Milwaukee honors MLK Day with focus on justice, equality

Milwaukee marked Martin Luther King Jr. Day on Monday, January 19, 2026, by honoring the civil rights leader's legacy through reflection, celebration and community service, underscoring that his message of justice and equality remains relevant decades later. The Milwaukee County Parks and the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Community Center, 1531 W. Vliet St., served as a focal point for the day's celebration. Their "Is It Me Who Must Change?" event featured guest speaker, Rev. Kenneth R. Lock II. Guests enjoyed presentations of music, dance, and spoken word honoring Dr. King.

The King center has been a longstanding hub for the Milwaukee community, providing programs and support for generations and

this year celebrates their 50 year anniversary.

"The fact we can celebrate being here for 50 years without closing the doors — except for the pandemic — is something to be honored, that we've been able to continue programming in the inner city, for all people," said Dee McCollum, director of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center.

Faith leaders also used the day to challenge people to carry King's message forward in their own lives.

"Your life has a bigger purpose than just you," said the Rev. Kenneth Lock of Evolve Church. "If you're sincere and you want to see change happen, then maybe — just maybe — it can start with you."

Milwaukee's northwest side faces another grocery store closure as Sentry shuts down

The Sentry store on Milwaukee's northwest side is closing this week, marking the third major grocery store closure in the area since summer.

Milwaukee's northwest side is losing another grocery store as the Sentry at 64th and Silver Spring is set to close this week, marking the third major chain store closure in the area since summer.

When the Sentry opened less than three years ago, it was hailed as a victory for the city and the neighborhood, which had been without a grocery store within a mile, known as a food desert.

"It's saddening to see that they're going to close the way they are, and I won't be able to come here and shop anymore," Sentry customer Jerry Watkins said Monday, January 22, 2026.

Another customer, Mike

B., expressed frustration, saying, "It's a terrible thing, man. I come here and buy my snacks, now I gotta go elsewhere. I don't know where I'm going to go."

He went on to say how im-

portant it is for the area to have an affordable source of fresh food. "Very important. Because there's a lot of little ones out here. And especially in this neighborhood," he said.

"It's bad, I mean, this is a community where they need to keep that store open because people got to go a long way to travel to go to another store. It's bad," said Anthony Wilson as he walked out of the store Monday.

There is hope that the city of Milwaukee, which intervened when the previous grocery store closed by bringing in this Sentry, can act again to fill the void.

"I want to work with members of the common council if we need to work with other levels of government as well, I'm also interested in doing that," Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson told WISN 12 Monday.

The location, a former Kohl's grocery store, has changed grocery vendors at

least four times in the last 20 years, raising concerns about the difficulty of finding a replacement in challenging retail times.

"That sort of shake-up in the economy, I think, is something that a lot of folks, whether you're a consumer or a brick-and-mortar retailer, are trying to grapple with. So, we're constantly trying to work to support businesses on the ground because that's what folks need in Milwaukee," Mayor Johnson said.

The current inventory is being sold off at 40 percent off, with workers indicating that the Sentry is expected to close in a matter of days.

The owner of the store did not respond to requests for a comment or explanation for the closing or any future plans for the site.

MPS receives final \$8 million withheld by state as it submits 2024-25 audit

Milwaukee Public Schools Superintendent Brenda Cassellius and Wisconsin State Superintendent of Public Instruction Jill Underly have announced a major milestone in MPS's work to correct financial and operational issues impacting the district.

The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) has released to MPS \$8 million in previously withheld state funding, the last installment of withheld funds from 2025. MPS also submitted its external financial audit for the 2024-25 fiscal year, marking the third audit completed in just under 13 months.

"Since arriving in Milwaukee in March, my focus has been on improving the operation of our district so that we can meet the needs and expectations of our students, families, and staff while we also rebuild the trust and transparency they deserve," Dr. Cassellius said. "I'm proud of the team here at MPS who committed to fixing these significant issues with a sense of determination and Milwaukee pride while facing intense public pressure and scrutiny. They rose to the occasion and showed that we all can expect great things in MPS."

In December, Superintendent Cassellius was joined by MPS Board leadership, Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier

Johnson and city health officials to announce the district had completed the work to stabilize lead paint in nearly 100 schools, marking the end of another serious issue the district faced in 2025. Addressing these operational issues is critical to moving the district forward.

"Under Superintendent Cassellius's leadership, MPS has made meaningful progress and is putting systems in place to meet its financial reporting obligations going forward," DPI's Dr. Underly said. "Accurate and timely reporting is essential to ensuring public confidence that school districts across Wisconsin are responsibly managing public resources. We will continue to work in partnership with MPS to strengthen these efforts. I am grateful for the collaborative work of the DPI team and MPS staff to address these challenges and improve processes for the future."

"The school board is committing to strengthening trust with our community, and this is a critical step in the process," Milwaukee Board of School Directors President Missy Zombor added. "We are grateful for the superintendent's leadership and the work of our partners as we continue to support ongoing technology improvements that will promote long-term fiscal health and responsible stewardship of resources."

To that end, Dr. Cassellius also announced continued work to improve processes. MPS has begun implementing new systems that will allow district financial platforms to communicate directly with the state's system. This was the root of the past reporting delays, requiring intense manual work. Other completed operational improvements based on a state operational audit of the district include rebuilding and hiring key personnel on the Finance team, establishing

new standard operating protocols, rebuilding the control environment, and partnering with Human Resources on position control. These positive changes put the dis-

trict on pace to rectify past accounting errors and ensure timeliness and accuracy of district books.

A visit from the Marquette University men's basketball team, coaches, and parents to Milwaukee Public School's (MPS) Milwaukee Academy of Chinese Language gave MACL students new role models to look up to — literally and figuratively:

The height of the tallest player on the MU Golden Eagles roster this year: 7 foot 1.

Players and coaches including Head Coach Shaka Smart along with the Moms of Marquette Men's Basketball (and some dads) spent the morning of Friday, January 9, 2026 with students at MACL, joined by Milwaukee Public Schools Superintendent Brenda Cassellius, EdD, and Director James Ferguson of the Milwaukee Board of School Directors.

students were eager to offer their impressions of the visit.


"They read well and picked out nice stories," one boy said.
