MPS buildings cleared of lead-paint risks after 10-plus months of work

All affected schools now meet or exceed standards

Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) Superintendent Brenda Cassellius announced today that after 10 months of intense work, the district has completed its lead-paint stabilization efforts in 99 schools identified as needing intervention, and the buildings have been inspected and deemed safe from lead hazards. The completion of the work comes ahead of the district's self-imposed deadline of December 31.

"This is an important milestone for the MPS community," said Dr. Cassellius. "We have asked so much of our students, families, and staff over the past 10 months as we addressed this issue with the urgency it required. Since I arrived in March, clearing our school buildings of lead dangers has been a top priority and now — because of the hard work of so many dedicated teams in our district we can move forward with the peace of mind that our schools are safe."

Dr. Cassellius made the announcement at a news conference at Trowbridge Street School for Great Lakes Studies, one of the six schools temporarily relocated last

school year while work was completed. Dr. Cassellius was joined by MPS Board Director Megan O'Halloran, Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson and Milwaukee Health Commissioner Michael Totoraitis, PhD.

Trowbridge students and staff were temporarily relocated on March 3, 2025, while the school was cleaned of lead dangers. They returned to Trowbridge on March 14, 2025 after the City of Milwaukee determined the school was safe.

"We are grateful for the progress we have made and remain committed to continued supports and monitoring to ensure lasting improvement," Milwaukee Board of School Directors President Missy Zombor said.

Since March, work has brought affected MPS schools into compliance, meeting or exceeding the requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services and the City of Milwaukee Health Department. The estimated cost of the work surpasses \$43-million.

Mayor Johnson said that



when he learned of lead risks in MPS schools, he expected the issue would be addressed with urgency, honesty, and a solution born out of collaboration, "and with an unwavering focus on the health of our kids, our students in Milwaukee Public Schools, because protecting children's health is not optional."

The superintendent credited the school district's partners and MPS employees and contractors who worked multiple shifts to complete the work. Teams addressed approximately 7-million square feet in schools across the district, including 2,700 classrooms plus common areas.

"The City of Milwaukee Health Department is proud to have gone above and beyond to protect the city's children, and we remain committed to this work as long as it takes," said Dr. Totoraitis. Both the mayor and the commissioner credited the district and Dr. Cassellius for addressing the issue with urgency.

Lead-paint stabilization work began on the oldest schools serving the youngest students, who are more likely to be affected by lead exposure. The first phase of work concentrated on schools constructed before 1950, when use of lead paint was most prevalent. Work at these schools was completed by the start of the school year in September. The second phase of the work focused on schools constructed between

1950 and 1978, the year the federal government banned lead paint. This group of schools was completed ahead of the December 31, 2025 deadline.

MPS now will focus on its cleaning, monitoring, and reporting standards for lead paint. District enhancements include:

- Expanded training for custodial and facilities staff
- 39 new school-based custodial positions
- Four new district operations managers who are in schools daily and report concerns immediately
- Lead-based paint inspections of all district facilities
- Adding Environmental Health & Safety staff who will continually monitor lead safety by conducting regular checks
- Full-facility visual evaluations for lead-based hazards on a three-year rotation

WNOV Radio and The Milwaukee Courier Newspaper enter new chapter under new owner, Civic Media

On Wednesday, December 17, 2025, the Wisconsin news and progressive-talk radio network, Civic Media, announced that it would be expanding its footprint in Milwaukee with the acquisition of heritage radio station urban AC WNOV (860 AM), its corresponding FM translator W293CX at 106.5, and the weekly Milwaukee Courier newspaper, assuming responsibility for both operations on January 1, 2026.

The deal marks a significant transition for two of the city's most enduring black-owned media institutions. WNOV was purchased in 1972 by Courier Communications Corporation under the leadership of Dr. Jerrel Jones, becoming the first black-owned radio station in Wisconsin, while the Milwaukee Courier has served the community continuously since 1964. Following more than five decades of family ownership and the recent passing of Dr. Jones — the Jones family has entrusted Civic Media with continuing that legacy.

As part of the transition, current *WNOV* owner Mary Ellen Jones will serve as a consultant, with Jerrel Jones assisting on the newspaper side. Civic Media also named Dr. Robert "Biko" Baker as Operations Manager for both

WNOV and the Courier. A longtime civic engagement leader, political commentator and former editor of The Source, Baker will oversee efforts to invest in journalism and programming that serve Milwaukee's Black community.

"My parents built *The Milwaukee Courier* and *WNOV* to give Milwaukee's black community a voice when few existed," Mary Ellen Jones said. "Passing that responsibility forward was not taken lightly. Civic Media is committed to honoring that legacy while investing in the future of trusted media."

Civic Media CEO Sage

Weil called the acquisition both an opportunity and a responsibility. "These are trusted institutions with deep roots in Milwaukee," Weil added. "Our role is to steward that legacy while investing in their future — modernizing operations, expanding digital reach, and ensuring they continue to serve the community with integrity."

Earnestine Jones, widow of Dr. Jones, said the family is confident the mission will continue. "We believed that accurate information is powerful and our voices matter," she commented. "As my family passes the torch to Civic Media, we do so with trust."

Local host Earl Ingram said the move signals renewed energy for WNOV, while Civic Media Regional President Chris Moreau emphasized the company's commitment to supporting the station and newspaper across broadcast,

digital and print platforms. "We're committed to providing the resources and infrastructure to help this team serve the community through broadcast, digital and print media," he remarked.

Kwanzaa: What it really is and how and why it's celebrated

Every year, around Christmas time, you may hear some black folks talking about celebrating Kwanzaa. Many of them jokingly because they don't know the history or roots behind the holiday. Here's how it all came about and why celebrating - it could be more important than ever.

Maulana Karenga created Kwanzaa in 1966, as the first specifically African American holiday. According to Karenga, the name Kwanzaa derives from the Swahili phrase matunda ya kwanza, meaning, "first fruits of the harvest." The choice of Swahili, an East African language, reflects its status as a symbol of Pan-Africanism, especially in the 1960s, although most of the Atlantic slave trade that brought African people to America originated in West Africa.

Kwanzaa is a celebration that has its roots in the black nationalist movement of the 1960s and was established as a means to help African Americans reconnect with their African cultural and historical heritage by uniting in meditation and study of African traditions and Nguzo Saba, the "seven principles of African Heritage" which Karenga said "is a communitarian African philosophy." Karenga believed and stated that "you must have a cultural revolution before the violent revolution. The cultural revolution gives identity, purpose and direction."



Kwanzaa was not created to give people an alternative to their own religion or religious holiday. Many African Americans who celebrate Kwanzaa do so in addition to observing Christmas.

Kwanzaa spans over seven days with each day focusing on a specific principle in the black community. A Kwanzaa ceremony may include drumming and musical selections, libations, a reading of the African Pledge and a discussion of the African principle of the day or a chapter in African history and a feast known as the "karamu."

Each day also consists of a candle-lighting ritual. You have what is called a kinara (candle holder) and seven candles (one black candle, three green candles and three red candles). The black candle is lit first then used to light each of the other candles on the day that is celebrated, going back and forth with lighting the red and green.

The seven principles of

Kwanzaa are as follows:

1. Umoja (Unity):

To strive for and to maintain unity in the family, community, nation, and race.

2. Kujichagulia (Self-determination):

To define and name ourselves, as well as to create and speak for ourselves.

3. Ujima (Collective work and responsibility):

To build and maintain our community together and

make our brothers' and sisters' problems our problems and to solve them together.

4. Ujamaa (Cooperative economics):

To build and maintain our own stores, shops, and other businesses and to profit from them together.

5. Nia (Purpose):

To make our collective vocation the building and developing of our community in order to restore our people to their traditional greatness.

6. Kuumba (Creativity):

To do always as much as we can, in the way we can, in order to leave our community more beautiful and beneficial than we inherited

7. Imani (Faith):

To believe with all our hearts in our people, our parents, our teachers, our leaders, and the righteousness and victory of our struggle.

Besides the candles and

the candle holder, other Kwanzaa celebratory symbols include a mat (mkeka) on which other symbols are placed: a kinara (candle holder), mishumaa saba (seven candles) mazao (crops), muhindi (corn), a kikombe cha umoja (unity cup) for commemorating and giving shukrani (thanks) to African Ancestors, and zawadi (gifts). Supplemental representations include a nguzo saba poster, the black, red, and green bendera (flag), and African books and artworks - all to represent values and concepts reflective of African culture and contribution to community building and reinforcement – with corn being the primary symbol for both decoration and celebratory dining.

The greeting for each day of Kwanzaa is "Habari Gani?" - which is Swahili for "What's the news?" or "How are you?"
