### Innovation meets impact: GMUL's 'Economic Vibrancy Luncheon' delivers

On Friday, February 27, 2026, the Greater Milwaukee Urban League (GMUL) hosted their "Economic Vibrancy Luncheon" at the the Pfister Hotel in downtown Milwaukee. The annual event began with an exclusive Executive Briefing that brought together 33 of Milwaukee's most influential leaders — top executives, strategic partners, and visionary entrepreneurs — for an intimate, high-level conversation with NVIDIA SVP of Software Engineering, Dwight Diercks. The event proceeded onto the afternoon luncheon, where 290 attendees gathered to celebrate innovation, opportunity, and the future of our community. The initiative focuses not

just on innovation, but on access — making sure communities of color and undeserved populations are not left out of the digital economy.

# ABHM honors the memory founder, Dr. James Cameron

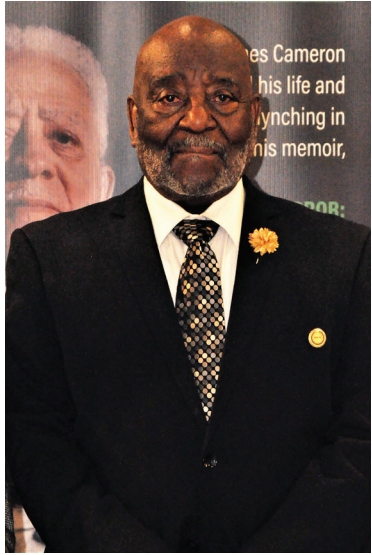
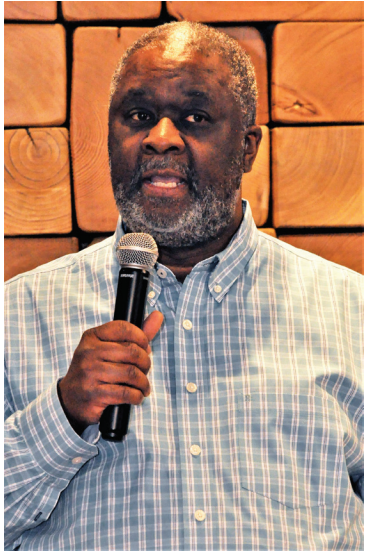

From Friday, February 20, to Saturday, February 21, 2026, America's Black Holocaust Museum (ABHM) hosted a two-day Founders' Day community weekend in memory of the late Dr. James Cameron, founder of

the ABHM. Dr. Cameron, who passed on June 11, 2006, was one of a few documented survivors of a lynching and the Founders' Day event served to honor his journey and his dedication to educating the public about resilience, reconciliation and healing. Hundreds of visitors from around the city, state and region viewed exhibits tracing the Black experience from the African continent to the transatlantic slave trade, through Reconstruction, Jim Crow, the Civil Rights Movement, to present day. Throughout the weekend guests enjoyed poetry from Milwaukee's poet laureate, Shelly Conley; live music from Cigarette Break; for the young ones, arts and crafts with ABHM partner, The Milwaukee Public Museum; a book-club discussion, tours and other celebratory activities were offered. The two-day event was free and open to the public and was presented courtesy of The Brewers Community Foundation. ## Milwaukee residents share west side priorities ahead of city's 10-to-20-year planning meeting

Milwaukee is asking residents to help shape the future of the city's west side for the next 10 to 20 years, and neighbors say they already know what needs to change.

The West Side Area Plan will serve as a roadmap guiding how money and resources are spent across dozens of neighborhoods — from safety and small business to education. The first public meeting took place on Tuesday, March 3, 2026 at Marshall High School.

Local tv station, *TMJ4* talked with people who live in the area about what they think should be the priority.

Shannon Ross grew up near 47th and Meinecke. He says investments should start with young people.

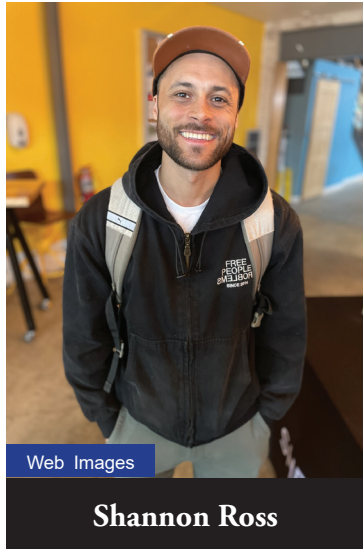
"For me, education is the most important thing right now... specifically black and brown youth, the need for getting investment is so key for the future," Ross said.

He says preparing youth for emerging industries is critical.

"These changes are happening now... Let's start looking at how to prepare and be positioned to take advantage of what's coming and be ready for the changes," Ross said.

Others say, before anything else, fix the streets.

"The roads are in very bad,"

Kathleen Berry-Burks said.

Berry-Burks says reckless driving is also a concern.

"Sometimes you never know which direction a person is going to drive in... and the speed," Berry-Burks said.

Business owner Kamara Carter of House of Vitali-TEA at the Sherman Phoenix says safety and infrastructure directly impact his business.

"It affects me because my customers have to come to me. If their tires and their axles are getting broken out there on the streets—It's taking more money out of my business," Carter said.

He also believes investment in healthy food options is essential.

"I'm really big on investing in nutrition. Our brain needs certain minerals. I feel like

we ain't eating right — so our brain ain't even getting the minerals we ain't eating like we're supposed to," Carter said.

Joshua Liston-Zawadi says meetings are important, but action matters more.

"To call a meeting is one thing. To actually use the

input you get is another. If you're gonna actually use it, I'm for it," Liston-Zawadi said.

For many neighbors, the message is simple: If the city is listening, now is the time to prove it.







## MPS proposes incentives to retain and recruit workers while addressing budget deficit

As Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) prioritizes protecting classrooms, keeping schools safe, investing in student achievement, and restoring fiscal health in building the district's 2026-27 budget, leaders also are intent on investing in the district's people.

Tough financial decisions will have to be made in the months to come because of the imbalance in the budget, MPS Superintendent Brenda Cassellius, EdD, has said. The district's three recent audits underscored this

by identifying a \$46 million gap between revenues and expenses at the end of the 2024-25 school year.

Because of that, the district is proposing two key investments in its employees:

Providing steps and lanes in 2026-27, which increase wages to recognize employees' long-term commitment to the district and educational attainment.

Making no healthcare plan design changes for 2026-27, while conducting a long-term study on how to save money in the face of consistent increases in healthcare costs. In the upcoming year alone, the district's share of healthcare costs is expected to increase by about 5.8 percent, based on an actuarial study.

The proposals will be presented to the Milwaukee Board of School Directors the week of March 8. The district also continues to bargain with its union partners on base wages in accordance with state law.

## The power of collaboration is Milwaukee's legacy

Milwaukee has a rich history that displays the power of collective action. From the organizing traditions of Black churches and neighborhood associations to the leadership that fueled local civil rights efforts, our city's progress has never been the result of one voice, but the result of many.

That same spirit lives on in collaborations like the RISE Drug Free MKE coalition. Substance misuse prevention is often framed as an individual issue. But it is a community issue that touches us all. For communities in Milwaukee that have limited access to health care, economic opportunity, and prevention resources, collaboration is a necessity.

History teaches us that when systems fail to protect our communities, we build



our own supports. Mutual aid societies, grassroots coalitions, and church-led initiatives have long filled the gaps left by disruptive policies. Today, that same model of shared responsibility is what makes collaborative initiatives so powerful.

### Resilience through

### collaborations

The RISE Drug Free MKE coalition brings together schools, mental health workers, health care providers, nonprofits, first responders, parents, and youth to align prevention efforts across the city. Instead of duplicating services or competing for visi-

bility, partners share data, coordinate outreach, and center community voice. That approach matters especially in neighborhoods that have too often been under-resourced.

Prevention cannot be forced. It must be informed by lived experience and provided with care. When young people see adults working together across sectors, it sends the message: your future matters enough for us to unite around it.

Sustainable change requires trust and consistency. It also requires acknowledging that our health outcomes are connected to broader issues, such as economic stability, high-quality education, and neighborhood investment.

Milwaukee's Black community has always demon-

strated resilience through collaboration. The question before us is whether we will continue that legacy intentionally.

The challenges facing our city are too complex for any one organization to solve alone. But when we stand together—across institutions and across neighborhoods—we strengthen the foundation for the next generation.

Collaboration is not just a strategy. In Milwaukee, it is part of our history. And it must remain part of our future.

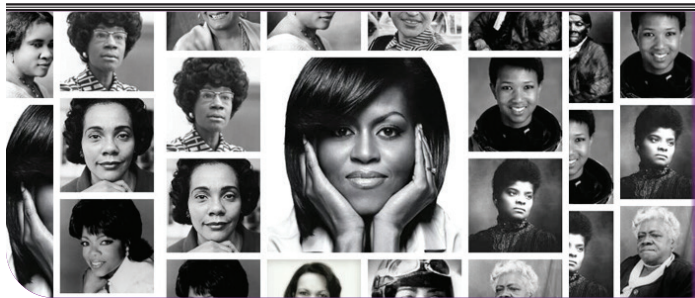

# Celebrating Women's History Month

## International Women's History Month is here. What's this year's theme?

International Women's History Month marks an opportunity to honor the contributions and achievements of women past and present, while pushing for gender equality progress around the world.

Every year, the National Women's History Alliance distinguishes a theme for the month, and 2026 is all about how women are addressing global challenges. This year's theme is "Leading the Change: Women Shaping a Sustainable Future," focusing on how "women are designing blueprints for sustainable transformation."

The month also features International Women's Day on March 8, when marches and events around the world will celebrate and advocate for gender equality.

### What to know about International Women's History Month

The genesis of Women's History Month was in 1978 at the Sonoma County Commission on Women in California, according to NWA. This local celebration coincided with International Women's Day on March 8, and was a weeklong event featuring school presentations and even a parade dedicated to celebrating women's history and accomplishments.

The movement became popular across the nation and reached Washington. In 1980, President Jimmy

Carter declared the official designation of the week of March 8 as National Women's History Week. In 1987, the designation was extended by Congress to include the entire month, according to the Library of Congress. In the proceeding years, the NWA have been the official custodians of Women's History Month, choosing an annual theme and advocating for gender-based priorities throughout the year.

In 2026, the theme calls to attention the "overlap-

ping disparities" of climate change, economic inequality, inaccessible health care and risk to democratic participation, with women of color and other marginalized groups disproportionately affected around the world. The theme spotlights how women care for their environment and communities, according to NWA's website, and what is left to be done to improve conditions for the next generation. The aim is to activate during the month toward a future that is healthier for people and the planet.

### March 8 is International Women's Day

International Women's Day is on March 8, and this year is themed "Give to Gain." This aims to "help forge gender equality through abundant giving," according to the IWD website.

This day has a long legacy, according to IWD. In 1909, the Socialist Party of Amer-

ica named the first National Woman's Day (NWD) observed across the country on Feb. 28. Then in 1910, an international conference in Denmark confirmed the creation of an International Women's Day. But March 8 wasn't chosen until the eve of World War I in 1914 as the exact date of the global event. The United Nations observed IWD for the first time in 1975.

IWD is not a federal holiday in the U.S., but March 8 is observed by numerous communities, companies and educational institutions across the country as a call to action for change. The theme for 2026 "encourages a mindset of generosity and collaboration." This can take many shapes and forms, from charitable giving to nonprofits that help women around the world to recognizing the women and carers in our lives who do invisible labor.

# MPL and UWM host lecture on Alonzo Robinson, Jr.

On Saturday, February 14, 2026 at the Milwaukee Public Library Centennial Hall the University of Wisconsin -Milwaukee architectural historian Justin Miller held a program celebrating the remarkable 40 year career of architect Alonzo Robinson, Jr. Robinson made profound and lasting contributions to Milwaukee's Black Community as architect. Kim A. Robinson, Sr., Alonzo's son, participated in the Q&A session, and longtime library partner, Docomomo Wisconsin, presented an exhibit and answered questions about their vital work advocating for Modern

architecture.

Robinson designed over 100 buildings over his illustrious four-decade career as Wisconsin's first Black licensed architect. Robinson, who died in 2000, did more than design buildings for Milwaukee's Black community. He created the spaces and places -- beauty salons, day-care centers, churches and restaurants that defined the Black community and contributed to the city's Black business growth.

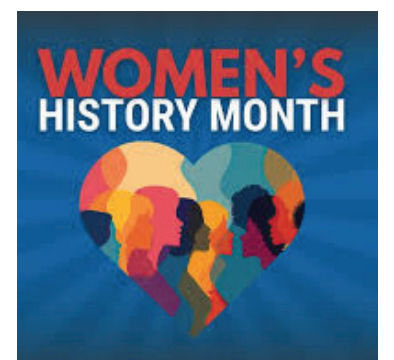

### Looking at gender equality today

March aims to celebrate progress in gender equality and also shed light on specific opportunities for improvements.

The Global Gender Gap Report 2025 from the World Economic Forum, which names key benchmarks in gender equality across 148 countries, found the gap is only 68.8 percent closed, an increase of 0.3 percentage points compared to the previous year. North America leads the 2025 regional gender gap rankings, having closed 75.8 percent of its overall gender gap. But the U.S. ranked 42nd overall, coming in first for educational attainment but 58th for health and survival.

An example of health risk is the threat to safe births in the U.S. The World Health Organization (WHO) reported in 2023 that the U.S. was one of only seven countries to report a significant increase in the proportion of pregnancies that result in the death of the mother since 2000. A 2025 study by The Commonwealth Fund found wide interstate differences in maternal mortality across the country.

# Small Business Spotlight

Getting to know the organizations and individuals helping make our community better

## Brandy Chambers and Loving Families #1, help give families a healthy and happy start

For Women's History Month, the Milwaukee Times is proud to spotlight Brandy Chambers, founder of Loving Families, a Milwaukee-based prenatal care coordination business rooted in compassion, resilience, and community empowerment.

Chambers is a lifelong Milwaukee resident from the 53206 zip code, a mother of two, and a business owner whose journey reflects perseverance through adversity and an unwavering commitment to uplifting others. "Loving Families is my second baby," Chambers said, noting that her first career as a hairstylist laid the foundation for her entrepreneurial path.

### Turning lived experience into purpose

Loving Families serves expecting and new mothers—particularly those in low-income communities — by helping them access essential resources such as housing support, education, transportation, and career pathways. Chambers' motivation for this work is deeply personal.

She became a mother at 16 and raised her oldest son as a single parent after his father was murdered. Her son later faced challenges including high-functioning autism, bipolar disorder, and schizophrenia. "That was very hard for me," Chambers shares. "I had to take care of him all by myself."

Despite these challenges, she continued moving forward. After initially working as a hairstylist, Chambers returned to cosmetology school, earned her credentials, and eventually became a licensed instructor. She also

spent five years working with the State Board of Cosmetology.

Her determination was shaped by family encouragement, particularly from her mother and grandparents. "My grandfather always told me, 'If you do what you love, you'll never work a day in your life,'" she recalls.

### Faith as a foundation

Chambers credit her faith as a central force in her life and work. A member of Infinite Church on Milwaukee's northwest side, she believes spiritual wellness is inseparable from maternal and child health.

"For me, staying close to God was all that I had," she says. "I feel like healthy moms make healthy babies—mentally, physically, spiritually. Without a healthy mother, you can't produce a healthy child."

She also speaks openly about managing her own health, including hypertension, emphasizing the importance of self-care for mothers. "Without me, there's no healthy child," she explains. "Nobody is going to take care of your children like you."

### Overcoming setbacks and starting again

Chambers does not shy away from discussing the most difficult chapters of her life, including a period of incarceration that separated her from her son. "I went to prison," she says. "But going through all of that and coming out, I saw that it still can be done."

When she returned home, she had nothing, not even a vehicle, but she rebuilt her career and expanded her vision. "I came home from prison with absolutely nothing," she says. "It can be done. It can happen."

That message now anchors her work with Loving Families. "You don't have to stay in a box. You don't have to become what society says you are," Chambers says. "You can persevere."

### Building community through collaboration

Loving Families works in partnership with other community organizations, churches, and local businesses to provide wraparound support. Chambers point to collaborations that include childcare services, job training, transportation assistance, and educational classes offered through community partners and her church network.

"We're here to love on you and be your family," she explains. "You have to be willing to take advantage of what's available, but there is always something, or someone, out there to assist you."

Chambers also emphasize the importance of surrounding oneself with people who have something to give. "Even if it's just encouragement, a hug, or a word, we're here."

### A living testimony

Today, Chambers stand as a testament to what resilience, faith, and community support can accomplish. Her youngest son is a student-athlete at Menomonee Falls High School, and she continues to expand her business ventures while mentoring women and young mothers across Milwaukee.

"I stand before you today a living witness," Chambers says. "A testimony. It can happen." Through Loving Families, Brandy Chambers is not only building a business, but she is also building hope, one family at a time.





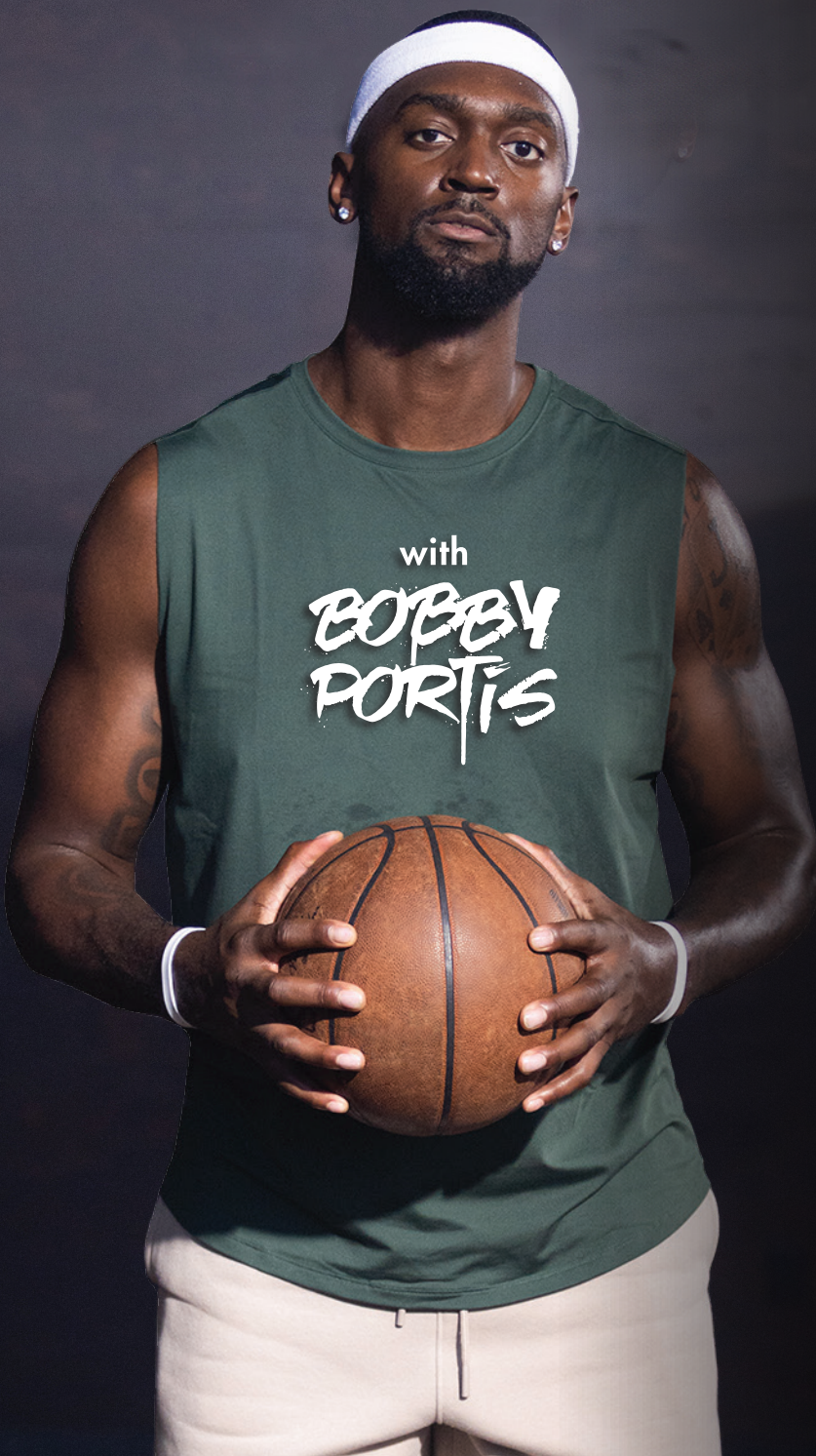
