On Sunday, February 22, 2026 2nd Chance Outreach of Minneapolis, Minnesota presented "The Sound of Gospel" a vibrant celebration of gospel music's rich legacy at the Bradley Symphony Center in downtown Milwaukee. More than a concert, this dynamic stage production honors the historical journey of Black sacred music — from spirituals, hymns, and ring shouts to contemporary gospel and urban praise. Created in honor of Black History Month, The Sound of Gospel© uplifts the stories and voices that have shaped a people and inspired a nation. Through music, movement, and celebration, this experience invites all to witness the heartbeat of a community whose song has never stopped.

Parting with 2nd Chance Outreach were the Alzheimer's Association Wisconsin Chapter Health Equity Coalition, and WNOV radio who worked to bring this inspiring production back to Milwaukee. Their collective commitment signified more than sponsorship; it reflected an intentional investment in cultural celebration, community education, and health awareness. By weaving together Black History Month observance with vital conversations around Alzheimer's disease and health equity, the afternoon carried depth as well as joy.

Nearby Nature Milwaukee hosts '7th Annual African American Environmental Pioneers Awards'



On Monday, February 16, 2026, Nearby Nature Milwaukee hosted the "7th Annual African American Environmental Pioneers Awards" (AAEPA) ceremony at the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center to celebrate those in Milwaukee's African American community who are working for a better environment. This year's Pioneer Awardees were Danell Cross of Metcalf Park Community Bridges, Cheri Fuqua of The Middle Ground MKE, Mabel Lamb with Sherman Park Community Association, Dee McCollum of the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Center, Lloyd Seawright with Beach Ambassadors, and Yvonne McCaskill with Century City Triangle Neighborhood. This year's recipients of the Rising Star Award were Jerica Fehr with MKE FreshAir Collective, Alana Fisher of Earth Echo, Christina Hill with Hawthorne Elementary School, Bryan Rogers of Walnut Way Conservation Corp., Ifeoluwapo Tolorunju of Sherman Park Community Association, and Tylon Moon of Teens Grow Greens. A special viewing of the documentary "A Fuller Education," chronicling

the life and educational advocacy of Dr. Howard Fuller, was held at Gee's Clippers (2200 N. MLK Dr.) on Friday, February 20, 2026. The event featured Dr. Fuller in attendance, with hosting by Kwabena Nixon and an opening poem by Muhib Dyer. The film highlights his work in educational equity, school choice, and his journey from Black Power to education reform.

The AAEPA awards were first held in 2020, in effort to recognize African American community members who have dedicated themselves to work in service of the Milwaukee community, and the planet, through their work in environmental conservation, sustainability or advocacy. They hold the awards ceremony during Black History Month to honor the rich cultural history of the African Diaspora, while celebrating our living generations of all ages for their efforts to make the world a better place through environmental stewardship.

Wisconsin school districts sue state legislature over education funding

Five Wisconsin school districts, along with the Wisconsin PTA, teachers unions, and individual parents and students, have filed a lawsuit against state lawmakers, claiming the current school funding formula is outdated and unconstitutional

Five school districts in Wisconsin, supported by the Brookfield-based Wisconsin PTA, teachers unions, and individual parents and students, have filed a lawsuit against the state legislature, accusing lawmakers of failing to properly fund education.

The lawsuit, which spans over 100 pages, argues that the current school funding formula is outdated and underfunded, rendering it unconstitutional.

The lawsuit begins with a quote from Wisconsin's constitutional convention in 1848: "Education is the grand insurance policy of our liberties," and claims the legislature has not lived up to this ideal.

Beloit School Interim Superintendent Dr. Wayne Anderson, who is part of the lawsuit, said, "The funding of education is part of our state

constitution. It's part of what they are required to do."

Anderson noted that 20 years ago, the state covered two-thirds of the cost of ed-

ucating a child, but today, it pays for less than half.

"So that's the impact it has on kids is that the things you used to be able to offer when you had sufficient funding, you can't offer them now. Or, you can't offer them to the same extent. That's when kids start to suffer," Anderson said.

The Wisconsin Institute for Law and Liberty (WILL) plans to contest the lawsuit, arguing that it targets school choice programs, which allow children to use vouchers to attend private schools instead of sending money allocated for them to public districts.

"WILL sees this lawsuit as an attack on choice and charter school programs. I think that's the real target, is the tens of thousands of students that utilize these programs, which have been upheld as lawful before, and which we believe are lawful and con-

stitutional," WILL's Deputy Counsel Cory Brewer said Tuesday, February 24, 2026, in an interview with WISN 12 News.

She also expressed concern that the lawsuit does not specify how much funding would be considered adequate under the Constitution.

"At what number will it be enough money? And that's why WILL says that this could be a very, very financially consequential lawsuit for the state of Wisconsin," Brewer said.

The lawmakers, who are defendants in this case, have 45 days to respond before a hearing is held in Eau Claire County, where the lawsuit was filed. It is likely that the case will eventually be decided by the Wisconsin Supreme Court.

Attempts to reach the co-chairs of the Joint Finance Committee for comment have so far been unsuccessful.

Everyone who has ever seen a Marvel Cinematic Universe, MCU, movie has heard the term alternative reality. Alternative realities are realities that diverge from the normal time stream. Gee's Clippers hosts special showing of PBS documentary, 'A Fuller Education'

On Friday, February 20, 2026, A special viewing of the PBS documentary "A Fuller Education." The documentary chronicles the life and influence of Howard Fuller, the former Milwaukee Public Schools superintendent and voucher school champion whose decades of advocacy have shaped the city's education system. The special screening was held at Gee's Clippers, 2200 N. MLK Dr.

The event featured Dr. Fuller in attendance, with hosting by Kwabena Nixon and an opening poem by Muhib Dyer. The hour-

long film highlights his work in educational equity, school choice, and his journey from Black Power to education reform. Fuller, 85, is well known in Milwaukee for his years leading MPS and as one of the early architects of the city's private school voucher program, which became the nation's first in 1990. He also taught at Marquette University and served in county and state government, including under former Democratic Gov. Tony Earl. But fewer people know the journey Fuller took before stepping into those roles and the experiences that shaped him.
