Northcott Neighborhood House hosts hundreds of free Thanksgiving meals

On Thursday, November 27, 2025, Milwaukee's Northcott Neighborhood House hosted a Thanksgiving feast for 500 people, offering a sit-down dinner that combined food, family and football for the community. Northcott had upwards of 75 volunteers on hand to help serve food, welcomed people in and got them seated. The Thanksgiving meal included sides like mashed potatoes and green beans, sweet potato pie, banana pudding, peach cobbler, and cake, along with 60 hams and turkeys.

"Everyone is going to be able to enjoy themselves. You'll find something you'll like," said Northcott Neighborhood House Executive Director Tony Kearney. DJ Homer Blow provided the music and Lt. Governor Sara Rodriguez joined in the dancing to the popular song "Boots on the Ground."

Bingo and football were also part of the festivities, with a giant screen showing the Packers game during the day.

The Northcott Neighborhood House plans to host a similar community meal on Christmas Day.

Former Lt. Gov. Mandela Barnes enters race for Wisconsin governor

The former lieutenant governor joins other prominent Democrats in the race

In a highly anticipated move, former Democratic Lieutenant Governor Mandela Barnes entered the race for governor Tuesday, December 2, 2025, three years after his failed bid for U.S. Senate, immediately going after President Donald Trump in his campaign launch.

"Under Trump, the name of the game has been distraction and chaos to avoid accountability," Barnes said in his launch video. "So here's the reality check: The only way for our state to move forward is to reject the Washington Way and get things done the Wisconsin Way."

Barnes joins current Lieutenant Governor Sara Rodriguez, Milwaukee County Executive David Crowley, State

Sen. Kelda Roys, State Rep. Francesca Hong and former Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation CEO Missy Hughes in the Democratic primary.

Rep. Tom Tiffany and Washington County Executive Josh Schoemann are running in the Republican primary.

Barnes, who lost a U.S. Senate bid to Republican Sen. Ron Johnson in 2022, has faced some push back about a gubernatorial bid both in recent stories by *The New York Times* and *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel*.

A recent editorial in the black-owned *Milwaukee Courier* said, "Mandela had his opportunity. He didn't

close. And that means it's time for a new chapter."

Barnes' campaign said he will immediately kick off a statewide "Wisconsin Way tour" meeting with voters in Madison, Milwaukee and Green Bay in the first days of the campaign.

"I know how to bring people together, and I know how to get things done," Barnes said in his launch video.

Gov. Tony Evers announced earlier this year he wouldn't seek a third term. When asked about Barnes entering the race during a

recent interview on 'WISN 12's UPFRONT,' Evers said, "I'm not sure. I mean, he certainly has name recognition, but there's lots of other good people, too."

The other Democratic candidates have also recently weighed in on Barnes' imminent entry into the race, which some early polls have suggested he would be the dominant front-runner in name recognition.

Barnes immediately touted a number of endorsements, including from Green Bay Mayor Eric Genrich, La Crosse Mayor Shaundel Washington-Spivey and Menasha Mayor Austin Hammond.

'It's all about dignity': St. Ben's warming center now open every night through March

The recent winter blast is creating a dangerous challenge for dozens of people who have no place to go.

Several warming shelters are now open throughout the area.

One of them is the St Benedict the Moor Parish warming center at State and 9th, operated by the Capuchin Community Services.

Every night for the next four months, St. Ben's will provide a warm and safe place to stay for dozens of people. They also want to help with long-term challenges like permanent housing, but the first concern is making sure people have a place to go.

Maurice Shehi stayed at St. Ben's Monday, December 1, 2025. He told us, "Personally, I like being out where I can just be alone and protect myself, whatever."

Shehi does not want to have to use the warming center. "But on nights like this?" he asked, "Yeah. I feel good knowing I can stay warm."

Shehi just started a new job last month but said it's still difficult getting ahead. "I'm trying to get out of there. I don't like being where I'm begging or feel like I'm begging."

So on the worst nights this

winter, he'll make his way to State and 9th, knowing he'll be safe.

On any given night, he'll be one of about 50 men and 20 women staying at St. Ben's.

Kenneth Howard is the site manager there. He said, "It's all about dignity. You really want to show people dignity. And that tears down those walls because every person deserves dignity."

Howard said the overnight warming center started in 2018 when they noticed people were not leaving the meal service on the coldest nights.

"The very next day, we just lifted up all those tables and chairs, and we put out some cots and we just started. No programming, no nothing. It was just a need," Howard said.

Since then, thousands of people have taken advantage of the service.

Most are fiercely independent and proud, like Shehi,

who said, "Just know that everybody out here is not out here on the streets begging for change. Just try to be a little bit more understanding."

But Howard says everyone could use some help. "Do not let your pride keep you from being inside."

The warming shelter at St. Ben's will open every night at 7 p.m. They're having people register so that they'll have a reserved spot through the end of March. And St. Ben's will work to accommodate work schedules.

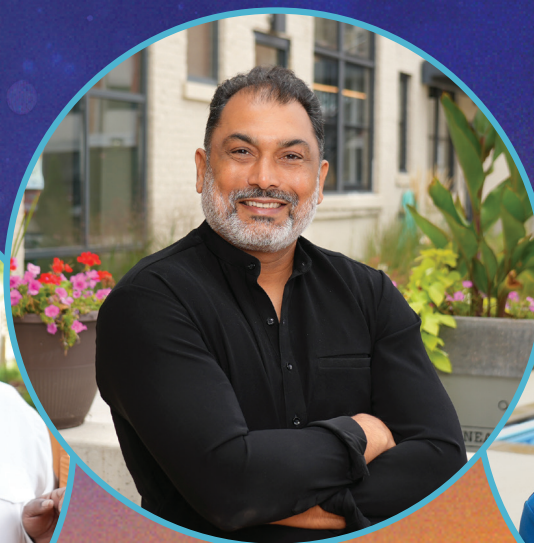

Medicare Part B to increase in 2026: What you should know

The standard Medicare Part B premium will rise to \$202.90 per month in 2026, an increase of 9.7 percent from the \$185 monthly premium in 2025, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services recently announced. The agency released the new figures in a fact sheet that outlines the coming year's costs.

CMS said the increase is mainly driven by estimated changes in prices and expected use of services. About 92 percent of people receiving Medicare Part B benefits will pay the standard rate unless they have higher incomes or specific penalties, according to a report from CNBC.

Medicare Part B 2025 and 2026 premiums

The standard Medicare Part B premium in 2025 is \$185 per month. AARP notes that some people pay more if they have higher incomes or if they delayed signing up and now face a late enrollment penalty.

Part B covers medically necessary care and preventive services. CMS said the 2026 premium of \$202.90 reflects normal price and utilization trends.

The annual deductible will



also rise. CMS said beneficiaries will pay a \$283 deductible in 2026, up from \$257.

What beneficiaries should know

The new premium and deductible amounts take effect on January 1, 2026. CMS will send notices before the end of the year. Social Security beneficiaries will also receive updates showing how the cost-of-living adjustment interacts with Medicare deductions.

Experts told CNBC that beneficiaries should review their coverage during the annual enrollment period and check whether their income level might trigger a higher charge. They also recommend contacting Social Security if a recent life change may qual-

ify for an adjustment.

Impact on social security checks

Part B premiums are usually deducted directly from Social Security benefits. The Social Security Administration has announced a 2.8 percent cost-of-living adjustment for 2026, which works out to about \$56 per month in added benefits for the average retiree.

Mary Johnson, an independent Social Security and Medicare analyst, told CNBC the new premium may feel like "a continuation in relentless cost increases." She said many retirees may see the higher premium "taking a significant chunk of or even most of their COLA."

A hold harmless rule prevents Social Security payments from going down because of a Part B premium increase. CNBC noted that other automatic deductions, such as Medicare Advantage or Part D drug plan premiums, can still reduce the final amount a retiree brings home.

Who is eligible for the Part B premium?

The standard Medicare Part B premium is not only for seniors – other groups are eligible for the benefits.

Although people 65 and older are a primary group, individuals under 65 with certain disabilities or end-stage renal disease (ESRD) are also eligible and pay the standard premium unless their income is high enough to require an Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amount (IRMAA).

Most U.S. citizens and legal residents who are 65 or older are eligible for Part B and pay the standard premium. People who are under 65 but have a qualifying disability may be eligible and pay the standard premium. And those under 65 who have End-Stage Renal Disease are eligible and pay the standard premium.

Who pays more

CMS said the standard \$202.90 premium applies to individuals with modified adjusted gross incomes of \$109,000 or less. For married couples filing jointly, the standard rate applies to incomes of \$218,000 or less.

About eight percent of beneficiaries will pay more than the standard rate in 2026. CMS said these individuals are charged what is called an Income-Related Monthly Adjustment Amount. These higher premiums are based on tax returns from two years earlier.

CNBC reported that people whose income has gone down, or who have had a qualifying life event, can ask the Social Security Administration to adjust their amount.

CMS said the changes reflect "projected price changes and assumed utilization increases that are consistent with historical experience." Analysts told CNBC that the 9.7 percent increase is one of the largest dollar increases seen in recent years. Johnson said the 2026 increase is the second-highest on record, behind the \$21.60 jump in 2022.

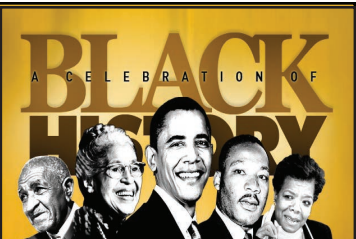
