right moves. "Not since Christian McBride can I recall experiencing an acoustic jazz bassist who seemingly has it all together at such a young age," he says of Norris, "and Nazir has groove in spades, a groove that is super-flexible, in the flow of the moment, and with an innate sense of architecture that always serves the song." By the summer of 2023, pianist Paul Cornish had completed the quartet's transformation. "Paul is the perfect balance of empath and contrarian, challenging everyone to break away from established patterns, while still always making the music feel good and natural in the moment.

For Joshua Redman, the shifting moods of wistfulness, aspiration, sadness and resolve contained in Words Fall Short signify his embrace of what he describes as "the beauty of human imperfection. We face huge questions about what our future

looks like," he stresses, "and a mathematical approach to language has even left us questioning what it means to be 'intelligent' or 'productive' or 'creative.' At heart I'm a humanist, and I believe in the shadows of the words, the things you can't crunch with technology." Words Fall Short is Redman's latest exploration of the words — and the shadows.

Joshua Redman's name resonates deeply in the jazz world as a gifted improvisor, a charismatic performer, and an insightful thinker on the nature and meaning of music.

The son of legendary saxophonist Dewey Redman and Renée Shedroff, a dancer and librarian, Joshua's childhood was steeped in music, movement, storytelling and the written word. That influence is evident in the remarkable path he's carved, blending emotion and intellect into a sound and style unmistakably his own.

After graduating summa cum laude from Harvard University and deferring his acceptance to Yale Law School, Redman moved to New York City, immersing himself once again in the world of the arts. Gigging and recording with some of the greatest musicians of all time - Charlie Haden, Elvin Jones, Jack DeJohnette, Joe Lovano, McCoy Tyner, Clark Terry, Milt Jackson, and his father, Dewey Redman, to name just a few - he found himself at the epicenter of the city's thriving jazz scene. 




