Milwaukee Brewers celebrate the start of the season with 2026 Opening Day

The Milwaukee Brewers' opened the 2026 MLB season on Thursday, March 26, 2026, against the Chicago White Sox at American Family Field, winning 14-2 in a historic rout. The win tied the 1988 club for the largest Opening Day margin in franchise history. The game featured a franchise-record 11 strikeouts from pitcher Jacob

Misorowski and marked the earliest home opener in team history. Ceremonial First Pitch was thrown by Green Bay Packers quarterback Jordan Love. Fans were treated to a 20-minute sneak peek of the "Ueck" documentary about legendary broadcaster Bob Uecker following the game.

Milwaukee mayor addresses crime, housing in State of the City address

Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson discussed crime reduction, affordable housing initiatives and opposition to President Trump's immigration policies.

Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson acknowledged illegal dumping, reckless driving, and other serious crimes in the city while announcing new programs to improve affordable housing for hundreds of Milwaukee residents in the future.

Housing was a major focus for Johnson, who highlighted a faster process for permits to get buildings built faster.

"In a report from the Wisconsin Policy Forum earlier this month, the city of Milwaukee topped the five other regional communities examined with the speediest building permit approval," Johnson said.

He noted that the process is now 33 percent faster.

His plan includes building 100 affordable single homes on Milwaukee's northwest



side in the Amani neighborhood, with the anticipation that 200 families in Milwaukee will receive down payment assistance this year.

"Immigrants make Milwaukee stronger," Johnson said.

He also criticized President Donald Trump's immigration policy, calling it "particularly egregious."

Addressing reckless driving and public safety efforts, Johnson acknowledged the work of the Department of Neighborhood Services.

"The DNS has deployed hidden cameras, and that's catching dumpers in the act in a number of city neighborhoods," Johnson said.

He mentioned that while crime is down 17 percent

from 2025, homicides are up, and non-fatal shootings are down, urging legislators to make a change.

"There are still too many guns in the hands of the people that should not have them. And there is still no meaningful legislative action in Madison or Washington to address gun violence," Johnson said.

Lead efforts continue to be a point of concern. Johnson said Milwaukee has replaced over 13,000 pipelines this year and aims to accomplish 5,000 more. He is partnering with Milwaukee Public Schools to expand a lead screening effort in schools as well.

Granddaughter takes over Milwaukee's Beckum-Stapleton Little League to rebuild youth baseball legacy

On Milwaukee's North Side, the Beckum-Stapleton Little League has been a home for generations of kids for more than 60 years.

Now, after the loss of founder James Beckum, his granddaughter Asia Beckum is stepping up as executive director to continue and rebuild the family legacy for generations to come.

"The community should know that we are still here. We've never stopped, we are functioning well, and we are growing," Asia Beckum said.

James Beckum was more than a coach—he was a pillar of the Milwaukee community who dedicated his life to creating opportunities for young people through baseball. As the founder of Beckum-Stapleton Little League, he spent decades building a

program rooted in discipline, mentorship, and access, ensuring kids had not just a place to play, but a place to grow.

Known for his commitment to providing quality equipment, strong coaching, and a supportive environment, Beckum helped shape the lives of thousands of children—many of whom went on to become leaders in their own communities. Today, his legacy lives on through the league that bears his name, continuing to impact a new generation.

Asia Beckum is focused on honoring tradition while pushing the league forward as the new season starts.

"We're trying to honor traditional ways while also adding new ones to grow the league," Asia Beckum said.

"My grandfather's shoes are extremely big to fill, but if we

come together as a community, we can get close," Asia Beckum said.

MPS supporting 201 staff members whose non-classroom positions were reduced

To address a current \$46 million budget shortfall as Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) builds its budget for the next school year, the district has reduced non-classroom positions in the district by about 201.

The Milwaukee Board of School Directors on March 9 approved reducing 263 positions in the district. The final number of about 201 employees affected takes into account positions already vacant in addition to recent retirements.

The district is working to support the affected staff members in finding roles across MPS by filling vacancies wherever possible. The number includes about 70 positions based in Central Services (including a deputy superintendent position and chief of schools position on the superintendent's senior team), 62 implementer positions (educators who hold a teaching license but are not

assigned to one classroom), and 59 assistant principal positions.

The district is focused on protecting classrooms and students as it addresses the budget gap. MPS Central Services is overstaffed compared with other large urban school districts, and the school district has more assistant principals than many of its peers. In the future, MPS will have one assistant principal for every 350 students, which still allows the district

to maintain a stronger ratio than other large urban districts.

"Every member of our MPS team brings value to our students and schools, and this was an incredibly difficult decision," said Superintendent Brenda Cassellius, EdD. "At the same time, our actions will result in \$30 million in savings, which reduces our \$46 million deficit while helping ensure our classrooms have the resources they need."

The savings will help the district maintain and even reduce class size when needed. The district is not cutting the positions of classroom teachers, counselors, nurses, psychologists, or social workers to address the budget gap. As is the case every year, when a school has lower enrollment, there might be fewer staff to reflect the change in student population.

MPS also will maintain services for students with special needs while undertaking an audit to make sure special education students are properly supported.

The district will continue to centrally fund critical positions supporting all students, including art, music, physical education, and library staff, as well as counselors, nurses, psychologists, and social workers.

Through the critical needs process that allows princi-

pals to request extra support, additional positions have been approved for classroom teaching, paraprofessionals, counseling, and art, music and physical education.

MPS will continue to advocate for adequate funding at the state level, including the additional special education reimbursement that Wisconsin public schools were promised. Any additional savings the district can achieve, or any additional revenue identified, would go toward further critical needs requests from schools.

The \$46 million budget shortfall identified in the audit of the district meant that MPS needed to identify savings before it distributed draft school budgets in preparation for the next school year. The district, however, is on track to finalize a proposed budget in May for the 2026-27 school year and present it to the board for approval.

Student voice grows at MPS, as delegates begin representing students on school board

Mateo De La Cruz, a senior at Reagan College Preparatory High School, and Ingrid Melzer, a junior at Milwaukee High School of the Arts, looked perfectly at ease sitting between Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) Superintendent Brenda Cassellius, EdD, and the members of the Milwaukee Board of School Directors during a school board meeting.

Mateo and Ingrid had been there before, to report briefly on happenings at the Superintendent's Student Advisory Council, where they also serve. But this was their first night as official delegates from the SSAC to the board, along with Lucina (Luna) Matos, a junior at Rufus King International High School.

The students, in their role as delegates, regularly will be sitting with the board and providing students' viewpoints as the board makes its decisions — the next meeting of the full school board is Thursday, March 26, 2026.

Like school directors, delegates will ask questions during proceedings, be recognized to speak, and be briefed on all issues except for confidential topics, such as personnel matters.

The delegates will be advisers to the board, but they won't make motions or vote. The delegates get the same training that the elected school board directors take.

Mateo's term will end when he graduates in spring, but Ingrid and Luna will continue to serve through the 2026-27 school year. All three ran for the positions and were elected by their SSAC peers, who come from high schools all around the district.

Dr. Cassellius clearly was delighted to have the new student delegates sitting beside her at their first official meeting with the board. She welcomed them during the meeting (before the meeting started, she took photos of them and took selfies with them, as well). Having student representation at board meetings was something she championed since joining MPS in March 2025.

One of the 11 core beliefs held by the school district is that "student voice is encouraged and respected." Existing administrative policy—first adopted in 1971 and amended over the years—calls for student delegates to serve as

representatives to the board, although that representation had fallen by the wayside over the years.

In interviews during an SSAC meeting, Mateo said he saw his new role as an opportunity to expand student input in MPS for future generations. "This kind of guides how the future student voice is going to be viewed at MPS," he said, adding, "I know that I'm not going to reap the rewards myself for this, but I'm really hoping to make sort of the framework that can be built on by future leaders in the SSAC."

Ingrid's SSAC experience reporting to the board encouraged her to run for the role of delegate.

"I think that having student voice in the proceedings of MPS is one of the most important, if not the most important, parts of making these decisions that will af-

fect all of the students across MPS," Ingrid added. "You cannot, in my opinion, do anything without regarding the people it affects, because we live in a democracy, and that's what democracy does."

Tina Owen-Moore, EdLD, chief officer to the board and board clerk, is eager for the return of student representation at board meetings.

"I think that the students

know their schools the best," she said in an interview. She observed that district success comes entirely from students, whether it's measured by attendance, test scores, or graduation. "The students are the only people who can make us successful as a district," she said.

"Having the students weighing in and providing different perspectives on the issues is only going to make us better as a district. I'm excited about it," Dr. Owen-Moore said.

Director Erika Siemsen, who represents District 2 on the school board, told the delegates during the February 26 meeting, "Thank you for the service that you're providing to your peers. It is really important, and I love how you both emphasize how student voice is truly beneficial to the district and to board members."

**Notice of Spring Election
and Sample Ballots
April 7, 2026**

OFFICE OF THE MILWAUKEE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION

TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE:

Notice is hereby given of a spring election to be held in City of Milwaukee on April 7, 2026, at which the officers named below shall be chosen. The names of the candidates for each office, whose nominations have been certified to or filed in this office, are given under the title of the office, each in its proper column, together with the questions submitted to a vote, for a referendum, if any, in the sample ballot below.

Information to Voters

Upon entering the polling place and before being permitted to vote, a voter shall:

- state their name and address
- show an acceptable form of photo identification*
- sign the poll book**

***If a voter does not have acceptable photo identification, the voter may obtain a free photo ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.**

****If the voter is unable to sign the poll book due to disability, a poll worker may write the word "exempt."**

If a voter is not registered to vote, they may register to vote at the polling place serving their residence if the voter provides proof of residence.

Where ballots are distributed to voters, the initials of two inspectors must appear on the ballot.

Upon being permitted to vote, the voter shall enter a voting booth or go to a machine and cast their ballot. The vote should not be cast in any manner other than specified here. Sample ballots or other materials to assist the voter in marking their ballot may be taken into the booth and copied. The sample ballot shall not be shown to anyone so as to reveal how the ballot is marked.

A voter who is a parent or guardian may be accompanied by the voter's minor child or minor ward.

An election official may inform the voter of the proper manner for casting a vote, but the official may not advise or indicate a particular voting choice.

Assistance for Voting

A voter may select an individual to assist in casting their vote if the voter declares to the presiding official that they are unable to read, have difficulty reading, writing, or understanding English, or that due to disability are unable to cast their ballot. The selected individual rendering assistance may not be the voter's employer or an agent of that employer or an officer or agent of a labor organization which represents the voter.

Where Optical Scan Voting is Used

The voter shall fill in the oval next to the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall write in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote and fill in the oval next to the write-in line. On referendum questions, the voter shall fill in the oval next to "yes" if in favor of the question, or the voter shall fill in the oval next to "no" if opposed to the question.

When using an *electronic ballot marking device* ("ExpressVote") to mark an **optical scan ballot**, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select the name of the candidate of their choice for each office for which they intend to vote. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, the voter shall type in the name of the person of their choice in the space provided for a write-in vote. On referendum questions, the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select "yes" if in favor of the question, or the voter shall touch the screen or use the tactile pad to select "no" if opposed to the question.

Spoiling Ballots

If a voter spoils an **optical scan ballot**, they shall return it to an election official who shall issue another ballot in its place, but not more than three ballots shall be issued to any one voter. If the ballot has not been initialed by two inspectors or is defective in any other way, the voter shall return it to the election official, who shall issue a proper ballot in its place.

After Voting the Ballot

After an official **optical scan ballot** is marked, it may be inserted in the security sleeve, so the marks do not show. The voter shall insert the ballot in the voting device and discard the sleeve or deliver the

ballot to an inspector for deposit. If a central count system is used, the voter shall insert the ballot in the ballot box and discard the sleeve or deliver the ballot to an inspector for deposit. The voter shall leave the polling place promptly.

Included with this notice is a sample of the official ballot.
